i) THE OPSO CONDUCTED A LIAISON VISIT TO SECTOR 5 HQ TODAY TO DISCUSS THE PROBLEMS CREATED BY THE PRESENT BOUNDARY BETWEEN OUR SECTORS. IT WAS AGREED THAT SECTOR THREE COULD DO A MUCH BETTER JOB OF SERVICING THE FOUR COMMUNES THAT LIE WITHIN THE GITARAMA PREFECTURE THAN SECTOR FIVE IS CURRENTLY ABLE TO DO. MOREOVER, ADJUSTING THE BOUNDARY ALONG THE PREFECTURE BOUNDARY WOULD GREATLY SIMPLIFY RELATIONS WITH THE RPA SINCE THEIR BOUNDARIES CORRESPOND WITH THE PREFECTURE.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE TEAM ESCORTED A BROWN AND ROOT CONVOY FROM KIGALI TO GIKONGORO AND BACK. THE CONVOY CONSISTED OF ONE VEHICLE. GIVEN THE SECURITY SITUATION AND THE NUMBER OF UN VEHICLES TRAVELLING THE MAIN ROAD ON A REGULAR BASIS, THE NEED FOR ESCORTS TO SINGLE VEHICLE CONVOYS IS NOT UNDERSTOOD.

ii) A HUMANITARIAN TEAM FROM KIGALI VISITED THE SECTOR HQ, WERE BRIEFED ON THE SITUATION IN NTONGWE AND PROCEEDED TO NTONGWE COMMUNE TO INVESTIGATE THE PROBLEMS WITH THE ORC.

iii) IT WAS CONFIRMED TODAY THAT CHARGES AGAINST THE HAKIZIMANA, JULIEN (SEE SITREP 16 JAN) HVE BEEN DROPPED AND HE HAS BEEN ALLOWED TO RETURN TO HIS COMMUNE IN PEACE. THIS CAME ABOUT AS A DIRECT RESULT OF GOOD FOLLOW UP BY HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM IN GITARAMA UNDER MR GHANDI.

iv) PLANNING FOR MOVE OF SECTOR 3 HQ BEGAN IN EARNEST TODAY. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THERE WILL BE SOME DISRUPTIONS IN COMMS NEAR THE END OF THE MONTH WHEN THE MOVE TAKES PLACE DUE TO LACK OF STEP UP FACILITIES.

ENCOUNTER GREAT DIFFICULTIES FORWARDING MESSAGES THAT ARE SENT TO US FOR BUTARE. IT IS IRONIC THAT THE ONLY HQ WE CANNOT COMMUNICATE WITH BY PHONE IS THE ONE THAT WE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR. REQUEST THAT SOME ATTEMPT BE MADE TO FIX THIS PROBLEM.

THE RUKONDO CAMP VISIT WAS AN APPARENT SUCCESS.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

- i) ONE TEAM PATROLLED TO RUNDA COMMUNE AND OBSERVED DISTRIBUTION OF HOES AND SORGUM SEEDS BY CARE INTERNATIONAL. IN DISCUSSION WITH THE BOURGEMESTRE THEY WERE ADVISED OF FOUR UNREPORTED MASS GRAVES. TIME DID NOT PERMIT INVESTIGATION.
- ii) THE RPA LO ADVISED THAT THE THREE PERSONS WHO HAD BEEN ARRESTED IN NTONGWE DURING THE COMMUNE VISIT WOULD NOT BE RELEASED OWING TO THE STRENGTH OF THE EVIDENCE AND THE POTENTIAL DIFFICULTY THAT THIS WOULD CAUSE WITH THEIR OWN POPULATION. THIS MATTER IS CONSIDERED CLOSED.
- iii) A MEETING WAS HELD IN GITARAMA WITH REPS FROM UNAMIR, UNREO, UNHCR, UNHCHR AND THE RPA TO DISCUSS SECURITY ISSUES RELATED TO OP RETOUR. IT WAS AGREED THAT THE BEST COMMON OBJECTIVE WOULD BE TRANSPARENCY OF JUSTICE. TO THIS END, ALL CONCERNED WILL ATTEMPT TO MONITOR EACH STEP OF THE PROCESS OF RETURN. THE UNREO REP ANNOUNCED A PLAN TO ORGANIZE A COMMUNE VISIT FROM ONE OF THE CAMPS TO KIGOMA COMMUNE NEXT TUESDAY. ALL IS READY AT THE ORC BUT IT WAS AGREED THAT THE VISIT SHOULD NOT TAKE PLACE UNLESS A LIST OF VISITORS CAN BE CLEARED THROUGH THE BOURGEMESTRE TO PREVENT A RECURRENCE OF THE NTONGWE TROUBLES. UNREO WILL FOLLOW UP AND UNAMIR WILL COORDINATE THE CLEARANCE OF THE LIST ONCE IT IS PROVIDED.
- iv) SECTOR COMMANDER ATTENDED THE FORCE COMMANDER'S CONFERENCE.

1. GENERAL SITUATION
CALM

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

THE BOURGEMESTRES OF MASANGO AND MURAMA WERE ESCORTED TO RUKONDO CAMP TO ADDRESS THE POPULATION OF THEIR COMMUNES. NO INFORMATION AVAILABLE ON OUTCOME UNTIL TOMORROW.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A.GITARAMA TEAM

i) TWO TEAMS WERE SENT TO ESCORT THE BOURGEMESTRES OF MASANGO AND MURAMA TO RUKONDO. THIS WAS CARRIED OUT IN COOPERATION WITH UNREO AND THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT AND APPEARED TO GO WELL. MORE TO FOLLOW TOMORROW.

ii) A CIVPOL TEAM WENT TO NTONGWE TO TAKE UP THE ISSUE OF THE THREE PERSONS ARRESTED FROM THE GROUP ON COMMUNE VISIT FROM CYANIKA CAMP. THE CIVPOL TEAM WAS ABLE TO CONFIRM THAT THE THREE ARE IN CUSTODY AND THAT TWO OF THEM HAVE BEEN POSSITIVELY IDENTIFIED BY RELATIVES OF THE PERSONS THEY ARE ALLEDGED TO HAVE KILLED. THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES PROMISED A FINAL DECISION ON WHETHER TO RELEASE OR RETAIN THESE PEOPLE AS SOON AS THEY ARE ABLE TO DISCUSS THE MATTER WITH THE PROCURER.

iii) THE CIVPOL TEAM PROCEEDED TO MUGINA TO INVESTIGATE THE ALLEGATION THAT 9 PERSONS HAD BEEN ARRESTED FOR HAVING BEEN SEEN TALKING TO UNAMIR. THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAVE LAID MURDER CHARGES AGAINST ALL OF THEM. THE ALLEGATION APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN AN INVENTION.

iv) A MILOB TEAM TRANSPORTED A DIABETES PATIENT TO KIGALI AND ARRANGED FOR TREATMENT.

v) SECTOR OPSO ATTENDED A MEETING WITH HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM AND CO 31ST BN RPA TO DISCUSS SEVERAL ARRESTS INCLUDING THE 3

ARRESTED YESTERDAY AT NTONGWE, THE 9 ARRESTED IN NTONGWE COMMUNE PRESENTLY BEING HELD IN MUGINA DETENTION FACILITY AND THE ATTEMPTED ARREST OF THE RWANDESE NATIONAL CURRENTLY UNDER UNAMIR PROTECTION IN GITARAMA. THE MEETING WAS VERY POSITIVE AND CONCLUDED WITH AN AGREEMENT THAT THESE ISSUES WOULD BE LOOKED INTO QUICKLY. TO BE FOLLOWED UP TOMORROW.

i) MALICOY CONFIRMED EARLY THIS MORNING THAT THE MISSING PERSON FROM THE COMMUNE VISIT TO NTONGWE HAD BEEN ARRESTED. MALICOY TRANSPORTED THE REMAINING 10 PERSONS AS FAR AS BUTARE WHERE THEY HAD A VEHICLE ACCIDENT. A CIVPOL REPORT WILL BE FORWARDED SEPARATELY. THE TEN PERSONS COMPLETED THE TRIP WITH MALAWICOY.

ii) ONE VEH WAS PROVIDED TO MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE FOR BRIDGE REPAIR. ANOTHER VEHICLE WAS PROVIDED TO RECOVER AN RPA VEHICLE THAT HAD BEEN IN AN ACCIDENT.

iii) MALI NATIONAL ARMY DAY TOMORROW. TODAY WAS SPENT IN PREPARATION FOR CELEBRATION; NO PATROLS.

MILOB VEHICLE 1097 WAS SENT TO KIGALI FOR THE THIRD TIME TODAY TO TRY TO HAVE A RADIO INSTALLED. DESPITE PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS, IT COULD NOT BE DONE. EACH TIME THE VEHICLE IS SENT, A PATROL TASK MUST BE CANCELLED. TOMORROW ANOTHER TASK WILL BE CANCELLED SO THAT A FURTHER ATTEMPT MAY BE MADE.

1. GENERAL SITUATION
CALM

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

THE PREFECT OF GITARAMA HELD A MEETING OF ALL BOURGEMESTRES TODAY. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE MAIN TOPIC WAS SECURITY. COMD 305 BDE, RPA ATTENDED.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

A. RPA. THE RPA YESTERDAY ARRESTED 9 OF THE 25 PERSONS WHO HAD TAKEN REFUGE WITH MALICOY IN NTONGWE SEVERAL MONTHS AGO. TODAY IT WAS ALLEDGED BY THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS THAT THE ARRESTS WERE A DIRECT RESULT OF CONTACT WITH UNAMIR. IT WAS CLAIMED THAT THE 9 HAD BEEN OBSERVED TALKING TO A MALICOY PATROL AND WERR SUBSEQUENTLY ARRESTED. THE MATTER IS BEING DISCUSSED THIS EVENING WITH COMD 305 BDE AND WILL BE TAKEN UP WITH THE BOURGEMESTRE TOMORROW.

B. RGF. NTR

C. MILITIA. A REPORT CAME TO LIGHT TODAY OF A NIGHT VISIT TO MURAMA COMMUNE BY 3 MEN FROM GIKONGORO AREA WHO CLAIMED TO HAVE MILITIA AFFILIATIONS AND WHO THREATENED TO KILL ALL THOSE WHO HAD RETURNED FROM THE CAMPS. THEY WERE CARRYING MACHETES AND ALLEDGEDLY THREATENED THEIR OWN PARENTS. THEY LEFT AS SOON AS THEY LEARNED OF THAT THE RPA HAD BEEN CALLED BUT NOT BEFORE USING THEIR MACHETES TO HACK DOWN A NUMBER OF CASAVA PLANTS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE TEAM WENT TO MASANGO, MURAMA AND RUKONDO. PURPOSE - ROUTE RECCE TO RUKONDO DPC. THE TEAM ALSO TIED UP DETAILS OF SECURITY FOR THE VISIT BY BOURGEMESTRES OF MASANGO & MURAMA TO RUKONDO DPC ON 19 JAN WITH ZAMBATT PL. THE TEAM ALSO OBSERVED THE DISTRIBUTION OF SEEDS AT MURAMA AND MASANGO BY THE CATHOLIC RELIEF ORGANISATION. THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE REPORTED THAT THERE HAD BEEN ONLY 150 RETURNEES DURING THE MONTH OF JAN. A NEWLY REPORTED MASS GRAVE FROM THE APR/MAY PERIOD WAS REPORTED. DETAILS TO FOLLOW BY 20 JAN.

ii) A SECOND MILOB TEAM WENT IN SEARCH OF MASS GRAVES IN THE MUYIRA, TAMBWE AND KIGOMA COMMUNES. A TOTAL OF 21 GRAVE SITES WERE REPORTED. THEY WERE ALLEGED TO CONTAIN OVER 10,000 BODIES IN TOTAL BUT IT WAS IMPOSSIBLE TO ESTIMATE THE VALIDITY OF THESE CLAIMS OWING TO THE DIFFERENCE IN SIZE AND SHAPE OF EACH AND DUE TO THE GRASS THAT HAS COMPLETELY COVERED EACH SITE. DETAILS TO FOLLOW BY 20 JAN.

B. BUTARE TEAM

1. ONE TEAM PATROLLED TO RUSATIRA (7431) FOR COMMUNE UPDATE. THE LOCAL RPA GUARD COMD REFUSED THEM ACCESS TO THE BOURGEMESTRE. THE GUARD NCO IC CLAIMED TO HAVE INSTRUCTIONS TO BAR UNAMIR ACCESS TO THE BOURGEMESTRE. NO RPA OFFICER COULD BE FOUND. THE ISSUE HAS BEEN TAKEN UP WITH RPA IN BUTARE.

2. ANOTHER TEAM PATROLLED TO KANYARU-HAUTI BORDER CROSSING AND REPORTED SITUATION CALM. 14 PEOPLE CROSSED INTO RWANDA FROM BURUNDI ON 17 JAN. NO INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE ON PERSONS LEAVING RWANDA.

C. MALI COY

i) LAST NIGHT IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE UNREO INITIATIVE TO ESCORT IDPS BACK TO THE COMMUNE OF NTONGWE HAD RUN INTO DIFFICULTIES. LAST NIGHT, THE MALICOY PL COMD IN NTONGWE, CAPT KONTE, SUCCEEDED IN CONVINCING THE BOURGEMESTRE TO ALLOW THE VISIT TO CARRY ON AS PLANNED. THE IDPS SPENT THE NIGHT IN THEIR HOME COMMUNES. THIS MORNING TWO WERE ARRESTED BY THE RPA AT THE REQUEST OF THE CONSEIL OF THEIR SECTOR. A THIRD FAILED TO SHOW UP BY THE TIME OF DEPARTURE AND COULD NOT BE FOUND BY AST LIGHT. THIS ISSUE WILL BE DISCUSSED WITH COMD 305 BDE THIS EVENING AND WILL BE PURSUED AGGRESSIVELY TOMORROW BY CIVPOL AND MILOBS. THE REMAINING TEN IDPS FROM CYANIKA CAMP HAVE BEEN BROUGHT BACK TO GITARAMA AND WILL BE KEPT HERE PART OF TOMORROW IN HOPE THAT THE OTHERS CAN BE BROUGHT TO JOIN THEM. THIS HAS SERIOUS POTENTIAL CONSEQUENCES FOR OP RETOUR.

ii) ONE VEH WAS PROVIDED TO FOOD FOR HUNGRY TO ASSIST WITH FOOD DISTRIBUTION IN THE MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE. A SECOND VEHICLE WAS PROVIDED TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL EVACUATION TO A DIABETES VICTIM FROM THE BYMANA SECTOR.

iii) PATROLS FROM MASANGO AND RUHANGO TO RUGOGWE (6956) AND KEROZO (6745). SIT CALM AND SEED AND TOOL DISTRIBUTION BY CARITAS WAS OBSERVED AT RUGOGWE.

D. MALAWI COY

i) SENT PATROLS TO KIHINGO (6313) AND RARANZINGE (6707). SIT CALM. PATROL TO RUGAUKA REPORTED THAT RPA HAD ARRESTED TWO SUSPECTS IN THE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED INCIDENT OF THEFT AT KARULEMERA (6110) ON 15 JAN.

ii) PROVIDED TRANSPORT TO TWO SERIOUSLY ILL RPA SOLDIERS FROM RUGALIKA CAMP (5606) TO UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL IN BUTARE.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

- i) MALICOY TREATED A TOTAL OF 43 RWANDESE PATIENTS TODAY.

1. RWABICUMA. NO ONE HAS RETURNED TO THIS SECTOR SINCE THE END OF THE WAR. NO NGO'S ASSISTANCE. CATHOLIC CHURCH DISTRIBUTED 4 KILOS OF MAISE, OIL, BEANS AND SOYAGRAM FOR EVERY LOCAL. NO MEDICAL ASSISTANCE DISPISTE HEAVY INCIDENCE OF MALARIA AND MEASELS. NO ELECTRICITY, NO CLEAN WATER. LOCALS REQUEST FARMING TOOLS, SEEDS AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE. THIS WILL BE DISCUSSED WITH MSF TOMORROW.

2. NYARUSANEE SECTOR. POPULATION WAS 6000 BEFORE THE WAR, 3000 KILLED, 1000 IN DPC AND ZAIRE. NO RETURNEES SINCE THE END OF THE WAR. NO MEDICAL ASSISTANCE; MANY MENENGITIS AND MALARIA CASES IN THE SECTOR. NO NGO ACTIVITIES. RPA PRESENCE, STR UNKNOWN. LOCALS REQUEST URGENT MEDICAL HELP, SEEDS AND FARMING TOOLS. MSF TO BE CONTACTED.

3. RUNGO SECTOR. (6539) POPULATION 674 FAMILIES AS COMPARED TO 2000, BEFORE THE WAR. 180-190 RETURNED FROM GIKONGORO DPC AND FROM ZAIRE. 1 NEWLY DISCOVERED MASS GRAVE OF 100 PERSONS (GR 6537). RPA : 1 SECTION. LOCALS IN THIS AREA VERY KEEN TO HAVE ALL THEIR NEIGHBOURS BACK WITH THEM.

4. ONE TEAM SENT TO NTONGWE REPORTED RPA SHOOTING APPROX 8 ROUNDS AT APPROX 0330 MORNING. SUBSEQUENT NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE LOCAL RPA REVEALED THAT THIS HAD BEEN PART OF A TRAINING EXERCISE AND LED TO A PROMISE OF EARLY NOTIFICATION FOR FUTURE EXERCISES AND AN APOLOGY. THE TEAM ALSO REPORTED THAT LOCALS WHO SPEAK WITH UNAMIR FEAR LATER RPA HARRASSEMENT. 10 OF THE 25 PERS WHO HAD SOUGHT REFUGE WITH MALICOY TWO MONTHS AGO AND WHO HAD BEEN RETURNED TO THEIR HOMES UNDER HUMAN RIGHTS SUPERVISION WERE REPORTED TO HAVE

BEEN CAPTURED BY RPA AND ILL-TREATED. THIS WILL BE FOLLOWED UP IN CONJUNCTION WITH HUMAN RIGHTS.

5. A PLAN INITIATED BY UNREO TO ESCORT 14 RETURNEES TO VISIT THERE HOME SECTORS IN THE NTONGWE COMMUNE RAN AFOUL OF A RELUCTANT BOURGEMESTRE WHO COULD NOT BE ADVISED AHEAD OF TIME DUE TO SHORT LEAD TIME. THE BOURGEMESTRE FURTHER OBSERVED TO THE MIL OB TEAM THAT HE DID NOT LIKE THE IDEA OF RECEIVING RETURNEES WITHOUT REGISTRATION AND WITHOUT NOTIFICATION. HE EXPLAINED THAT MANY RESIDENTS HAVE REASON TO FEAR SOME OF THE RETURNEES AND ADVISED THAT UNLESS WE HAD SOME SCREENING SYSTEM, THE LOCAL RPA WOULD BE OBLIGED TO ENSURE THAT UNAMIR WAS NOT IMPORTING CRIMINALS.

6. MILOB TEAMS ATTEMPTING TO GATHER INFORMATION ON SECTORS ARE HAMPERED BY LINGUISTIC DIFFICULTIES. MANY SECTORS HAVE NO ONE LEFT CAPABLE OF SPEAKING EITHER FRENCH OR ENGLISH. WE URGENTLY REQUIRE AT LEAST THREE MORE INTERPRETERS IF WE ARE TO CARRY OUT THE TASKS THAT WE HAVE BEEN GIVEN. AN INITIAL ATTEMPT TO RESOLVE THIS AT OUR LEVEL HAS BEEN STARTED BUT YOUR SUPPORT MAY BE REQUIRED TO ENSURE THAT UNAMIR HQ UNDERSTANDS THAT OUR NEED IS NOT FOR SCHOLARS BUT RATHER FOR PERSONS ABLE TO INTERPRET SIMPLE CONVERSATIONS FROM KINYARWANDA INTO EITHER FRENCH OR ENGLISH.

VISIT BY BOURGEMESTRES OF MASANGO AND MURAMA TO RUKONGO IDP CAMP WAS PLANNED TODAY FOR THURS, 19 JAN.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.A.GITARAMA TEAM

MILOB TEAMS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO SECTOR LEVEL IN BOTH MUYIRA AND NTONGWE COMMUNES. THE TEAM THAT WENT TO MUYIRA FOUND CONSEILS AVAILABLE IN NYAMIYAGA, MUTUTU AND MUNYNIYA. THE SECURITY SITUATION IN ALL THREE SECTORS WAS REPORTED AS VERY GOOD WITH NO PROPERTY DISPUTES AND SUFFICIENT HOUSING TO ACCOMODATE MOST OF THOSE WHO HAVE RETURNED. THIS COMMUNE WAS ONLY RECENTLY SETTLED AND MOST OF THE INHABITANTS FLED EARLY DURING THE WAR TO BURUNDI. CONSEQUENTLY, IT WAS SPARSELY POPULATED AND THERE WAS LITTLE DESTRUCTION. THERE WERE RELATIVELY FEW WAR DEATHS AND MOST OF THE POPULATION HAD ALREADY RETURNED. THE MAIN PROBLEM IS POOR DRINKING WATER. FARM TOOLS, SEEDS AND FOOD ARE ALSO IN SHORT SUPPLY AND THERE IS LITTLE NGO ACTIVITY IN THE AREA. THE TEAM THEN VISITED THE BRIDGE AT BUSORO AND FOUND THAT A SMALL FERRY HAS BEEN PUT INTO PLACE FOR FOOT AND BICYCLE TRAFFIC. THERE WERE ONLY TEN PEOPLE WORKING ON THE APPROACH AND THE ROAD LEADING FROM THE BRIDGE DUE WEST TO THE GITARAMA ROAD IS VIRTUALLY IMPASSABLE.

THE SECOND TEAM VISITED GITOVU, RUTOBU, KINAZI AND GAKO SECTORS OF NTONGWE COMMUNE. THE SECURITY SITUATION WAS REPORTED AS GOOD BUT THERE IS LITTLE FARMING ACTIVITY DUE TO A SEVERE SHORTAGE OF TOOLS AND SEEDS. FIGURES OF RETURNEES IN THE FIRST TWO SECTORS WERE ENCOURAGING HOWEVER THE CONSEILS OF EACH OF THE SECOND TWO HAD NO FIGURES AVAILABLE. ALL SECTORS HAD EXPERIENCED CONSIDERABLE DESTRUCTION AND, WHILE MOST PEOPLE ARE BACK IN THEIR OWN VILLAGES, MANY OF THEM ARE FORCED TO CAMP OUT BECAUSE THEIR HOMES WERE DESTROYED. THERE ARE NO MATERIALS AVAILABLE FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND FOOD IS IN SHORT SUPPLY. VERY LITTLE NGO ACTIVITY.

At approximately 1000h on 15 Jan 95, a Rwandese national by the name of HAKIZIMANA, YURIYANE took refuge with the Mali troops

at KABGUYI from 2 RPA soldiers in hot pursuit. They claimed that they had orders to arrest the civilian for murder. The civilian had come from NYAMABUYE commune, SHOGWE sector as part of the carrying party for his cousin, who was ill and had come by stretcher to KABGUYI for medical attention. The soldiers were requested to produce evidence of their orders. They could not and left. They have not come back. The civilian was given food and shelter for the night. The matter was passed to the GITARAMA Human Rights team on 16 Jan. They prepared a letter to the CO of 31st Bn, GITARAMA requesting help in resolving the matter. The civilian will be given asylum until a reply is received from the RPA. He will be turned over to them if the Bn Comd can assure us that he is aware of some evidence against M. HAKIZIMANA. If not, M. HAKIZIMANA will be transported back to SHOGWE and turned over to the counsellor of his sector with a request that he be charged properly or left alone.

- i) PATROL TO KABULEMERA SECTOR (GR 6110) IN RUNYINYA COMMUNE TO INVESTIGATE INCIDENT REPORTED LAST NIGHT IN WHICH TWO PEOPLE WERE MACHETED. THE TWO MEN, GABILO, AGE 23, AND ATAKALI, AGUSTIN, AGE 35, WERE ATTACKED BY A GANG OF MEN ALLEGEDLY FROM GIKONGORO. THE VICTIMS SUSTAINED HEAD WOUNDS AND WERE TREATED AT THE MSF FACILITY IN THEIR COMMUNE. THE BANDITS WERE ARMED WITH GRENADES, MACHETES AND STONES. THE RING LEADERS ARE SUSPECTED TO BE CYENERI, KALANGANI AND MUNYETWARI, RWAMAMANYWA, REPUTEDLY OUT OF KIBEHO DP CAMP. THE ATTACK STARTED WITH GRENADES. RPA WERE CALLED BY FAILED TO APPREHEND THE BANDITS. THEY ESCAPED WITH 5 COWS, SOME CLOTHES AND OTHER ITEMS.
- ii) PATROL SENT TO NDAGO (GR 5201) REPORTED THE SITUATION CALM THOUGH TWO MEN WERE MACHETED TO DEATH LAST NIGHT BY UNKNOWN ASSAILANTS. LOCALS STILL FEAR TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMES. THE KILLING HAS PROMPTED AN INCREASE IN RPA PATROLLING.

1. Information reaching this HQ indicates that certain MILOBs are spreading the news that UNAMIR HQ has approved the accumulation of CTO up to a maximum of 12 days. This information is NOT TRUE.

2. However to clear doubts, all MILOBs should be aware of how this false information on accumulation of CTO originated. The details are as below:


a. The UNAMIR draft SOPs had been amended to conform with UN Field Regulation after which a printing press in Nairobi was contracted to print the SOPs.

b. A covering letter for the SOPs headed "SOP AUTHORIZATION" was signed on 19 Dec 94 by the DFC/CMO on behalf of the Force Comd. This letter was to be sent to the printing press.

c. However, it is believed a staff officer made a copy of the covering letter and attached it to the draft SOPs which recommended the approval of CTO up to a maximum of 12 days. A copy of this false document found its way to Sector 2 without the knowledge of MILOBs GP HQ thus spreading the false information that the Force Comd has approved the accumulation of CTO.

3. All MILOBs are reminded that, the policy on CTO remains that only 6 days could be taken after 30/31 days continuous work and accumulation is not allowed.

4. It is directed that the contents of this letter is brought to the notice of all MILOBs under command.
