Excellency:

On July 12, 2014, I sent you an Application in which we asked Your Excellency to initiate proceedings with the General Assembly to accredit the National Sovereign State of Borinken (formerly Puerto Rico), as an official member of the UN. According to the Regulations of the organization, you are the person responsible for processing the request and send it to the Security Council for their respective assessment, consideration and subsequent submission to the President of the Assembly.

During the month of August, I called your office twice to check on the status of the Application and the person in that office with whom I spoke, told me to re-send it by fax. A few days later I proceeded to send the Application and it was received in the fax number indicated.

At this point, our government has not received any news about any paperwork that your office has made in this regard. We would like to know if you already sent the Application to the President of the Security Council or, otherwise, which is the status of it.

I respectfully request of you to let us know whether the Application has already been sent to the Security Council or whether it is still in your office. In the case that you have not sent it to the Council yet, as it proceeds, then, we would like to know the reasons for not sending it yet.

I will appreciate if you could let me know any news about this as soon as possible, since the next session of the General Assembly begins early this month and we would like it for our petition to be considered during this session.

On July 12, 2014 I send an Accreditation Petition to H. E.
