1. FOR FAMILIES WHO ARE STILL LIVING IN REFUGEE  
CAMP, THAT GUSSING AND HIS STAFF LOCATE AND TRANSFER THEM  
TO PLACE OF ORIGIN ON SPACE AVAILABLE ON TRAINS AND/OR  
AIRCRAFTS

2. FOR THOSE IN JADOTVILLE, KIPUSHI ETC, AND IN  
ELI OUTSIDE REFUGEE CAMP THAT REDCROSS LOCATES AND  
REPATRIATES THEM. KIMBA, AFTER RECEIVING TSHOMBE'S MESSAGE  
CONCERNING SAID FAMILIES (YOUR EV718) REMARKED THROUGH  
MRS VERMEULEN THAT HE DOES NOT KNOW ANYTHING CONCERNING  
THE PRISONERS AND THEIR FAMILIES AND THAT HE WONDERED WHY

SOON WE MUST TAKE DECISION CONCERNING THE ESTIMATED 20000  
BALUBAKAT. I HAVE NOT ENOUGH INFORMATION ABOUT CONDITIONS IN ALB  
ETCETRA TO DECIDE IF A REPATRIATION IS POSSIBLE AT ALL. MILITARY  
COLLEAGUES WHO HAVE VISITED ALB ETCETERA INFORM ME THAT THE FOOD  
SITUATION PARTIALLY BAD AND THAT ONLY COMPARATIVELY SMALL AREAS  
ARE CONTROLLED BY CENTRAL GOVERNMENT. THEY ALSO SAY THAT THEY  
HAVE DIFFICULTIES IN ALB TO PREVENT NUMEROUS REFUGEES FROM OTHER  
PARTS OF NORTH KATANGA TO ENTER THE CITY AND FORM A REFUGEE CAMP  
THERE. A REPATRIATION OF BALUBAKAT TO AREAS CONTROLLED BY  
GENDARMERIE SEEMS ILLOGICAL TO ME SINCE THEIR STAY IN REFUGEE

AFTER CONTACTS WITH DIFFERENT SECTIONS OF POPULATION IN ELI, BOTH EUROPEAN AND AFRICAN I AM CONVINCED THAT A CERTAIN KATANGESE NATIONALISM EXISTS WHICH COULD CONSIDER CONCESSIONS MADE BY TSHOMBE TO CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AS SURRENDER. BOTH MUNONGO AND KIMBA ARE MAKING EVERY EFFORT TO ENCOURAGE THIS TENDENCY. IF AGREEMENT IS REACHED BETWEEN TSHOMBE AND CENTRAL GOVERNMENT, HE WILL FIND HIMSELF MORE OR LESS ALONE AND WITHOUT SUPPORT WHEN HE RETURNS HERE.
