1. SITUATIONA. GENERAL. CALM.B. BORDER.REMERA BP 420899 - NORMAL CROSSING.
AKABUGA BC 499887 - NORMAL CROSSING.2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.A. POLITICAL. NTR.B. MILITARY. NTR.3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.A. SECTOR HQ. THE SECTOR HQ COORDINATED ACTIVITIES OF TEAMS AND MONITORED THEIR PROGRESS.

B. TEAM 1. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL MUSEBEYA COMMUNE (4033). THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT 8 RETURNEES HAD COME TO THE COMMUNE DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER. THEY HAVE REJOINED WITH THEIR FAMILIES. THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 400 IDPs IN THE COMMUNE AWAITING TRANSPORT TO RETURN TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES. THE IPJ IN THE COMMUNE HAS TRIED AND RELEASED A FEW PRISONERS. THERE ARE 11 PRISONERS IN THE CACHOTS OF MUSEBEYA AND MUKO AWAITING TRANSFER TO GIKONGORO PRISON. THE SECURITY SITUATION IS GENERALLY CALM. HOWEVER TODAY MORNING SOME SHOTS WERE HEARD FIRED IN THE BUSHIGISHIGI SECTOR, POSSIBLY BY SOME MISCREANTS SYMPATHETIC TO THE FORMER GOVERNMENT. THE CRETE-ZAIRE-NIL PROJECT FOR AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT IS STILL NOT FUNCTIONAL THOUGH A STATEMENT WAS MADE BY THE GOVERNMENT THAT THE PROJECT WOULD BE ACTIVATED EARLIEST.

C. TEAM 2. THE TEAM WAS STAND BY DUE TO NON AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

D. TEAM 3. THE TEAM WAS STAND BY DUE TO NON AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

E. TEAM 4. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL RUKONDO COMMUNE (5538). THE TEAM WAS INFORMED OF BANDITRY ACTIVITIES IN KIRAMBI SECTOR (6233). IT WAS REPORTED BY THE LOCALS THAT SOME OF THE BANDITS WEAR MILITARY UNIFORM AND CARRY FIREARMS AND MACHETE. THE BANDITS ARE SUSPECTED TO BE FROM NYABISINDU COMMUNE OF BUTARE PREFECTURE. THE IRISH PRIEST FATHER NICOLAS TOLD THE TEAM OF THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WHERE REPORTEDLY A MASS GRAVE IS LOCATED BEHIND THE PRIMARY SCHOOL. APPARENTLY NO LOCAL INFORMS THE AUTHORITIES OF THE GRAVE AND A WOMAN WHO INFORMED THE PRIEST OF THE GRAVE DIED A WEEK AFTER THE MATTER WAS REPORTED. THERE HAVE BEEN NO ARRESTS FROM THE SECTOR FOR REASONS OF GENOCIDE AS IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE LOCALS ARE ABSOLUTELY SILENT ON THE ISSUE AND DO NOT GIVE ANYONE AWAY. FATHER NICOLAS IS OF THE OPINION THAT THE BANDITRY ACTIVITIES COULD BE RELATED TO THE INCIDENTS MENTIONED ABOVE. IN KIRAMBI SECTOR THE SURVIVORS OF GENOCIDE DO NOT WISH TO RETURN. EFFORTS BY FATHER NICOLAS TO BUILD HOUSES FOR THE SURVIVORS OF GENOCIDE HAS NOT SUCCEEDED AS THE LOCALS REFUSE TO ASSIST AND THE SURVIVORS FEAR RETURN.

F. TEAM 5. THE TEAM WAS ON STAND BY DUE TO NON-AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THE ORPHANAGE AT GATARE, MUSEBEYA COMMUNE (4033) WAS VISITED TODAY. THERE ARE 47 CHILDREN IN THE ORPHANAGE FROM AGES ONE TO SIXTEEN YEARS. THE ORPHANAGE IS RUN BY AN ITALIAN CATHOLIC ORGANIZATION "SOVURS DU DIVINZELE". CARITAS ASSISTS THE ORPHANAGE WITH FOOD AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES. THE ORPHANAGE IS FACING PROBLEMS OF WATER AND ELECTRICITY. THERE IS NO SOURCE OF WATER AVAILABLE TO THE ORPHANAGE AND THE SISTERS HAVE MENTIONED THAT THEY ARE TRYING TO BUILD SOME CHANNELS ALONG THE ROOF TO COLLECT RAIN WATER. WATER AND ELECTRICITY WERE BEING PROVIDED BY THE CRETE-ZAIRE-NIL PROJECT BEFORE THE WAR, BUT SINCE THE PROJECT IS NOW NOT FUNCTIONAL THE ASSISTANCE IS NOT FORTHCOMING. THE SISTERS HAVE REQUESTED ASSISTANCE FOR WATER STORAGE FACILITIES AND BLANKETS FOR THE CHILDREN.

THE TEAM LEARNT THAT THE FIRST PHASE WOULD BE COMPLETE BY THE END OF DECEMBER OR EARLY JANUARY AND THE FACTORY WOULD GO STRAIGHT INTO PRODUCTION. THE TEAM WAS ALSO TOLD THAT THE SECOND PHASE WOULD COMMENCE IMMEDIATELY ON COMPLETION OF THE FIRST PHASE. THE FACTORY LACKS SKILLED LABOUR, MEDICAL FACILITIES AND THE WORKERS EXPRESSED FEAR OF ATTACK AND ARBITRARY ARRESTS AT THE FACTORY.

8. MISC. TODAY, AROUND 1500HRS AN RPA LIAISON OFFICER AND TWO OTHER SOLDIERS TRAVELLING FROM CYANGUGU TO GIKONGORO HAD AN ACCIDENT BETWEEN BUGARAMA COMMUNE OF CYANGUGU AND GIKONGORO. THE DRIVER PANICKED AFTER A TYRE BURST AND LOST CONTROL ENDING IN THE VEHICLE HITTING A TREE. MEMBERS SUSTAINED MINOR INJURIES AND WERE EVACUATED TO MALI COY FOR TREATMENT. THE VEHICLE WAS ALSO TOWED TO MALI COY COMPLEX.

THERE ARE 10 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT. 4 HAVE BEEN ACCUSED OF PARTICIPATING IN THE GENOCIDE, 1 FOR RAPE, 3 FOR CATTLE THEFT AND 2 FOR LAND DISPUTES. 13 PEOPLE ARRIVED IN THE COMMUNE DURING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER. NOVEMBER HAS NOT REGISTERED ANY RETURNEES. THE PEOPLE HAVE EXPRESSED GREAT APPREHENSION DUE TO THE EXPECTED CLOSURE OF UNAMIR.

1. UNAMIR CIVPOL HQ continued coordination and monitoring of activities of CIVPOL Observers in Prefectures.

2. The security situation in the country continues to be calm.

3. UNAMIR CIVPOL Observer Teams in the Prefectures continued patrols and monitoring in AOR and reported as follows :

3.1 KIGALI PREFECTURE Sector 1 A / Theme: V.I.P. Visit
In a related development, a two day seminar on "Arrest and Detention" opened in Kigali on 10.11.1995 under the auspices of UNICEF and UNHCHR. The seminar attracted local officials and military authorities, including NGO's personnel. The Force Commander paid a working visit to CIVPOL HQS in TRAMPRO complex on 10.11.1995. The Force Commander who was briefed by the CIVPOL Commissioner about the structure and deployment of CIVPOL, later inspected the various divisions and offices of CIVPOL Headquarters. The visit was rounded up with a brief remarks, in which the Force Commander commended CIVPOL's achievements so far. Observers at the National Gendarmerie Training School at Kigali are in progress.

3.2 PMT - KIGALI PREFECTURE Sector 1 A / Theme: Prison

The team visited Kigali central prison and reported that one inmate died on 09.11.1995 from natural causes occasioned by illness.

The deputy director of the institution who gave the current number of inmates to be 10,513, said plans are on to transfer at least 1,000 inmates to other prison facilities within Rwanda.

3.3 **PMT - BUTARE PREFECTURE** Sector 3 B / Theme: Prison & Banditry

The team carried out patrols of NYARUHENGERI Commune and reported that the Commune Bourgmestre has appealed for transportation assistance to facilitate the transfer of 90 inmates to NYANZA prison. Expatriating further, 40 of the 120 prisoners in a makeshift prison were transferred on 30.10.1995 and ever since, the commune has no other means to complete the transfer process.

In another development, the team reported that unspecified number of Rwandese refugees from BURUNDI, armed with machetes and other dangerous weapons crossed into KIGEMBE and KIBUYE Communes in BUTARE prefecture and attacked local residents. Continuing, the report further stated, that cattle and other personal effects of locals in affected Communes were carted away by the bandits, who have since escaped into BURUNDI with their loot. The RPA Commander in BUTARE, in a swift reaction to the incident, deployed a company strength of soldiers to the border Communes to stem the menace of armed bandits in the area.
