In a letter dated 27 November 1962, you were appointed Forestry Officer (Provincial Forestry Adviser) under the Technical Assistance agreement between FAO and the Government of the Republic of the Congo (Léopoldville). The terms of your assignment are as follows :

"Within the framework of a well-defined Federal Forest Policy, you will apply and implement, at the provincial level, more detailed forest programs, taking into account local economic and social circumstances. You will participate in training local staff and in the establishment of a research program."

The following instructions are to confirm those given to you verbally during your briefing period in Rome.

You will proceed to Leopoldville, where you should present your letter of introduction to Mr. R.D. Chaturvedi, FAO Senior Consultant for Agriculture in the Republic of the Congo (address: ONUC, Hotel Royale, Boulevard Albert, Léopoldville), who will introduce you to Mr. R. Müller, the FAO Forestry Team Leader, and to officials and technicians with whom you will be in regular contact during your assignment. In consultation with the Government and Mr. Müller, Mr. Chaturvedi will determine your duty station in the Congo.

I should also like to draw your attention to the name of Mr. S. Habib Ahmed, Resident Representative of the United Nations Technical Assistance Board, and Director of Special Fund Programs in the Congo. The Technical Assistance Board is composed of one representative each from the United Nations and each of the specialized agencies carrying out work under the technical assistance program. The representative of TAB is, therefore, primarily concerned with overall coordination of the program of the various agencies, and Mr. Ahmed will be in a position to assist you on any problems requiring his attention. Mr. Ahmed can be contacted at the same address as Mr. Chaturvedi.

Upon arrival in Leopoldville, it will be necessary, depending on circumstances, for you to spend a certain amount of time in acquainting yourself with further details of the background of your work. This will include not only technical conversations and studies of documentation on the purely professional aspect of your work, but familiarizing yourself with the cultural and human background of the people of the Republic of the Congo (Leopoldville).

In conclusion, I should like to add that I have confidence in your professional qualifications and your personality. The program of technical assistance is an undertaking on which we all set the highest hopes, not only for the improvement of the standard of living of the people the world over, but also one of the most hopeful projects yet to be undertaken in the interests of enduring peace.

I cannot stress too strongly the responsibility that falls upon all of us concerned with this work. I am certain that you feel this responsibility as greatly as those who are endeavouring to implement the program at this Headquarters and that you will discharge your duties accordingly.

Subject : Technical Assistance Projects for FAO

1. We have been asked by Mr. Amachree to submit to him our revised estimates for the Programme for 1963, in the light of the present position on the progress of the projects and of recruitment of experts as well as of other factors.

2. In the case of the FAO Programme it has been, as you know, decided to proceed with a limited implementation of the recommendations of the FAO Mission on the rehabilitation of food and agriculture in the country. Accordingly, it is proposed that Project 01-01 be reorganized and that a new project submission be prepared under N° 01-02 to include all elements of the rehabilitation programme. For the purpose of preparing the two project sheets separately we propose that each of the two projects cover the following.

01-01.

We suggest that this project should include the following: Senior Consultant, Assistant to Senior Consultant, Marketing Expert, Commodities expert, Cooperation, credit, import and exports expert, Adviser on agricultural research, Teacher for Lovanium - Diploma Course, tea maker, coffee expert.

All other posts except the following should be transferred to the new Project 01-02 as constituting elements of that project. The exceptions are: Farm Mechanics Training Expert, Poultry Expert. These experts, it is suggested, should be transferred to their respective projects: 01-04 and 01-11 respectively.

01-02

This project should include the 83 experts and technicians initially required to implement the recommendations of the FAO Mission. The following posts included in 01-01 will be absorbed among the 83 posts: 5 Forestry Advisers, 12 Provincial Agricultural Advisers and Agronomists, 8 Veterinarians and one Inland Fisheries Expert.



3. I should be grateful if the descriptions of the various projects mentioned above are revised to conform to the present position as outlined above and, in particular, a comprehensive description written for the new project Q1-Q2 summarizing the recommendations of the Mission and the objectives of the project and the manner in which it is proposed to be carried out. The ultimate expansion of the programme to cover the full personnel requirements set out in the Mission's report should be mentioned in our narrative though budget provision should be made for the time being for 83 posts only.

4. The submission of the revised project handbook to New York is extremely urgent and I would like the revised FAO programme to be included in it rather than left out for subsequent inclusion. Mr. Thompson will provide you with the revised calculations for each of the projects if required but I hope that it would be possible to have narratives revised and written so as to be available in draft form by Wednesday 20 March. This will enable us to include the narratives in the revised project handbook which we plan to send to New York by pouch on Friday.
