1. It has been observed that your SITREPS of late contain unnecessary details which make them long for reading and tend to eclipse the required information.

2. The inclusion of names and ID numbers of members of a patrol clearly indicates that the SITREP is mistaken for a patrol report. At worst, routes could be mentioned if there is something to say about road conditions. Long stories under other headings not giving any significant information should also be avoided.

3. Importantly, care should be taken in editing the SITREP before it is sent. It is of no use to state correct names and ID numbers of members of a patrol and make unbelievable statements like "Donation of grenade by Australian EOD team "(Reference para 4 (d) of your SITREP of 05 MAY 95).

4. Please accept for necessary and immediate corrections.

5. A suggested format is enclosed.

b. KM-3 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN NYARUGENGE COMMUNE AND FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. THE PTL TRIED TO TALK TO PEOPLE ON THE STREET. THE LOCALS WERE SUSPICIOUS. IT TURNED OUT THAT THE PEOPLE HAVE INFORMATION (RADIO RWANDA) THAT UNAMIR PERSONNEL RAPS YOUNG GIRLS OR GIVES THEM MONEY FOR LOVE. THEY ALSO STATED THAT UNAMIR HAS LOST FACE AS MILOBS HAVE BEEN OBSERVING KILLING AND DID NOT INTERVENE. AFTER A LONGER DISCUSSION IT WAS POSSIBLE TO EXPLAIN THESE PEOPLE THAT MILOBS WERE NOT ABLE TO INTERVENE AS THEIR POSSIBILITIES ARE VERY LIMITED IF THE HOST COUNTRIES AUTHORITIES DO NOT COMPLY WITH THE CONTRACTS THEY HAVE SIGNED. STILL UNAMIR HAS TO THINK ABOUT AN IMAGE BRUSH UP ASAP AND SHOULD STRONGLY PROTEST ACCUSATIONS VIA RADIO RWANDA WHICH ARE NOT YET PROVED.

AFTER ARRIVING AT THE RD BLOCK THEY FOUND MR RASSHOUSEN WITH UNAMIR 1944 HR AND A 2ND MEMBER OF HR (DIDN'T WEAR HIS ID OPENLY) IN UNAMIR 1920 HR WAITING FOR ADVICE. WE TOLD HR STAFF THAT SEARCHES ARE NOW A DAYS ACCEPTED. HR STAFF DECLARED THAT THEY HAD DIFFERENT INSTRUCTIONS AND WOULD LIKE TO WAIT UNTIL THEIR HQ WOULD ADVISE THEM TO BE SEARCHED. WHILE THIS DISCUSSION WENT ON RPA THREATENED TO SEARCH THE VEHICLES BY FORCE. WE PERSUADED THEM TO WAIT UNTIL THE LO UNAMIR TO HR WOULD ARRIVE. SEARCH BY FORCE WAS NOT PERFORMED. AFTER ARRIVAL OF LO HR VEHICLES WERE SEARCHED IN A VERY PARTICULAR WAY FOR ABOUT 30 MINUTES. EVEN PERSONAL LETTERS, FILES AND LEAVELETS WERE LOOKED AT SIDE BY SIDE. PERSONAL LETTERS WERE COMPLETELY READ. NOTHING WAS FOUND TO JUSTIFY THE SEARCH AND EVERYTHING WAS GIVEN BACK TO THE OWNERS. THE VEH OF SEC 6 WAS ALSO SEARCHED. THE DISCUSSIONS AROUND THE SEARCH WERE TOUGH BUT FAIR AND NOT HOSTILE.

IT IS BELIEVED THAT UNAMIRs ADMINISTRATION SHOULD PASS ON ESSENTIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THOSE IT CONCERNS IN A MORE EFFICIENT WAY AND SHOULD GIVE PEOPLE ON THE GROUND TIME TO ADJUST TO NEW REGULATIONS.



HE CLAIMED THAT THE PERSON WHO DIED HAD BEEN BEATEN UP BY SOLDIERS IN THE YEAR 1990 AND HAD NEVER RECOVERED SINCE THEN. ADDITIONALLY THE PTL BROUGHT DETAILED INFO ABOUT PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE. MORE DETAILS SEE PTL REP.

b. KM-2 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN RUBUNGO COMMUNE AND FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. THEY COLLECTED INFO ABOUT SCHOOLS AND TRIED TO SPEAK TO AN RPA COMDR IN KABUGA GR 246819. THE PTL WAS NOT WELCOMED. THE PTL SAW A PRISON THERE AND WAS TOLD THAT 2 PRISONERS WERE JAILED THERE. PTL SUSPECTS ABOUT 50 PERSONS THERE AND RECOMMENDS TO HAVE THIS MATTER INVESTIGATED BY HUMAN RIGHTS.

c. KM-3 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN KANOMBE COMMUNE AND FOUND THE SITUATION CALM AND QUIET. THEY FOUND OUT THAT 250 RETURNERS HAVE COME TO GAHANGA SECTURE UNTIL THE 10 MAR 95 SINCE THE WAR STOPPED. THEY WERE NOT ALLOWED TO VISIT A PRISON AT KAGASA GR 774121. NO INFO ABOUT THE PRISONERS WERE GIVEN. AN OTHER CASE FOR INVESTIGATION FOR HUMAN RIGHTS.

THEY WERE GIVEN AGUIDED TOUR THROUGH THE AREA WHICH COVERS ABOUT 2-3 SQKM. THE CHIEF IS MR RAVEN FROM GERMANY. HE EMPLOYS AN OTHER 3 GERMANS AND ABOUT 45 LOCALS WHICH IS ONLY ONE THIRD OF THE STRENGTH BEFORE THE WAR. THIS STATION ALSO TAKES CARE OF THE SHORT WAVE SERVICE OF RWANDA. IN THE AREA OF THE RADIO BROADCASTING STATION GR 125885 THERE ARE SEVERAL BOD. MANAGER REQUESTS CLEARING SO THEY CAN CUT THE GRASS AROUND THE ANTENNAS AND BUILDING TO REDUCE THE FIRE HAZARD IN THE DRY PERIODS.

PTL WENT TO SEE HEALTH CENTER OF KINYINYA GR 124882 WHICH HAS ONE MED ASSISTANT AND 3 NURSES EMPLOYED .THEY EARN 30000 RFR/MONTH. SALARY WAS PROVIDED BY MSF UNTIL FEBRUARY 95. NOW

THIS HAS BECOME A GOVERNMENT RESPONSIBILITY. PATIENTS HAVE TO PAY FOR TREATMENT 50 RPF THAT HAS REDUCED THE FLOW OF PATIENTS FROM ABOUT 100 PATIENTS TO 30 PATIENTS A DAY. THE CENTRE HAS 50 BEDS. MOST COMMON DECEASES ARE MALARIA AND LUNG INFECTIONS. THERE IS NO PROBLEM WITH ELECTRICITY AND WATER. MR ALFRED THE MANAGER COMPLAINS ABOUT NO TELEPHONE AND NO RADIO FOR THE HOSPITAL.

- b. KM-3 DID A ROUTINE PTL IN BUTAMWA COMMUNE AND FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. THE PTL HEARD A RUMOUR FROM DIFFERENT LOCAL SOURCES THAT THE HUTUS FEAR THAT RPA AND FANATIC TUTSIS MIGHT CELEBRATE THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT ON THE 6/7 APRIL 95 WITH HARASSMENT AND MURDER OF HUTUS AND THAT NEW RIOTS AND FIGHTS MIGHT BREAK OUT.
