FOLLOWING THE ATTACK OF HIPPOPOTAMUS ON THE LOCALS OF GIKOMERO AND GIKORO COMMUNES, THEY HAVE DUG TRENCHES AS TRAPS FOR THE ANIMALS WITH VIEW TO KILLING THEM.







A REPORT OF AN ACCIDENTAL EXPLOSION OF A (UXB) INVOLVING 3 CHILDREN OF AGES 3, 8 AND 16 WAS REPORTED AT ABOUT 1215HRS. KM-5 WAS TASKED TO INVESTIGATE AND PTL REPORTED THAT THE 3 YEAR OLD BOY PICKED UP THE BOMB WITHIN THE BACK YARD OF ONE OF THE CHILDREN. THE BOMB EXPLODED WHEN HE WAS PLAYING WITH IT AND HE SUSTAINED SERIOUS INJURIES TO THE HEAD AND LEGS WHILE THE 8 YEAR OLD BOY AND THE 16 YEAR OLD GIRL HAD SLIGHT INJURIES. THE VICTIMS WERE SAID TO HAVE BEEN TRANSPORTED TO KIGALI HOSPITAL BUT BY THE TIME KM-5 GOT TO THE HOSPITAL THEY WERE NOT THERE. THE INCIDENT OCCURRED AT KABUGA (GR 2581) AT ABOUT 1000HRS.





THE RED CROSS AND SAVE THE CHILDREN WERE OBSERVED SUPPLYING FOOD, CLOTHING, BLANKET AND WATER TO THE KIGALI PRISONERS. THEY WERE ALSO OBSERVED TO BE RENOVATING AND PROVIDING MEDICATION AT THE PRISON.

PROBLEMS OF THE PRISON

THE PRISON COULD BE SAID TO BE OVER POPULATED TO BE CONSERVATIVE. THE CONGESTION HAS FORCED SOME OF THE INMATES TO BE SLEEPING IN THE TOILETS. MEANS OF CONVENIENCES ARE GROSSLY INADEQUATE THUS MAKING THE PLACE VERY DEPLORABLE.

THE PRISON DOES NOT HAVE A SINGLE VEHICLE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES OR EMERGENCIES WHICH ARE IMMINENT AT THE PRISON. A WOMAN WAS SAID TO HAVE DELIVERED IN THE DEPLORABLE SITUATION STATED ABOVE DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORT TO CONVEY HER TO THE NEAREST HOSPITAL. IT IS BELIEVED THAT MANY OF THE INMATES WOULD HAVE DIED IN EMERGENCY CASES DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORT IN THIS PRISON.

LACK OF PRISON UNIFORM ALSO PLACES EXTRA RESTRICTIONS ON THE PRISONERS AS THE OFFICIALS ALWAYS ENTERTAIN THE FEAR OF THE PRISONERS MIXING-UP WITH VISITORS. THIS OFTEN HINDERS PRISONERS FROM SEEING THEIR RELATIVES WHO BRING FOOD FOR THEM.

SUGGESTIONS

IT IS SUGGESTED THAT UNAMIR PREVAILS ON THE RWANDAN AUTHORITY TO DECENTRALISE THE PRISONS BY SENDING BACK SOME OF THE PRISONERS TO NEARBY COMMUNE PRISONS FROM WHERE MOST OF THEM WERE BROUGHT. THIS COULD BE ON AN AGREEMENT THAT UNAMIR WOULD TRANSPORT THEM BACK WHEN THEY ARE REQUESTED FOR TRIAL. OUR RECORDS SHOW THAT SOME OF THE COMMUNE PRISONS ARE EMPTY. WE ALSO BELIEVE THAT THE DEATH RATE OF INMATES IS HIGH EVEN THOUGH THE RATE WAS NOT GIVEN. NOTWITHSTANDING, AN OUTBREAK OF EPIDEMIC IN THE PRESENT SETTING COULD BE DISASTROUS ON POLITICAL AND HUMANITARIAN CONSIDERATION FOR THE RECONCILIATION BEING SOUGHT FOR. ABOVE ALL, THE TRIAL OF THE PRISONERS REQUIRES EXPEDITE ACTION TO FORESTALL DELAYED JUSTICE. ON THE LACK OF PRISONER UNIFORMS WE REPORTED, NUMBERED CLOTH BIBS COULD BE WORN BY THE PRISONERS FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES. THIS MEASURE WOULD ALLEVIATE THE RESTRICTION ON THE INMATES.
