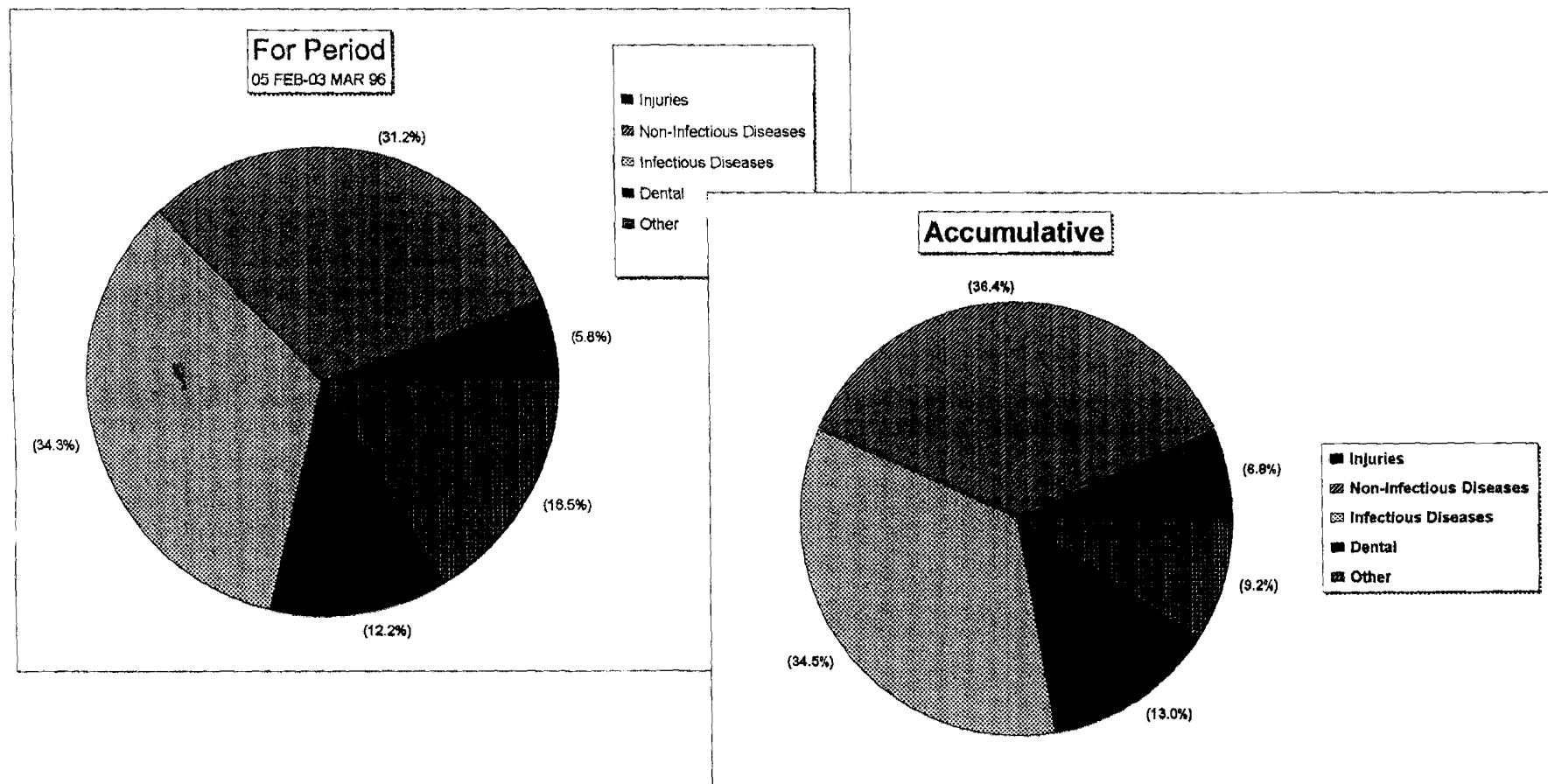

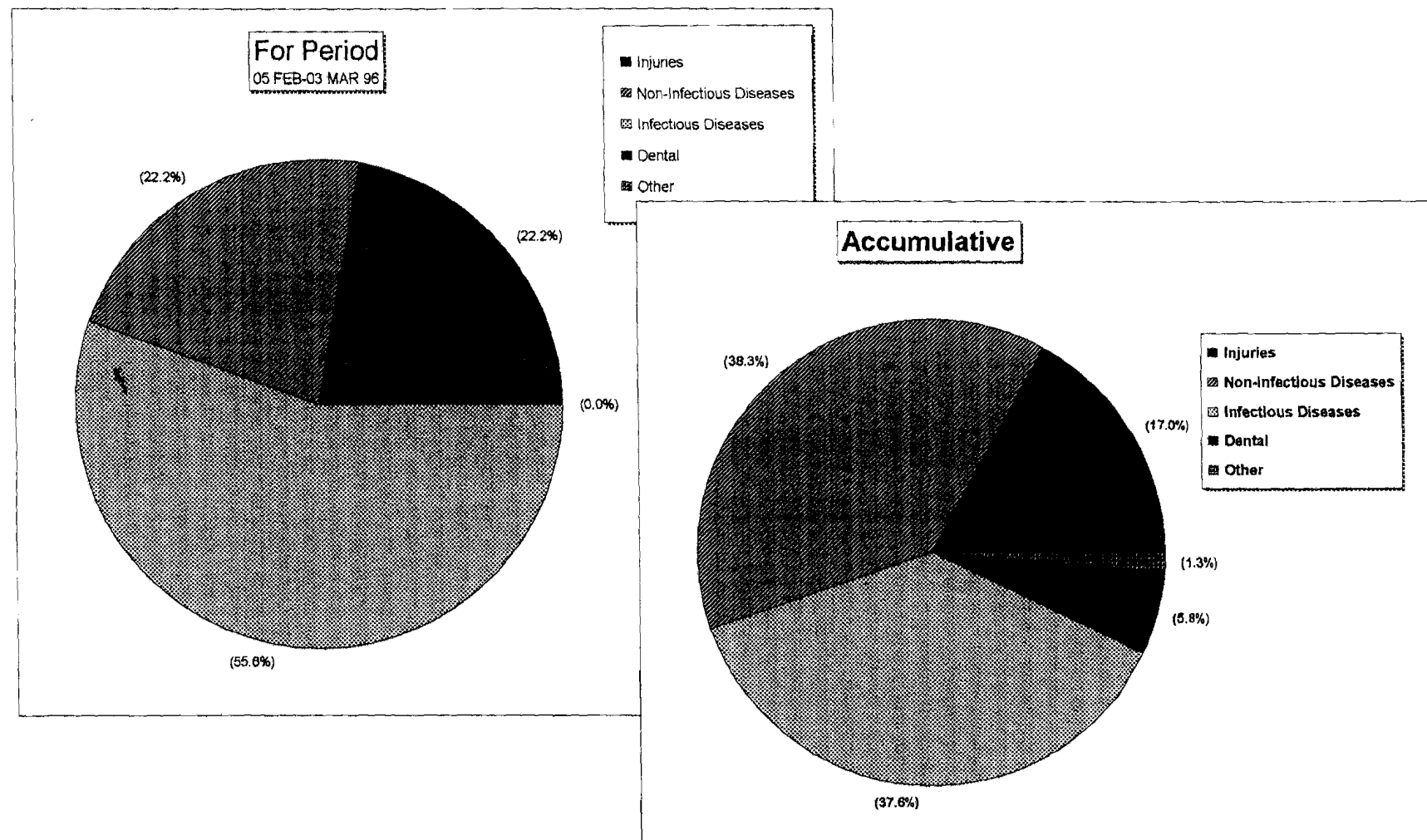

Force Out-patients Strength



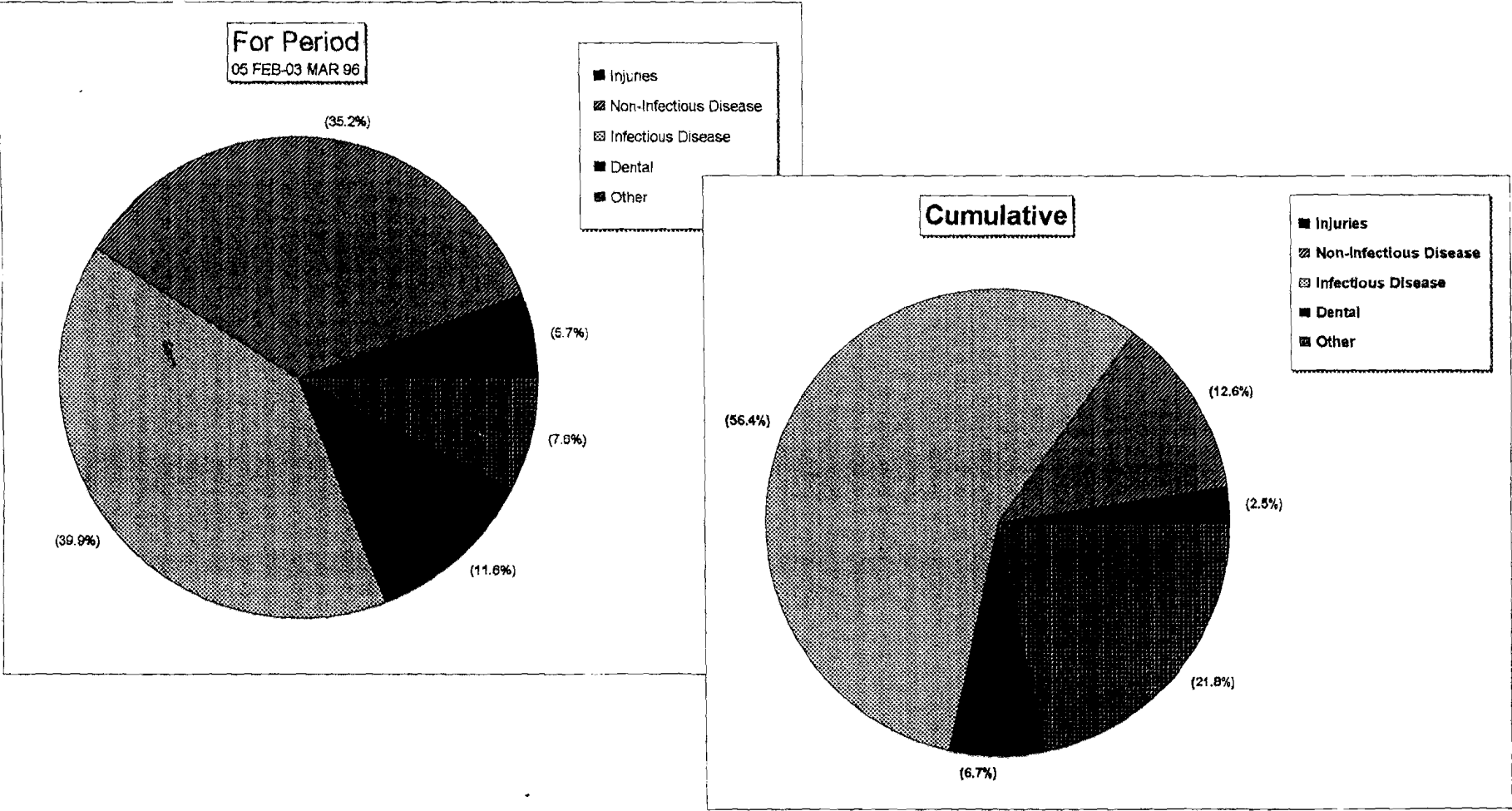
