Excellency,



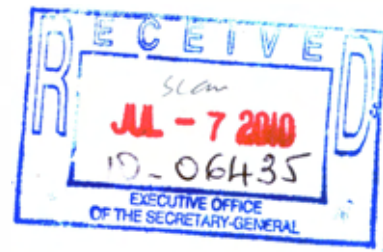



**Letter to Kyrgyz President Otunbaeva**



1. The Central Electoral Commission in Kyrgyzstan will announce the official results of the 27 June constitutional referendum on 2 July. On 29 June the Commission reported that 72% of the electorate took part in the referendum, with 90% of the votes in favour of the new constitution.
2. In adopting the constitution, voters also approved Ms. Roza Otunbaeva as President through 31 December 2011. She will be inaugurated on 3 July and will establish a caretaker Government until a Parliament is put in place through elections on 10 October 2010.
