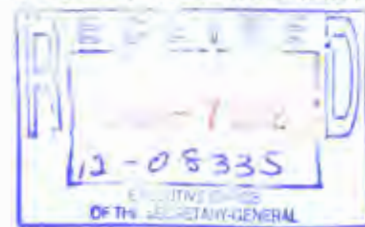

The period during the opening of the sixty-seventh session of the General Assembly and the General Debate will be an extremely busy time for all parties. However, we are still receiving information about numerous meetings and events relating to the session that will require the presence of the Secretary-General. It is therefore not possible to determine how much time will be available for bilateral meetings until closer to the opening of the General Debate.

In the interim, we would appreciate if your office could inform the Chief of the Scheduling Office, Ms. Josiane Ambiehl, should there be any changes in the plans of the President, or any details regarding the topics to be discussed in the requested meeting.

Re: Request for interview with the Secretary-General

Reference is made to Note Verbale EOSG/SOSG/GA67/001 of 29 June, regarding requests for bilateral meetings with the Secretary-General during the General Debate of the sixty-seventh session of the General Assembly.

H.E. Otto Pérez Molina, the President of Guatemala, would appreciate the opportunity to meet with the Secretary-General at a convenient time on any day between September 23 and September 26. President Pérez Molina assumed office in January of this year, and, in consequence, this would be his first opportunity to meet with the Secretary-General. Among the topics he wishes to discuss, the following can be mentioned:

- a) The Guatemalan Presidency of the Security Council (October, 2012).
- b) Extension of the International Commission against Impunity in Guatemala (CICIG).
- c) Guatemala as host of the annual General Assembly of the Organization of American States (June, 2013).
- d) The Central American Security Strategy.
- e) General interaction between Guatemala and the United Nations.

We trust that you will find a slot in the Secretary-General's busy agenda to accommodate this request.
