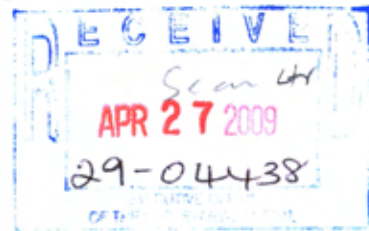

This conference, which is organized by three Associations of Czech and Slovak women entrepreneurs, has a high ambition to be a "strategic meeting point" for creative people, who are able to share their ideas, exchange knowledge and positive energy in the field of women entrepreneurship in the global market. Conference, which is held under the auspices of the Czech and Slovak Ministers of Foreign Affairs, is primarily focused on businesswomen, but it is open to all women and men interested in this topic, regardless their occupations.

The idea of organizing a conference by and for businesswomen and managers, focused on different aspects of women's entrepreneurship, was conceived in the Czech Republic in the late 1990s. These conferences were very successful and largely visited by participants from different parts of Europe. This year, after a five-year break, the organizers decided to continue in this tradition and transfer the conference from Europe to the United States, to New York.

The International Conference “Woman – A Creative Personality of the Third Millennium”

HOW CAN WOMEN´S ENTREPRENEURSHIP HELP US FACE THE GLOBAL CRISIS?

About the Conference

The Conference, which is focused on global aspects of women’s entrepreneurship, will be held in the **Bohemian National Hall in New York from May 21st to May 22nd 2009**. The accompanying program starts with short festival “Femina Film in New York” on 19th May; there will be also exhibitions of the photography of Líba Taylor and Jadran Šetlík during the conference.

The New York conference is the sixth in the series of international conferences, which were held in the Czech Republic and Slovakia between 2000 – 2004, specifically in Prague (2000-2002), Bratislava (2003) and Brno (2004). After a five-year break, the three organizers – the Moravian Association of Women Entrepreneurs (Moravská asociace podnikatelek a manažerek - MAPM), the Women’s Forum (Fórum žen) and “Top Centrum Podnikateliek”, the Slovak Association of Businesswomen - decided to continue with this tradition and organize the conference together with U.S. partners in New York.

Main goals of the conference:

- Networking, exchange of experience between women – specifically entrepreneurs and managers on the top management positions, about their businesses in Europe, the United States and developing countries;
- Creation of a platform for formal and informal discussions concerning professional development and successful entrepreneurship, especially small and medium-sized companies owned and managed by women in the global market (the main topic of Day 1);
- Cooperation between business and NGO sectors and organisations (main topic of Day 2);
- Preparation of projects supporting women entrepreneurship and business education for children and students by:
 - Collecting and publishing the most successful projects and ideas to support women entrepreneurship in the world,
 - Preparing international educational courses for university students specialising in business and economics, to be held in Vilemov Castle in the Czech Republic,
 - Supporting fair trade through conference web pages.
- Preparations of the 7th international conference in Nairobi, Kenya, 2011.

Five-year summary 2000 – 2004

In 2004, the International Conference “Woman - A Creative Personality of the Third Millennium” celebrated the fifth anniversary of its inaugural assembly. The Czech initiative, managed by the Moravian Association of Women Entrepreneurs in Brno, was held four times in Czech cities: Prague in 2000, 2001 and 2002; and Brno in 2004. It was organized in Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, in 2003.

The conferences focused mainly on Czech and Slovak women entrepreneurs, especially from small and medium sized businesses. The main goal was to develop cooperation between women who own or manage companies and to secure their participation in regional, national or international projects such as Women and the Internet, Entrepreneurship Education, Assistance Centres for Women Entrepreneurs, Mentoring and others.

Conferences were attended by a **growing number of participants, from 140 to 220**. During the five years about **150 speakers took the floor**. Most of the experts came from the **Czech Republic, Slovakia, Great Britain, the United States and Canada**. The conferences hosted many VIP guests, including its **patron, Tomáš Bat'a** and his wife, Sonia.

The five conferences have produced a melting pot of ideas and accumulated experience. The presentations of diplomats, politicians, academics, business experts, and representatives of the arts, fashion and other professional fields have been inspirational and of great help to many participants in planning their future projects.

SUMMARY

1999

The idea of organizing a conference for women entrepreneurs was conceived in the Czech Republic in the late 1990s. Olga Girstlová, the general director of the company GiTy, the first Czech businesswoman to receive the “Leading Woman Entrepreneur of the World” award, initiated it. The celebrated American Star Group presented this accolade to her in Monaco.

2000

In January 2000, the 1st international conference was held at the Mövenpick Hotel in Prague. About 130 participants took part in this event. The program of the conference focused specifically on: Company Strategy, Ethics in Business, HR Management; The Economic and Legislative Environment for Small and Medium sized Businesses, Globalisation and International Communications, Business via the Internet and The Establishment of Harmony between Career, Family and Personal Development.

The conference resulted in the formation of the Central Office of the Moravian Association of Women Entrepreneurs and two independent clubs for women entrepreneurs in Brno and Ostrava. This first conference was linked with the award ceremony for “**The Best Czech Woman Entrepreneur of 1999**” in which Eva Štěpánková, the director of Ryor cosmetic company, was chosen from six finalists. A year later, she became the second Czech woman to be awarded the title “**Leading Woman Entrepreneur of the World**”.

“Empowering Women to Shape the New World” was the title of the international conference Women’s Forum organized in Prague in June 2000. Following on from the Vital

Voices Meeting in Vienna, the purpose of this conference in the Czech Republic was to establish the first in a series of dynamic meetings of women leaders from Europe and North America. They were discussing significant issues affecting women's lives in democratic societies, sharing various perspectives, debating and exchanging ideas and networking among themselves. Main speakers of the conference were H.E. Swanee Hunt, former US Ambassador to Austria and Esther Dyson, Chairwoman of EDventure Holdings.

2001

The 2nd International Conference convened in January at the Renaissance Hotel in Prague and was attended by 140 participants. For the first time, directors of schools took part. The main conference topics focused upon: Professional Development; Business Planning; Business via the Internet; Work and Family Harmony. The conference took a new view of head teachers as school managers and their management abilities. **After the conference, the new Professional Club of School Management was established in Brno.**

2002

The 3rd International Conference was again held in the Prague Renaissance Hotel and was attended by 160 participants. Its deliberations concentrated on five themes: How to Improve Professional Knowledge; How to Lead a Company Successfully; How to Make Strategic and Expedient Decisions; How to Build a Responsible and Productive Civil Society; How to Make a Professional Life-style Compatible with the Career.

The two main topics were Business Strategy – the Right Decision at the Right Time, and Women in Top Management. The relationship between schools and business was also discussed, together with the establishment of innovative relationships between entrepreneurs and NGOs. The conference was conducted **under the auspices of the Czech Republic National Commission for UNESCO**. Its social element culminated in the Blanka Matragi Fashion Show at Žofín in Prague.

2003

In January 2003, for the first time, the 4th **Conference was transferred to the Slovak capital, Bratislava, with a record-breaking 220 participants.** It was organised in close co-operation with the TOP Centre for Businesswomen. Plenary debates and group discussions led to an exchange of experience and to the adaptation of new ideas concerning the professional development of successful female entrepreneurs and their companies in the European Market. The conference motto was: "Europe Welcomes the Well-Prepared". **Following the entry of both countries into the EU, Czech-Slovak co-operation & the competitive ability of businesses and individuals was at the top of the agenda.** Speakers and other participants discussed newsworthy events and individual experience in various European regions. The conference evaluated one year of the Czech-Slovak Mentoring project.

2004

The 5th International Conference assembled for the first time in its 1999 birthplace - **the city of Brno** - at the Voroněž hotel. The January event was held **under the auspices of Brigita Schmögnerová, the UNECE Executive Secretary, with the Slovak Consul-General, Katarína Smékalová, the Mayor of Brno, Petr Duchoň and Tomáš Baťa, its patron.** The conference motto was: "Contacts, Information, Knowledge" – being the precepts of successful entrepreneurship in the EU market. **The Conference reflected upon the subsequent entry of the Czech and Slovak Republics into the EU.** The conference was enhanced by a video link with Vanda Wolfová, a top manager at Ogilvy & Mather in Paris.

The most social segment of the conference was the cultural program staged in the Brno House of Arts and Besední Dům.

A special series of the International Conference assembled in Lignano - Northern Italy. The conference was organized together with the **Chamber of Commerce in Udine (Italy)**, which developed a special assistance's program for women start up businesses. Plenary debates focused on different experience of Italian and Czech and Slovak businesswomen, especially during their business start up process. The conference was co-financed by the European program ARGE 28, the goal of which was to prepare the new European member countries to work together within the European Union. The Conference was held symbolically in **May 2004** when the Czech and Slovak Republics joined the European Union.

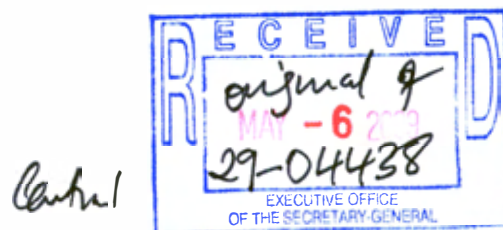

The first conference took place in January 2000 in Prague, followed by four others among 2000 – 2004, which were held in the Czech Republic and Slovakia. These conferences were very successful and largely visited by participants from different parts of **Europe**. This year, after a five-year break, the organizers decided to continue in this tradition and transfer the conference from Europe to the United States, to New York.

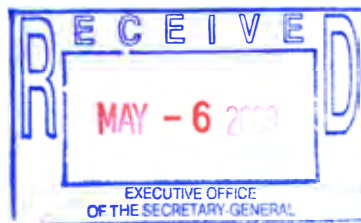
