4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

a. GITI, RUTARE & KINYAMI COMMUNES.

(i) THE TEAM TRANSPORTED THE UNDERMENTIONED ITEMS PROVIDED BY MIFAPROPE (DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN OF RWANDA) TO THE COMMUNES FROM THE PREFECTURE:-

COMMUNE	FERTILISERS	MARICOT	CHOUX	CARROT
GITI	08 SACKS	9 KG	2 KG	6 KG
RUTARE	07 SACKS	7.5 KG	1.5 KG	5 KG

(ii) GITI COMMUNE THE TEAM ALSO CONFIRMED FROM THE BOURGMESTRE OF GITI COMMUNE THAT THEY HAD RECEIVED 10 TONS OF BEANS FROM KIGALI. HOWEVER HE REQUESTED FOR ASSISTANCE TO TRANSPORT 10 TONS OF FERTILISERS FROM KIGALI WHICH HAVE BEEN PROVIDED BY ADRASAWS GIKONDO. THE REQUEST IS BEING ROUTED THROUGH HAC.

(iii) RUTARE COMMUNE THE TEAM ALSO DELIVERED A LETTER FROM THE DOCTOR IN CHARGE OF THE RUTARE HEALTH CENTRE TO WORLD VISION AT BYUMBA REQUESTING FOR VACCINES.

(iv) KINYAMI COMMUNE WFP WAS OBSERVED DISTRIBUTING FOOD TO THE WORKERS WHO HAD BEEN WORKING ON THE ROADS AT THE SCALE OF 25 KG OF MAIZE FLOUR AND 150 KG OF SIORGUM PER PERSON RESPECTIVELY.

(b) GITUZA COMMUNE

(i) NYARUBUYE HEALTH CENTRE (GR 3221) THE TEAM VISITED THE HEALTH CENTRE AND WERE INFORMED OF 45 DEATHS DUE TO DYSENTRY SINCE THE PAST TWO MONTHS. A REQUEST IS BEING FORWARDED TO UNAMIR TO PROVIDE VACCINES TO COMBAT THIS

DISEASE. AS A RESULT OF LARGE NUMBER OF ADMISSIONS, THE BED CAPACITY (21) IS INADEQUATE AND A REQUEST WAS MADE FOR 40 ADDITIONAL MATTRESSES. WHEREAS CRC (BELGIUM) IS ASSISTING THE HEALTH CENTRE, THE REHABILITATION WORK IS BEING UNDERTAKEN BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH

(c) KIVUYE COMMUNE

(i) THE TEAM INTERACTED WITH A FEW OF THE 140 RETURNEES WHO HAVE BEEN SETTLED IN VILLAGE KAGANA IN GATEBE SECTOR SINCE SEP 95. THEY ARE FACING PROBLEMS OF SHORTAGE OF SEEDS, AGRICULTURE IMPLEMENTS AND WATER. MOREOVER, THEY ARE LIKELY TO BE MOVED OUT OF THIS SECTOR AS THEY ARE FARMING ON LAND WHICH IS THE PROPERTY OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE. A FINAL DECISION IS AWAITED.

(ii) THE TEAM TRANSPORTED FIVE SACKS OF FERTILISERS (50 KG EACH), 15 KG OF CABBAGE SEEDS, SIX KG OF BEANS SEEDS AND FOUR KG OF CARROT SEEDS FROM THE PREFECTURE TO THE COMMUNE OFFICE.

(iii) THE TEAM WAS ALSO INFORMED THAT 1000 SPADES HAD BEEN DISTRIBUTED BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE ON 08 NOV 95.

5. CIVIL AFFAIRS

(a) KIVUYE COMMUNE. THE TEAM VISITED THE CELL AND MET A 45/50 YRS OLD WOMAN WHO HAD BEEN ARRESTED ON 08 NOV 95 FOR ALLEGEDLY HAVING TRAVELLED TO ZAIRE ON A NUMBER OF OCCASIONS. THE WOMAN EXPLAINED THAT SHE HAD BEEN MAKING FREQUENT VISITS TO MEET HER CHILDREN. THERE WERE TWO OTHER INMATES WHO HAD BEEN ARRESTED FOR POSSESSION OF A GUN AND A HAND GRENADE.





- a. **GENERAL** CALM.
- b. **BORDERS** GATUNA, BUZIBA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

- a. **POLITICAL** NIL.
- b. **MILITARY**.

(i) RPA CONTINUES TO CONDUCT VEH AND FOOT PATROLS IN THE AOR, BOTH BY DAY AND NIGHT.

(ii) **GITI COMMUNE**. THE PATROL WAS INFORMED BY THE LOCAL PEOPLE THAT THE RPA PRESENCE IN THE COMMUNE HAD REDUCED TO ONLY TWO SOLDIERS. THIS WAS CONFIRMED BY THE SECRETARY TO THE BOURGMESTRE.

(iii) **KIYOMBE COMMUNE**. THE PATROL OBSERVED A STRENGTH OF 20-30 RPA SOLDIERS FROM RUSHAKI (GR 1139) PATROLLING ALONG ROAD KIYOMBE - BYUMBA. THEY WERE IN SEARCH OF A MAN INVOLVED IN THE THEFT OF MEDICINE FROM THE RUSHAKI HEALTH CENTRE; THE MAN IN CHARGE OF THE STOCK HAD BEEN ARRESTED ON 06 NOV 95 NIGHT AND IS

UNDER IMPRISONMENT IN THE RUSHAKI CELL.

3. **OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES**

- a. **SECTOR HQ.** COORD OF GENERAL ACTIVITIES IN AOR.

4. **HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES**

(a) **GITI COMMUNE.** THE GITI DISPENSARY, SUPPORTED BY MALTESAR (GERMANY) IS FACING A SHORTAGE OF MEDICINE - THIS WAS REPORTED BY THE SISTER - IN - CHARGE. THE DISEASES PREVALENT ARE DYSENTRY AND DIARRHOEA.

(b) **MURAMBI COMMUNE.**

(i) **GAKONI ORPHANAGE (GR 461962).** THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT THERE WERE A TOTAL OF 222 ORPHANS; ONE BOY AGED 17 YEARS DIED OF AN ELECTRIC SHOCK WHEN HE TAMPERED WITH THE ELECTRIC WIRES IN THE CENTRE. THE DIRECTOR ALSO INFORMED THAT HE HAS PLACED A REQUEST OF 06/07 TONS OF RICE TO CARITAS AT BYUMBA.

(ii) **KAZIGURO HOSPITAL (GR 425049).** A VACCINATION DRIVE AGAINST MENINGITIS HAS SINCE BEEN COMPLETED IN MUHURA, RUTARE AND GITI COMMUNES. HOWEVER, THESE DAYS AN AVERAGE OF 10 CHILDREN ARE BEING ADMITTED DAILY WITH AILMENTS OF MALARIA AND DIAHRROEA.

(c) **KIYOMBE COMMUNE.** 10 TONS OF BEANS WERE PROVIDED BY WFP ON 06 NOV 95 FOR DISTRIBUTION AMONG RETURNEES AND THE POOR.

5. CIVIL AFFAIRS

(a) MURAMBI COMMUNE. THE COMMUNE CELL HAS A TOTAL OF 13 INMATES; 11 ACCUSED OF THE GENOCIDE. THE PRILIMINARY INVESTIGATIONS ARE BEING CONDUCTED BY THE COMMUNE AUTHORITIES. THERE IS ACCUTE SHORTAGE OF FOOD; THE SAME IS BEING PROVIDED BY THE RELATIVES OF THE INMATES.

6. MISC**(a) RECOVERY OF EXPLOSIVES**

(i) RUTARE COMMUNE. THE PATROL SPOTTED FIVE MORTAR BOMBS ALONGSIDE ROAD TO THE COMMUNE AT GR 173118 IN MATYAZO CELL OF KINGOGO SECTOR OF RUTARE COMMUNE. THE AREA HAS BEEN MARKED AND THE LOCAL RPA AND COMMUNE AUTHORITIES HAVE BEEN INFORMED AND SHOWN THE SITE.. THERE IS A REQUIREMENT OF THE EOD TEAM TO DE-ACTIVATE THESE BOMBS.

(ii) KIYOMBE COMMUNE. LOCALS SPOTTED A ROCKET LAUNCHED GRENADE AT GR 0536 AND IT WAS RECOVERED BY THE RPA SOLDIERS TO THEIR STATION AT MULINDI.



(a) RUTARE COMMUNE

(i) A UNICEF SPONSORED VACCINATION PROGRAMME AGAINST MENINGITIS WAS CONDUCTED AT THE HEALTH CENTRE.

(ii) THE PATROL WAS APPROACHED BY THE DOCTOR OF THE HEALTH CENTRE FOR ASSISTANCE IN REPAIRING THEIR AMBULANCE. THE REQUEST IS BEING ROUTED THROUGH THE HAC.

(b) MUKARANGE COMMUNE. THE RUSHAKI HEALTH CENTRE (GR 1139) HAS PROJECTED AN ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT OF 20 BEDS TO CATER FOR THE INCREASE IN INFLOW OF PATIENTS (THERE ARE 10 BEDS AVAILABLE AT PRESENT). THE DAILY FIGURE OF PATIENTS BEING TREATED HAS GONE UP TO 300.

(c) BWISIGE COMMUNE. THE PATROL WAS APPROACHED TO ASSIST IN TRANSPORTATION OF SEEDS DELIVERED BY WFP TO THE BYUMBA PREFECTURE. THE *BOURGMESTRE* EMPHASISED THE NEED FOR PROVISION OF TRANSPORT ON PRIORITY AS THE PLANTING SEASON WOULD END AT THE END OF THIS WEEK.

6. MISC

(a) MINE ACCIDENT - MUKARANGE COMMUNE. THREE CHILDREN WERE INJURED ON 29 OCT 95 IN NYABISHAMBI SECTOR (GR 1027) WHEN THEY HIT ON AN UNEXPLODED MORTAR BOMB. INFORMATION ON THEIR PRESENT CONDITION COULD NOT BE OBTAINED.

(b) RETURNEES . THERE ARE PRESENTLY A TOTAL OF 87 RETURNEES / IDPs AT THE NEW TRANSIT CAMP UNDER CONSTRUCTION AT BYUMBA. INFORMATION GATHERED

INDICATED THAT THEY ARE LIKELY TO BE MOVED TO THEIR RESPECTIVE COMMUNES BY TOMORROW (07 NOV 95).



4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

a. BYUMBA COMMUNE THE PATROL TEAM VISITED ECOLE SOCIALE DE BYUMBA (ESB) . THE HEADMISTRESS OF THE MENTIONED SCHOOL INFORMED THE TEAM THAT LT COL FOX , CHAO VISITED THE SCHOOL BEFORE TWO MONTHS . DURING HIS VISIT REQUIREMENT OF REPLACING THE DEFECTIVE GENERATOR WAS BROUGHT TO HIS KNOWLEDGE AND CHAO TOLD THE SCHOOL AUTHORITY ABOUT UNAMIR'S ALL OUT POSSIBLE ASSISTANCE AND CO-ORDINATION IN THIS REGARD BUT SO FAR NO PROGRESS WAS MADE ON THE SUBJECT ISSUE . HENCE , THE HEADMISTRESS REQUESTED THE PATROL TEAM TO TAKE UP THE CASE TO THE CONCERNED END .

b. KIBALI COMMUNE THE PATROL TEAM EXCHANGED VIEWS WITH THE LOCAL PEOPLE ON THE WAY TO THEIR PATROL ROUTE . THE LOCALS INFORMED THEM THAT MOST OF THE RETURNEES HAVE ARRIVED THE COMMUNE FROM ZAIRE . UNHCR PROVIDED THE REQUIRED TRANSPORTATION FACILITY . BUT THESE RETURNEES WERE NOT PROVIDED WITH ANY REHABILITATIONAL HELP PACKAGE FROM ANY NGO OR UN AGENCIES . FURTHER MORE THE LOCAL ADMINISTRATION ARE ALSO SHOWING THEIR INDIFFERENT ATTITUDE TOWARDS THEM . THE TEAM POINTED OUT THAT WATER CRISIS IS THE MAJOR PROBLEM OF THE COMMUNE . MOST OF THE PIPE LINES BETWEEN THE WATER SOURCE AT RUHENDA (GR 0228) AND THE USER'S END ARE CORRODED.MOREOVER , THERE IS NO WATER PUMP .

THE SAME OFFICIAL REQUESTED FOR UNAMIR EXPERTS TO COME UP AND HAVE A LOOK AT THE AREA TARGETED THEREBY RECOMMENDING THE TYPE AND SIZE OF WATER PUMP REQUIRED FOR THE PURPOSE BEFORE THE NGO COULD BUY THE PUMP. - a. MURAMBI COMMUNE. THE MILOB TEAM VISITED KIZIGURO HOSPITAL. THERE ARE 70 BEDS AND 65 PATIENTS AT THE MOMENT. THE STAFF OF THE HOSPITAL CONSISTS OF 2 DOCTORS AND 2 NURSES FROM GERMANY, ONE LOGISTICIAN FROM BELGIUM AND LOCAL ADMINISTRATOR. AT THE MOMENT THEY HAVE ENOUGH MEDICINE BUT THERE IS A PROBLEM OF SECURITY. IT IS REPORTED THAT THE NGO

WOULD HAND OVER THE HOSPITAL TO CARITAS IN BYUMBA BUT IT WAS NOT CLEAR AS TO WHY THEY WERE TAKING SUCH A MOVE. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED GAKONI ORPHANAGE WHICH IS SUPPORTED BY ADRA AND THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ORPHANS IS 232. THERE ARE NO MAJOR PROBLEMS REPORTED AT THE ORPHANAGE SO FAR.

b. MUHURA COMMUNE THERE ARE TWO NGOS THAT ARE OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE, NAMELY CARITAS AND INTER SOS. CARITAS ARE RUNNING THE MUHURA HEALTH CENTRE WHILST INTER SOS ARE REHABILITATING SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE. MELTESER, ANOTHER NGO ACCASIONALLY ASSISTS THE BUGARURA DISPENSARY AND IT IS REPORTED THAT THE DISPENSARY LACKS POTABLE WATER. THE COMMUNE WAS GIVEN SOME 15 TONS OF FOOD BY ADRA AND ARE REQUESTING FOR TRANSPORT TO UP LIFT THE FOOD FROM KIGALI TO THE COMMUNE OFFICES TO HELP FEED THE RETURNEES WHO HAVE JUST COME FROM NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES AND ARE DESPERATE OF FOOD.
