

- (b) THERE HAVE BEEN REPORTED 40 NEW CASES OF MEASLES IN NGARAMA (B 2628) HOSPITAL
- (c) CYUMBA COMMUNE DONATED A LOT OF FOOD STUFF FOR ORPHANAGE URUMULI-BYUMBA. DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORTATION THE FOOD HAS BEEN SOLD AND THE MONEY WAS SENT TO MTHE ORPHANAGE. THE MANYAGIRO HEALTH CENTER (0032) HAS NO VEH FOR REFERRING SERIOUS CASES TO BYUMBA.
- (d) CARE HAS STOPPED FOOD DISTRIBUTION SINCE NOV 94. RETURNEES AND LOCALS HAVE HOWEVER CULTIVATED ENOUGH FOOD TO FORESTALL ANY FOOD SHORTAGES.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS

- (a) MEETINGS HAVE TAKEN PLACE BETWEEN MILOBS AND BURGERMASTERS OF MURAMBI- NGARAMA COMMUNES FOR UPDATING DATA.

ANOTHER MEETING TOOK PLACE BETWEEN THE SUB PREFECT OF NGARAMA AND MILOBS TO FIX APOINTMENTS WITH THE BURGERMASTERS OF MUVUMBA (B 2547) - MUHURA (B 2908). BOTH MEETINGS ARE PLANNED FOR FRIDAY 17/03/ 95

- (b) MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT LAST WEEK ONLY ONE FAMILY OF 6 PEOPLE RETURNED TO CYUMBA COMMUNE.

- (c) AT RWAMIKO SECTOR (2104) IN THE GITI COMMUNE, THE SECTOR CHIEF HAD CONVENED A MEETING TO DISCUSS SECURITY AND COMMUNAL ACTIVITIES. THE MEETING TAUGHT THE LOCALS WHO ARE MAINLY COFFEE FARMERS ON NEW TECHNIQUES TO INCREASE PRODUCTION. IN GITI COMMUNE, THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT THE COURTS WERE NOT YET ESTABLISHED BECAUSE JUDGES HAD NOT BEEN APPOINTED BY NOW. ALL CRIMINAL CASES WERE REFERRED TO RPA, THE SERIOUS ONES ARE REFERRED TO BYUMBA PREFECTURE.

THE COLLEGE OF RUTARE COMMUNE HAS NO GENERATOR FOR NIGHT STUDIES. THE BUILDING WAS VANDALISED, FURNITURE AND TEACHING MATERIALS ARE IN DIRE NEED. THE ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES FOR THE BORDERS HAVE BEEN OCCUPIED BY RPA SOLDIERS.

THE COLLEGE REQUIRES ASSISTANCE TO MOVE THE RPA FROM THE COLLEGE'S PREMISES. DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORT IN THE COMMUNE, PEOPLE HAVE TO TRAVEL ON FOOT TO THE NEXT MAIN ROAD.

ICRC: MAHURA NESENBHANA IS THE PERSON IN CHARGE. THIS STATION OFFERS ONLY OPD SERVICE. 40 TO 50 PATIENTS ARE TREATED DAYLY. THE STAFF CONSISTS OF 8 PEOPLE. ICRC HAS PAYED THEIR SALARY UNTIL JANUARY. SINCE THOSE DAYS THE STAFF HAS NOT RECEIVED ANY FUNDINGS FROM THE GOVERNMENT. TRANSPORTATION IS A BIG PROBLEM. THE CENTER HAS NO AMBULANCE NOR TRUCK. THE LOCALS ONLY USE RAIN WATER. MALARIA, PNEUMONIA, BRONCHITIS, MALNUTRITION ARE COMMON DISEASES. CARE DISTRIBUTES BEANS BUT NOT IT IS NOT REGULAR..

THERE IS A NEED FOR HIGH ENERGY FOOD. DUE TO LACK OF REFRIGERATOR NO VACCINATION PROGRAM CAN BE STARTED. THERE IS ALSO A SHORTAGE OF LABORATORY EQUIPMENT. NO AIDS OR MOTHER AND CHILD PROGRAM IS IN PROGRESS.


MUVUMBA - MURAMBI - MUHURA






