1. GEN SIT: CALM WITH BORDER OPEN TO TRAFFIC TO AND FROM BURUNDI .
OBSERVED AN INCREASE OF RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI AT KANYARU BAS BORDER
POST GR 6291.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITY : BOURGMESATRE RUHASHYA GR 6926 ADDRESSED A
PUBLIC MEETING TODAY AT COMMUNE OFFICES ATTENDED BY LOCALS. RPA AND
GENDAMERIE IN THE AREA. MEETING WAS TO DISCUSS COMMUNE PLANS IN
HANDLING EX-IDP PROBLEMS NOW TRYING TO SETTLE DOWN AFTER CLOSURE OF
IDP CAMPS IN APRIL 1995.

OUR AOR AND REPORTS AS FOLLOWS :-

A. RUHASHYA GR 6926: SITUATION IS CALM . BOURGMESTRE FOUND ADDRESSING A PUBLIC MEETING AND HE ASKED TEAM TO GO BACK ON 02 JUNE 1995 FOR BRIEFING AND CONDUCTED TOUR OF THE COMMUNE.

B. MARABA GR 6321: SITUATION IS CALM . ROADS AND WOODEN BRIDGES IN AREA IN BAD STATE . 107 PRISONERS ARE HELD AT COMMUNE PRISON AND BOURGMESTRE COMPLAINED OF CONGESTION IN THE TWO SMALL ROOMS HOUSING PRISONERS AND REQUESTED FOR TRANSPORT FORWARD SOME TO BUTARE PRISON SIMBI CLINIC RUN BY AICE(NGO)TREATS 53 % PATIENTS SUFFERING FROM MALARIA AND RESPERATORY INFECTION . CLINIC COMPLAINED OF INADQUATE BED AND CLEAN WATER . COMMUNE HAS 807 ORPHANS REGISTERED AND STAYING WITH OTHER FAMILIES WHO REQUIRE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE.

C. MUGANZA GR 8407: SITUATION IS CALM . 627 ORPHANS AND 810 WIDOWS ARE REGISTERED AND IN NEED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE. EX- IDPS REGISTERED IS 74 WITH 72 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI AND 08 FROM TANZANIA WHO ARE SAID TO BE RE-SETTLING WELL WITH THE HELP OF ICRC AND CRS (NGO) WHO ARE OPERATING IN THE AREA. AT MUGOMBUWA SECTOR GR 8404 LVIA (NGO) ARE A NUTRITION PROGRAMMA FEEDING OVER 529 CHILDREN AND ALSO VACCINATES CHILDREN.

D. KIGEMBE GR 7000: SITUATION IS CALM . LOCALS FOUND COLLECTING NATIONAL IDENTITY CARDS AT COMMUNE OFFICES . 60 PRISONERS HELD AT COMMUNE OFFICES OUT OF WHICH 45 ARE WAITING TO BE TRANSFERRED.

TO BUTARE STATE PRISON AND BOURGMESTRE REQUESTED FOR TRANSPORT FOR THE TASK. RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI AT KANYARU BAS BORDER POSTS ARE: 28 MAY 95 - 102, 29 MAY 95 - 15, 30 MAY 95 - 49 AND 31 MAY 95 - 05. ATKANYARU- HAUTE BORDER POST RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI ARE: 29 MAY 95 - 04 AND 30 MAY 95 - 01. BOURGMESTRE COMPLAINED OVER LACK OF CLEAN DRINKING WATER AND AICE - USA CEASED SUPPLY OF THE SAME IN THE AREA.

4. GISHAMVU OR 6505: SITUATION IS CALM. LOCALS COMPLAINED OVER IRREGULAR SUPPLY OF PIPED WATER FORCING THEM TO DRAW FROM SPRINGS. ROAD AROUND COMMUNE OFFICES RECENTLY REPAIRED BY LOCALS. MANY PEOPLE WERE SEEN WAITING AT COMMUNE PRISON TO GIVE FOOD TO PRISONER RELATIVES.

5. HUMANITARIAN: UN AGENCIES AND NGOS CONTINUE TO GIVE AID TO LOCALS IN HOME COMMUNES OF THE SECTOR.

6. CIVIL AFFAIRS: NORMAL WITH IRREGULAR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY TO BOURGMESTRE.

1. GEN SIT. CALM AND BORDER REMAINED OPEN FOR TRAFFIC TO AND FROM KIGALI.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NIL REPORTED DURING THE PERIOD.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITY :

A. RPA. CONTINUE TO CONTROL SECTOR THROUGH PATROLS AND MANNING OF CHECK POINTS AND COMMUNE PRISONS/DETENTION CENTERS. PATROL AND CHECK POINTS AROUND THE UNIVERSITY CAMP.

B. FREG. BOURGMESTRE OF KIBAYI COMMUNE.

AND RETURNEES. 139 PRISONERS ARE HELD AT DETENTION CENTRE/COMMUNE PRISON WITH MANY BEING 1994 GENOCIDE ACCUSED.

C. BUTARE WAY STATION (GR 9637): RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI AND EX-IDPs MOSTLY TUSI SPEAKING ARE LIVING IN A HYGIENIC CONDITION AND LOOKED HAPPY WITH LITTLE OR NO HARASSMENT FROM RPA SOLDIERS PROVIDING SECURITY AT THE AREA. 149 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI AND 08 EX-IDPs DISCHARGED FROM BUTARE HOSPITAL ARE PRESENT. IOM IS PROVIDING TRANSPORT TO VARIOUS PREFECTURES AND COMMUNES BUT DELAY IN FINISHING THE EXERCISE IS DUE TO ABSENCE OF AN OFFICIAL FROM MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION WHO IS GOVT AGENT SUPPOSED TO GIVE GO AHEAD OF RETURNEES AND IDPs LEAVING THE STATION.

D. RUNYINYA (GR 6012): SITUATION REPORTED CALM. AT RUKARA SECTOR COUNSELLOR BRIEFED TEAM OF AN ACUTE SHORTAGE OF FARMING IMPLEMENTS AND INPUTS AND THAT POPULATION OF SECTOR HAS INCREASED TO 2,900 SINCE CLOSURE OF IDP CAMPS IN APRIL 1995. RUNYINYA-KIBEHO ROAD IS IN VERY POOR CONDITION AND REQUIRED REPAIRS. 470 PRISONERS MOSTLY 1994 GENOCIDE ACCUSED ARE HELD AT COMMUNE PRISON AND THERE HAVE BEEN NO RELEASES. PRISON IS CONGESTED AND CONDITION POOR FOR HUMAN HABITATION VERY POOR. BUT BOURGMESTRE TOLD TEAM THAT AUTHORITIES WOULD DO SOMETHING BUT NOTHING HAS BEEN DONE.

FRFG SOLDIERS ARE IN HIDING AMONG RWANDAN REFUGEES AT NGOZIL, MUNFLE AND KUREUMU REFUGEE CAMPS IN BURUNDI AND STOPPING REFUGEES FROM RETURNING BACK TO RWANDA.

C. MILITIA. BOURGMESTRE KIBAYI ALSO ALLEGE THAT FORMER INTER-HAMWE MILITIA MEN ARE ALSO HIDING AMONG REFUGEES IN THE THREE BURUNDI CAMPS MENTIONED ABOVE.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES. MILOB TEAMS PATROLLED SOME HOME COMMUNES IN OUR AOR AND THE BUTARE WAY STATION AND REPORTED AS FOLLOWS :

A. KIBAYI GR 8497 : BANDITRY ACTIVITIES REPORTED ON THE DECREASE DURING THE MONTH OF MAY 95 DUE STOPPAGE OF TRANS-BORDER MOVEMENTS BY RPA DEPLOYED ALONG THE AKANYARU RIVER AND BURUNDI ARMY ACROSS THE RIVER. THE KIBAYI-KIGEMBE ROAD LEADING TO BUTARE IS IN POOR CONDITION AND BOURGMESTRE REQUESTED FOR UNAMIR ASSISTANCE TO HAVE IT REPAIRED. IT WAS ALSO OBSERVED THAT NO NGO OR UN AGENCY IS WORKING IN THE COMMUNE THEREBY MAKING RESETTLEMENT OF RETURNEES AND EX-IDPs VERY DIFFICULT. 876 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI HAVE MANAGED TO ESCAPE FROM FRFG MEN AND MILITIA INTIMIDATION AND HAVE REGISTERED AT COMMUNE OFFICE IN MAY 95.

B. RUSATIRA (GR 7431): GEN SIT IS CALM IN THE AREA. UNHR TEAM IN THE AREA FOR UNKNOWN REASON WERE HOSTILE TOWARDS MILOBPATROL TEAM. MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION OFFICIALS IN THE AREA ARE WORKING OUT NUMBER OF DESTROYED HOUSES SO THAT THE SAME CAN BE DISTRIBUTED AMONG EX-IDPs WITHOUT HOUSES. BORGMESTRE IS TRYING TO ARRANGE A MEETING AMONG RPA, UNAMIR AND COMMUNE AUTHORITIES TO DISCUSS THE PRESSING PROBLEMS FACED BY IDPs.

5. HUMANITARIAN. CONCERN (NGO) HAS SUSPENDED ITS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTOR AFTER FACING A STRIKE ACTION FROM LOCAL STAFF WHEN SOME OF THEM WERE DECLARED REDUNDANT. LOCALS IN COMMUNES ARE EXPRESSING ANXIETIES AT WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO HUNDREDS OF LOCALS EMPLOYED BY UN AGENCIES AND NGO'S. SOME EVEN PREDICT A RISE IN CRIME RATE THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR.

6. CIV AFFAIRS. ROUTINE SOCIAL AND COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES GOING ON IN THE SECTOR. ERRATIC SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY CONTINUE IN BUTARE TOWN.

BURUNDI .

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITY: BOURGMESTRE NDORA COMMUNE GR 8112 IS ON AN
OFFICIAL VISIT OF SECTORS TO CHECK ON HOW EX- IDPS ARE RESETTLING
AND URGING THEM GET ENGAGED IN DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES .

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITY:

A. RPA: CONTINUE TO CONTROL THE SECTOR THROUGH FOOT AND MOBILE
PATROLS . ALSO MANNING OF CHECK POINTS AND COMMUNE PRISON/DETENTION
CENTRES.

B. FRGF: NO ACTIVITIES REPORTED IN THE SECTOR .

C. MILITIA: NO ACTIVITIES REPORTED IN THE SECTOR .

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES : MILOB TEAMS PATROLLED SOME OF THE HOME
COMMUNES AND REPORTED THAT :-

A. NYAKIZU GR 5696: GENERAL SITUATION IS CALM . TEAM FOUND ABOUT 50 EX- IDPS WAITING TO BE REGISTERED AT COMMUNE OFFICES ,THESE CAME DIRECT TO SECTORS WITHOUT REGISTERING AFTER CLOSURE OF IDP CAMPS. AT KANYARU -HAUTE BORDER POST GR 6291 IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS TOLD TEAM THAT NO RETURNEES CAME FROM BURUNDI FOR THE PAST TWO WEEKS .

B. HUYE GR 7614: SITUATION IS CALM . BOURGMESTRE WAS HOSTILE WHO ACCUSED UNAMIR OF DOING NOTHING IN RWANDA AND CHALLENGED UNAMIR TO REPAIR OFFICE BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCT PRISONS INSTEAD OF JUST VISITING COMMUNES. HE ALSO STRONGLY COMPLAINED AGAINST SENBATT CONTINUED OCCUPATION OF THE COOPERATIVE COMPLEX AT SOVU GR 6717 AND REQUESTED FOR AN AUDIENCE WITH SENBATT COMDR TO IRON OUT THE ISSUE.

C. NDORA GR 8112 : SITUATION IS CALM. TODATE 401 EX-IDPS REGISTERED AND ARE SETTLING WELL WITH 50 RETURNEES COMING FROM BURUNDI,UGANDA AND TANZANIA. 404 ORPHANS ARE REGISTERED AND ARE STAYING WITH OTHER FAMILIES WITH 472 WIDOWS WHO ARE ALL IN NEED OF HUMANITARIAN SUPPORT. CONCERN (NGO) WORKING IN MBAZI GR 7117 ARE INVOLVED IN A LABOUR DISPUTE AFTER SOME LOCAL STAFFS WERE DECLARED REDUNDANT AND NGO HAS TEMPORALLY CEASED OPERATION IN THE ARE.

D. MBAZI GR 7117: SITUATION IS CALM. BOURGMESTRE COMPLAINED OF LACK OF CLEAN WATER . ICRC IS DOING FOOD DISTRIBUTION IN THE AREA WITH TERRES DES HOMES (NGO) GIVING MEDICAL AID TO LOCALS.

5. HUMANITARIAN : UN AGENCIES AND NGOS CONTINUE GIVING AID TO HOME COMMUNES, HOWEVER MUST OF THE INDICATE THEY WILL SOON CLOSE DOWN OFFICES THEREBY POSING A DANGER OF FAMINE AND INCREASED DISEASES IN MOST HOME COMMUNES IN THE SECTOR WHO DEPEND ON THEIR SERVICES FOR THEIR SURVIVAL.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITY :ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED NGOMA COMMUNE
(GR 9637) AND REPORTED SITUATION CALM. ATTEMPT BY TEAM TO VISIT
BUTARE PRISON WAS REFUSED BY GENDARMERIE AS SUNDAYS ARE NOT VISITING
DAYS BUT PRISON OFFICIALS TOLD TEAM THAT CURRENT PRISONERS HELD IS AS
FOLLOWS , 6,136 MEN, 210 WOMEN,52 BABIES AND 114 CHILDREN UNDER 16
YEARS OF AGE WITH 72 REMANDEES . THESE FIGURES CLEARLY INDICATE AN
INCREASE COMPARE TO A WEEK AGO WHEN RPA CONDUCTED A CORDON AND SEARCH
OPERATION .

4. ANOTHER MILOB TEAM ATTENDED A REBURIAL CEREMONY OF THE 1994 GENOCIDE VICTIMS AT NTYAZO COMMUNE GR 8631 AND REPORTED THAT APPROX 2,000 PEOPLE ATTENDED OPEN AIR REQUIEM MASS WHICH WAS ATTENDED BY TOP GOVT OFFICIALS INCLUDING DEPUTY SPEAKER OF NATIONAL ASSEMBLY UNAMIR WAS CONDEMNED FOR HAVING STOOD BY WHILE GENOCIDE TOOK PLACE . MILOB TEAM LEADER MAJ ADEKAGUN WAS ASKED TO MAKE A SPEECH ON THE OCCASION. OFFICER WHO IS NIGERIAN MADE A COMPARISON OF RWANDA TO NIGERIA DURING THE 1967-70 CIVIL WAR AND THE RECONCILIATION WHICH HAS TAKEN PLACE IN NIGERIA AND HOPED RWANDA WILL DO THE SAME. DURING SPEECHES IT WAS REVEALED THAT COL BAGOSORA OF FRFG WAS A GENOCIDE PERPETRATOR WHO FLED TO ZAIRE BUT THAT HIS SON FORMER BOURGMESTRE OF NTYAZO IS HELD AT BUTARE PRISON .

5. HUMANITARIAN : AT MATYAZO SECTOR OF NGOMA GR 9637 CATHOLIC MISSIONARIES RUNNING THE CLINIC IN THE AREA COMPLAINED OF INADEQUATE BEDS TO ADMIT PATIENTS.

6. CIV AFFAIRS. NORMAL WITH ERRATIC SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY CONTINUING IN BUTARE.
