TEXT OF MEMORANDUM DATED 16 JANUARY  
FROM SECRETARY-GENERAL TRYGVE LIE TO UN STAFF

To: Members of the Staff  
From: The Secretary-General  
Subject: Advisory Panel

1. In the memorandum addressed to the members of the staff on 4 December 1952, I announced that I had decided to establish the Advisory Panel proposed by the Commission of Jurists in their report of 29 November 1952 (A/INF/51), to assist me in dealing with certain cases of staff members charged with subversion.

2. I have now appointed the Advisory Panel under the chairmanship of Mr. Leonard W. Brockington, Q.C., L.L.D., of Canada. I intend shortly to appoint an alternate chairman to serve in the absence of the chairman.

3. The members of the Panel will be as follows:

Mr. Ralph Bunche, Principal Director, Department of Trusteeship  
and Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories

Mr. Tor Gjesdal, Principal Director, Department of Public Information

Mr. Gustavo Martinez-Cabañas, Deputy Director-General, Technical  
Assistance Administration

Mr. Constantin A. Stavropoulos, Principal Director in charge of the  
Legal Department,

Two of the above members, in addition to the chairman or alternate chairman, will serve in each case.

4. The Panel's detailed terms of reference will be issued after the General Assembly has dealt with the question of personnel policy at the second part of its seventh session. For the time being, the Panel will have the function of advising the Secretary-General in cases referred to it by him.
