"J'AI PRIS CONNAISSANCE DE VOTRE LETTRE DU 20 JANVIER 1961 RELATIVE AU LIBRE MOUVEMENT DES RESSORTISSANTS ETRANGERS DANS LE CONGO OU POUR QUITTER LE TERRITOIRE DE LA REPUBLIQUE.

1. ALL PERSONS ARRESTED IN STANLEYVILLE ON 19 AND 20 JANUARY (THIRTY-EIGHT IN ALL) HAVE BEEN RELEASED. AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED CRABBE IS FREE AND IN GOOD HEALTH AND SPIRITS AND SO IS RAES. NO INFORMATION IS YET AVAILABLE ON THE EIGHT PERSONS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN KIVU AND TRANSFERRED TO STANLEYVILLE.

2. ACCORDING TO OUR BEST INFORMATION, THE SUM TOTAL OF ARRESTS IN THE ORIENTALE PROVINCE IS AS FOLLOWS : THIRTYEIGHT PERSONS IN STAN, TEN IN DINGILA AND THREE IN AKETI. ALL PERSONS WERE RELEASED THE NEXT DAY.

3. THIRTYTWO OF THE STAN DETAINEES WERE TAKEN TO THE MILITARY CAMP WHERE, UNDER THE REGULATIONS ENACTED UNDER THE BELGIAN ADMINISTRATION AND UNFORTUNATELY STILL IN FORCE, THIRTY OF THEM ARE REPORTED TO HAVE RECEIVED EIGHT WHIP STROKES AND ONE PERSON TWELVE. ONE DETAINEE WAS LEFT UNTOUCHED. AMONG THOSE WHO WERE WHIPPED, FOUR WERE ALSO BEATEN . EXCEPT FOR CHAMPAGNE, WHO STILL HAD THE MARKS OF THE BEATING , ALL OTHERS HAVE NO TRACES LEFT.
