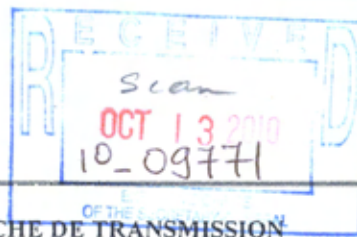



AGENDA ITEM 111(a): ELECTION OF FIVE NON-PERMANENT MEMBERS
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

SUMMARY

Introduction

At its 28th plenary meeting, on 12 October 2010, the General Assembly elected **Colombia, Germany, India, Portugal, and South Africa** as the five non-permanent members of the Security Council for a two-year term beginning on 1 January 2011.

Regions and vacancies

African and Asian States – 2 vacancies

Latin American and Caribbean States – 1 vacancy

Western European and Other States – 2 vacancies

Candidates

India, and South Africa

Colombia

Canada, Germany and
Portugal

Voting results

Four candidates were elected on the first ballot, having obtained the required two-thirds majority: **Columbia** (186 votes), **India** (187 votes), **Germany**, (128 votes), and **South Africa** (182otes).

Canada, (114 votes), and **Portugal** (122 votes) did not secure the required two-thirds majority votes and therefore had to proceed to the second round of balloting. During the second round neither **Portugal** (113 votes) nor **Canada** (78 votes) secured the required two-thirds majority votes (128 votes). The General Assembly then proceeded to the third round of restricted voting, at which point the delegation of Canada announced its withdrawal.

Consequently, one candidate **Portugal** (150 votes) was elected on the third round of balloting having obtained the required two thirds majority (122 votes). **Canada**, obtained (32 votes).

Retiring members

The five non-permanent members retiring as of 31 December 2010 are **Austria**, **Japan**, **Mexico**, **Turkey** and **Uganda**.
