AT OUR SUGGESTION PRESROUPRO CONVENED MEETING TO REVIEW ECONOMIC AND MILITARY SITUATION. PRESENT WERE 2 MEMBERS GOVERNMENT MAJOR ELENDE COMMANDING LOCAL ANC FORCES, CHIEF CIVIL MISSION, COLONEL ALSAGOFF AND MAJOR MOHALUDIN.

AAA. ALL AGREED ON URGENCY ECONOMIC MEASURES ~~XXX~~ TO PREVENT FAMINE. PRESROUPRO PREPARED DECREE TO DIRECT OPERATION REQUISITIONING ALL AVAILABLE TRUCKS TO SEND TO FEED PRODUCING AREAS UNDER ANC MILITARY ESCORT. REQUESTED FROM MAJOR ELENDE A PUBLIC DECLARATION SUPPORTING OPERATION AND THAT THERE WOULD BE NO MORE ARMY REQUISITIONING. EXCEPTION WOULD BE MADE TO TRUCKS ENGAGED ALREADY SAME PURPOSE. THE ONLY COOPERATION ASKED FROM ONUC WAS PROMPT DELIVERY OF FLOUR REF BULE 1279.

BBB. MAJOR ELENDE SAID HE HAD GIVEN ORDERS TO ANC AND PARACOMMANDES FORCES TO AVOID ANY PROVOCATIVE ACTION AND AGREED TO MIXED PATROLS OF ONUC AND MILITARY POLICE. HAD SENT SIMILAR ORDERS TO GOMA WHERE BEFORE HAD BEEN SOME PROVOCATION. HE ADDED THAT 2 PARACOMMANDOS WHO YESTERDAY POINTED THEIR GUNS TO ONUC SOLDIERS HAVE BEEN GIVEN 15 DAYS ARREST.

FURTHER BUKA352 FOLLOWING POINTS ARE MEANT TO SUMMARIZE LATEST EVOLUTION IN KIVU CONSEQUENT TO STAN TROOPS MOVE IN PROVINCE ON THEIR WAY TO AND FROM KATANGA.

(A) SINCE EARLY NOV UNDER THREAT OF ANC OFFICERS PARTLY FROM STAN PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT IS TOTALLY PARALYZED. IF NO ARREST OF ITS MEMBERS WAS ACHIEVED ITS DUE TO UN PROTECTION. MIRUHO STILL AFRAID TO MOVE AND FACE THOSE OFFICERS.

(B) ANC REQUISITIONED ALL OVER PROVINCE AROUND 140 TRUCKS AND VEHICLES FROM COMPANIES AND PRIVATES WITH 2 IMMEDIATE CONSEQUENCES

(D) EUROPEAN PERSONNEL OF CERTAIN COMPANIES AS COTONCO AND SUCRAF WAS WITHDRAWN FROM UVIRA FIZI AND KASONGO ACCORDING TO UNCERTIFIED CABLE INSTRUCTION FROM GOUPRO. MOVE OF ANC OUT OF KINDU SPREADING OVER MANIEMA CREATED PROBLEM OF EVACUATION OF EUROPEAN PERSONNEL OF MINING COMPANIES AS THEY ARE COMPLETELY AT THEIR MERCY AND CUT FROM UN UNITS IN KINDU.

DUE TO THE REQUISITIONING OF TRUCKS BY MILITARY FORCES AND THE IMMOBILISATION OF THOSE WHICH STILL ARE IN PRIVATE HANDS, THE SUPPLY OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES TO BUKAVU AND SUBURBAN VILLAGES HAS BEEN AT A STANDSTILL FOR MORE THAN A WEEK, WITH THE RESULT THAT THERE IS A GROWING SCARCITY OF FOODSTUFFS. THE SITUATION IS ALREADY ACUTE. THIS MISSION HAS TODAY SENT HARNETT TO USUMBURA (REF BUKA350) TO INQUIRE ABOUT THE PURCHASING OF CERTAIN BASIC FOODSTUFFS, IN FORESIGHT OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SEVERAL HUNDRED EUROPEANS SEEKING PROTECTION IN ONUC CAMP, IF THE MILITARY SITUATION SHOULD BECOME EXPLOSIVE. BUT THE GREATEST PROBLEM IS THE LACK OF FOOD FOR ABOUT 20000 CONGOLESE PEOPLE IN AND AROUND BUKAVU WHO MAY BECOME DESPERATE AT ANY MOMENT. WE ARE, THEREFORE, CONFRONTED WITH TWO ALTERNATIVES

1. ACCUTE WHAT APPEARS INEVITABLE

- (A) ANC REACTION TO KINDU OPERATION AND MILITARY ACTION
- (B) PANIC AND REFUGE OF EUROPEANS IN ONUC CAMP
- (C) PILLAGE OF EUROPEANS SHOPS AND HOMES
- (D) FINAL EXODUS OF EUROPEANS FROM KIVU, & SPECIALLY TEACHERS,

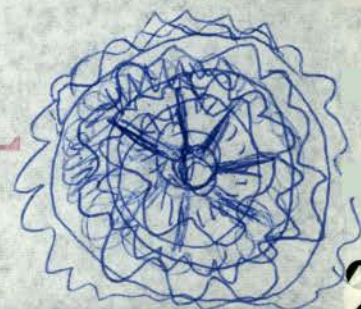
