1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES ARE REPORTED HOLDING MEETINGS IN SEVERAL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY IN AN ATTEMPT TO DISPEL RUMOURS AND ALSO TO PLAN ACTIVITIES FOR THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE WAR.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) RPA TROOPS AT THEIR ROAD BLOCK AT GR 042868 TODAY DETAINED FOR SEARCH, A HUMAN RIGHTS VEHICLE FOR ABOUT TWO AND A HALF HOURS. A MILOB TEAM FROM KIGALI WAS SENT TO THE SCENE BUT COULD NOT CONVINCE THE RPA TO LET THE VEHICLE THROUGH WITHOUT SEARCH. THE SEARCH WAS THOROUGH AND LASTED FOR TWENTY MINUTES. NOTHING WAS FOUND AND NOTHING WAS TAKEN. A SIMILAR INCIDENT HAPPENED AT THE SAME PLACE ON 18 MAR 95.

(b) SECTOR 3 REPORTED THAT THE RPA PROGRAMME TO TRAIN CIVIL SECURITY OFFICERS SEEMED TO BE NEARING COMPLETION IN THE GITARAMA PREFECTURE. IN NTONGWE COMMUNE (GR 9057), 47 TRAINEES GRADUATED TODAY.

(c) IN THE SAME SECTOR, THE INFORMATION CONCERNING SOME RENEGADE RPA SOLDIERS IN A STOLEN VEHICLE THAT WAS HIDDEN AT RUTOBWE ORPHANAGE; IT WAS LEARNT TODAY THAT THE RPA HAD CAPTURED THE VEHICLE IN THE SHOGWE AREA. NO FURTHER DETAILS WERE GIVEN.

(d) SECTOR 4C MILOBS REPORTED THAT THREE RPA OFFICERS; MAJ BUSHANDA (COMDT DEF), LT GAFFIZI (COMMS DEF) AND MACUMU EVARISTE (SECUR OFFR) WENT TO UNHCR TO GATHER INFORMATION ON THEIR RADIO COMMUNICATION TYPES AND FREQUENCIES. THE UNHCR STAFF DECLINED AND TOLD THEM THEY WOULD HAVE TO ASK THEIR HQ IN KIGALI.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

- a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.
- b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

- (1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.
- (2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE SECTOR INCLUDING THE BORDER POSTS.
- (3) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED TO KISARO (GR 0220), MIYOVE (GR 9721), CYUNGO (GR 9321), GATUNA (GR 0143), KIBALI (GR 0424) AND RUHONDA. SITUATION IN THESE AREAS WAS REPORTED CALM.

- c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

- (1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.
- (2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS FROM RILIMA (GR 2561) TO GASHORA (GR 2655) AND RUTETE (GR 2242). THE SITUATION IN THE AREA WAS CALM.
- (3) PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED IN SAKE (GR 4354), MUGESERA (GR 4764) AND BIRENGA (GR 5959). AT SAKE, MILOBS WERE INFORMED BY THE BOURGMESTRE THAT THE AUTHORITIES WERE PLANNING REBURIAL OF SKELETONS FROM THE MASS GRAVE AT RUKUMBELI (GR 0061) ON 07 APR 95.
- (4) MILOBS ALSO PATROLLED KIBUNGO AND SURROUNDING AREAS, RUKARA (GR 5601), MUHAZI (GR 4590), RUTUNDE (GR 4884) AND KAYONZA (GR 5784). SITUATION IN THESE AREAS WAS CALM. PATROLS OBSERVED THAT BOURGMESTRES OF THESE COMMUNES WERE HOLDING A MEETING. THE BOURGMESTRE OF RUTUNDE INFORMED MILOBS THAT PEACEFUL DEMONSTRATIONS WERE BEING PLANNED FOR THE 6 AND 7 OF APRIL AT RWAMAGANA.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA/KIBUYE

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR CONTINUED TO BE TENSE IN ANTICIPATION OF ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE WAR. GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS HAVE BEEN TRYING TO DISPEL RUMOURS BUT THE LARGE NUMBER OF ARRESTS IN SOME SECTORS MAKE IT DIFFICULT FOR THEM TO ACHIEVE THIS AIM.

(2) A SECURITY MEETING WAS HELD AT THE SECTOR HQ TODAY INVOLVING UN AGENCIES AND NGOS. DISCUSSIONS ON THE GENERAL SECURITY SITUATION WERE HELD. THE FUTURE OF OP RETOUR WAS DISCUSSED WITH THE IOC REP, UNHCR, UNREO AND HUMAN RIGHTS. ANOTHER MEETING WHICH HAD BEEN PLANNED FOR TODAY WITH THE PREFECT OF GITARAMA, THE RPA BDE COMMANDER, THE BISHOP OF GITARAMA, ICRC, UNHCR AND HUMAN RIGHTS, WENT AHEAD WITHOUT THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THE AIM WAS TO DISCUSS THE EXPANSION OF THE GITARAMA PRISON WHICH NOW HOLDS OVER 6,000 PRISONERS AND HAD CAUSED 14 DEATHS IN THE PAST ONE WEEK.

(3) MILOBS PATROLLED RUTSIRO (GR 3183), GISOVU (GR 2952) AND MANBANZA COMMUNES. THEY OBSERVED THAT LOCALS WERE LIVING IN THE FEAR OF THE RUMOURS OF PLANNED ACTIVITIES FOR 6 AND 7 APR 95. AT KIBINGO VILLAGE (GR 3080) IN MANBANZA COMMUNE, THEY WERE INFORMED OF A SHOOTING INCIDENT ON 28 MAR 95. ONE MR INTIMANUZNA WAS SHOT IN THE LEG BY RPA. NO REASON WAS GIVEN. THE PATROL ALSO LEARNED OF 11 ARRESTS OVER THE LAST TWO WEEKS. THE PRISONERS ARE ALLEGEDLY KEPT IN A PIT AT THE RPA CAMP AT SURI. MILOBS TO INVESTIGATE FURTHER.

(4) TEAMS FROM UNAMIR ENGINEER COY AND HUMAN RIGHTS TODAY VISITED THE KIBUYE PRISON TO DISCUSS RENOVATIONS TO EASE OVERCROWDING.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) SECTOR COMMANDER ATTENDED A MEETING AT THE PREFECTURE REGARDING ACTIONS TO BE INITIATED FOR THE EARLY CLOSURE OF DPCS IN THE PREFECTURE. A NUMBER OF POINTS WERE DISCUSSED AND SEVERAL DECISIONS TAKEN. THE IOC REP SAID FIELD OFFICERS WILL BE DEPLOYED IN CAMPS AND HOME COMMUNES TO MONITOR PROGRESS. ALSO, HOME COMMUNES ARE BEING PREPARED IN REGARDS TO WATER, SANITATION, FOOD AND AGRICULTURE TO RECEIVE RETURNEES. THE RPA COMMANDER EXPLAINED THAT HE WAS AWAITING RADIO ANNOUNCEMENT OF A PLANNED CURFEW IN MUBUGA AND RWAMIKO COMMUNES BEFORE IT IS IMPOSED. ANOTHER MEETING HAS BEEN PLANNED FOR MON 03 APR 95.

(3) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE NYAMIGINA (GR 4523) AND BUHORO (GR 4621) IDP CAMPS. MILOBS WERE INFORMED BY THE CAMP CHIEF THAT THEY HAD BEEN INSTRUCTED TO MOVE TO A BIGGER CAMP BY THE RPA. THE STRUCTURE BUILT FOR FOOD AT BUHORO CAMP WAS DEMOLISHED ON THE ORDERS OF THE PREFECT OF GIKONGORO AND THE RPA COMMANDER. THE CHIEF ALSO REVEALED THAT MOST PEOPLE REFUSE TO LEAVE THE CAMP FOR FEAR OF ARREST.

(4) MILOBS ALSO PATROLLED MUKO COMMUNE . THEY WERE INFORMED OF ARMED ROBBERY OF THE CONSEILLER OF MUSENYI SECTOR (GR 4241) ON 24 MAR 95 BY ARMED ELEMENTS IN UNIFORM.

(5) MILOBS CARRIED OUT OP RUBY AND ALSO MONITORED OP RETOUR AT KIBEHO CAMP.

f. SECTOR 4B - BUTARE

(1) THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED KANYARU-HAUTE (GR 6391) AND NYABISUNDU (GR 7138). THEY ACCOMPANIED ICRC AND DELEGATES FROM KIGALI TO NYAZA IN NYABISUNDU COMMUNE. THE TEAM VISITED THE DETENTION CENTRE WHICH HOLDS A TOTAL OF 452 PRISONERS. MEN AND WOMEN ARE KEPT TOGETHER IN THE SAME CELLS AND CONDITIONS WERE VERY BAD.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CONSIDERABLY TENSE. RUMOURS ABOUT PLANNED ACTIVITIES FOR 6 AND 7 APR 95 IS LIKELY TO DRIVE THE POPULATION ON THE LAKESHORE AND FRONTIER AREAS DEEPER INTO THE HINTERLAND.

(2) THE SECTOR RECEIVED AND BRIEFED OFFICIALS FROM THE GERMAN EMBASSY AND THE TEA INDUSTRY. BRIEF WAS ON THE GENERAL SECURITY SITUATION IN THE SECTOR. THE VISITING TEAM HINTED THEY WANTED TO REVIVE THE TEA FACTORIES IN THE AREA.

(3) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN THEIR SECTOR. SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM INVESTIGATED ALLEGED ARRESTS BY RPA IN RWERERE COMMUNE (GR 2418) ON 21 MAR 95. INVESTIGATIONS CONFIRMED THE ARREST OF SIX PERSONS BY THE CONSEILLER OF MUHANDA SECTOR WITH THE HELP OF THE RPA. THOSE ARRESTED WERE ACCUSED OF HAVING PARTICIPATED IN THE GENOCIDE. ONE OF THEM, MR EDWARD HABIMANA, DIED IN GISENYI PRISON. DETAILED

REPORT TO FOLLOW.

(3) MILOBS AND CIVPOL ALSO INVESTIGATED THE KILLING INCIDENT THAT OCCURRED IN THE NIGHT OF 28/29 AT KAYOVE COMMUNE (GR 2892). THREE MEN AND A TWO YEAR OLD CHILD WERE KILLED. ONE WOMAN WAS INJURED IN BOTH LEGS FROM A GRENADE EXPLOSION. ANOTHER WOMAN WHO ESCAPED THE ATTACK IS STILL REPORTED MISSING. DETAILED REPORT TO FOLLOW.

(4) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT TO CYANIKA BORDER POST. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM AT THE BORDER.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND SURROUNDING AREAS REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN GIKOMERO, NYARUGENGE AND KANOMBE COMMUNES. THEY VISITED SEVERAL SECTORS IN THESE COMMUNES. THEY WERE SHOWN A MASS GRAVE AT GR 124929 IN GIKOMERO COMMUNE. IT CONTAINED APPROXIMATELY 10 BODIES. THE TEAM WAS ALSO SHOWN AN EOD NEAR THE SAME PLACE.

k. AIR OPS. NTR

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

a. TOTAL OF 59 DPS WERE EVACUATED FROM THE DPCS IN SECTOR 4A DURING THE PERIOD; 47 FROM KIBEHO AND 12 FROM NDAGO.

b. SECTOR 3 REPORTED A BROKEN DOWN WATER PUMP AND GENERATOR IN KAYENZI COMMUNE. ALSO, FIVE OTHER COMMUNES FACE THE SAME PROBLEM. THE NGO 'SOLIDARITE' HAS ALSO FAILED

UN RESTRICTED

TO TAKE OVER THE DISPENSARY AT NYABINAGA (GR 1350) AS PROMISED. AS SUCH, THE DISPENSARY WILL RUN SHORT OF FOOD IN THE NEXT TWO DAYS.

c. SECTOR 5 REPORTED AN ORGANISED MOVE OF 28 RETURNEES FROM KATALE CAMP IN ZAIRE TO GISENYI TODAY.

d. A BI-WEEKLY MEETING OF ALL NGOS IN GISENYI, RUHENGARI AND GOMA WAS HELD IN GISENYI TODAY. DISCUSSIONS CENTRED MAINLY ON CO-ORDINATION AND ENHANCEMENT OF NGOS ACTIVITIES WITHIN THEIR SECTORS OF RESPONSIBILITY.

e. SECTOR 6 REPORTED THAT THE PEOPLE OF MUHIMA (GR 8606) HAVE NEVER BENEFITED FROM NGO HELP AND SEEM ABANDONED TO THEIR FATE.

UNAMIR INFOSUM FOR 01 APR 95

1. OVERVIEW. FRGF/MILITIA ACTIVITY ON THE INCREASE IN SECTORS 4C AND 5 FURTHER AGGRAVATING THE SECURITY SITUATION IN BOTH SECTORS.

2. RPA

A. IN SECTOR 4A, MILOBS OBSERVED APPROXIMATELY A PLATOON STRENGTH OF RPA MOVING FROM NDAGO GR 520023 TO MUNINI GR 4899. THEY WERE CARRYING THEIR PERSONAL WEAPONS, MORTARS AND RPGS. THE SAME GROUP WAS SEEN AT NYARURE GR 5195, PROCEEDING TO NYAKIZU COMMUNE GR 5796.

B. MILOBS IN SECTOR 4B REPORTED HAVING OBSERVED A COMPANY STRENGTH OF RPA SOLDIERS MOVING TOWARDS SAVE GR 7419.

C. IN SECTOR 4C, MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE RPA WERE SUSPECTED IN THE MURDER OF AN EMPLOYEE OF NUNS IN THE AREA OF MURWA GR 9741 (NYAMASHEKE) AT APPROXIMATELY 1930 HRS ON 31 MAR 95. THE RPA HAD SPOKEN TO THE VICTIM AN HOUR EARLIER BEFORE HE WAS MURDERED. IN ANOTHER INCIDENT, RPA LAST NIGHT ENGAGED THREE BOATS AT ISHARA PENINSULA AT 2400 HRS. THE OCCUPANTS RETURNED FIRE AND RETREATED. STILL IN THE SAME SECTOR, THE RPA ARRESTED A LOCAL FOR REPORTING A ROBBERY WHICH NEVER TOOK PLACE. THE RPA CLAIMED THEY HAD INFO THAT THE LOCAL'S SON WAS AMONG A GANG OF ROBBERS OPERATING IN THE AREA.

D. IN SECTOR 4C ETHIOBATT REPORTED THAT RPA KILLED A LOCAL AT MURAINA GR 1546. AN F1 GREN WAS FOUND AT THE SITE OF THE KILLING. RPA HAVE DENIED INVOLVEMENT. INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS.

E. IN SECTOR 6, 95 FLSG REPORTED THAT TWO OF THEIR PERS WERE STOPPED BY AN RPA SOLDIER WHO ACCUSED THEM OF TRAVELLING THE WRONG WAY ON A "ONE WAY STREET" AT THE TIME, VARIOUS OTHER VEHs WERE TRAVELLING IN BOTH DIRECTIONS AND THERE WERE NO MARKINGS INDICATING THAT IT WAS A ONE WAY STREET. THE TWO CANADIAN SOLDIERS WERE ORDERED TO FOLLOW THE RPA VEH AND PAY A FINE OF \$50.00 OR 10,000 RWANDAN FRANCS OR GIVE UP THEIR VEH. THE RPA ACCEPTED \$40.00 IN EXCHANGE FOR THE RELEASE OF THE VEH.

G. IN SECTOR 6, INDBATT REPORTED THAT RPA HAS INTENSIFIED FOOT AND VEHICLE PATROLS IN KIGALI CITY. THE NUMBER OF CHECK POINTS HAVE ALSO BEEN INCREASED.

3. FRGF. IN SECTOR 4C, AT 2330 HRS ON 31 MAR 95, A GROUP OF

BANDITS, SOME DRESSED IN COMPLETE MILITARY ATTIRE, ENGAGED RPA PATROL AT GASHARO GR 9838 ALONG NYAMASHEKE ROAD. ONE RPA SOLDIER WAS INJURED DURING THE ATTACK. THE SAME GROUP IS BELIEVED TO HAVE CARRIED OUT ROBBERIES THAT NIGHT IN THE AREA. IN A SEPARATE INCIDENT, ANOTHER GROUP OF BANDITS RAIDED KAGARAMA GR 9633 AND SHOT DEAD ONE MAN WHEN VILLAGERS ATTEMPTED ALERTING RPA AND UNAMIR BY BEATING THEIR DRUMS. THE GROUP CONTINUED WITH THE ROBBERY AND ESCAPED.

6. REGIONAL. NTR.

6. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) REPORTED A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT INVOLVING UNAMIR 4614 WHICH HIT A LOCAL WOMAN IN BYUMBA. THE VICTIM SUSTAINED A CUT ON THE HEAD AND MINOR BRUISES. SHE IS CONSCIOUS AND RESPONDING TO TREATMENT IN NIBATT MED CENTRE.

(3) 1,513 DPs ENTERED RWANDA THROUGH KAGITUMBA BORDER ON 01 APR 95.

(4) MED STAFF TREATED 31 LOCALS AT MED CENTRE.

C. SECTOR 2.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) GHANBATT PTLs TO KANZENZE COMMUNES GR 1564 REPORTED THAT LOCALS WERE BEING HARASSED ON THEIR FARMS BY UNIDENTIFIED UNIFORMED PERSONS. GHANBATT HAS INTENSIFIED PTLs IN MENTIONED AREA.

(3) 171 IDPs FROM GIKONGORO ARRIVED AT NGENDA COMMUNE. THEY WERE REGISTERED AND CONVEYED TO THEIR VARIOUS HOMES IN GHANBATT VEHS.

(4) 16 DPs ENTERED RWANDA THROUGH RUSUMO BORDER ON 31 MAR 95.

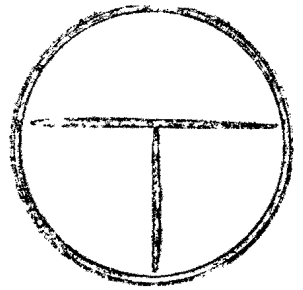

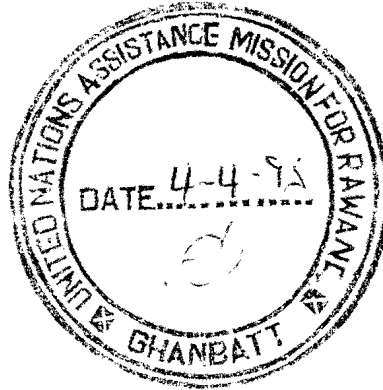

1. OVERVIEW. FRGF ACTIVITY APPEARS TO BE INCREASING IN SECTORS. RPA INTERNAL SECURITY ACTIVITY HAS ALSO INCREASED.

2. RPA

A. IN SECTOR 1, BYUMBA (0825), ON SATURDAY, A NIBATT TRUCK STRUCK A LOCAL FEMALE. VICTIM WAS EVACUATED TO NIBATT AID STATION. THE GENDARMERIE MOUNTED A ROADBLOCK TO PREVENT MOVEMENT IN/OUT OF BYUMBA BY UNAMIR PERSONNEL AND VEHICLES. THE ROADBLOCK WAS LIFTED WHEN THE VEHICLE WAS IMPOUNDED BY GENDARMERIE.

B. RPA HAS BEEN VERY VISIBLE THROUGHOUT SECTOR 3. A WRITTEN NOTIFICATION OF A "TRAINING EXERCISE" TO BE HELD IN CERTAIN SECTORS NEXT WEEK HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE GITARAMA AREA. THIS IS HAVING THE EFFECT OF MAKING PEOPLE IN THE OUTLYING REGIONS EVEN MORE NERVOUS AS THEY BELIEVE THEY ARE BEING DUPED INTO COOPERATING IN THEIR OWN DEMISE. MILOBS WILL MONITOR THE SITUATION.

D. RPA COMPANY IN SECTOR 4B CONDUCTED A MARCH WITH WEAPONS IN AREA OF SAVE (7419) ON 01 APR 95.

SATURDAY'S SWEEP OF THE AREA BY COMBAT ENGINEERS FOUND ANTI-PERSONNEL MINES PLANTED AT THE GATE OF THE LOCAL BURGOMESTRE. COMMENT: THE BURGOMESTRE WAS ETHNIC TUTSI. THE MINING AND ATTACKS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE TRAINING BEING GIVEN THE FRG MILITIA IN ZAIRE.

(2) ISHARA PENINSULA; 302400B APR 95, 3 BOATS ENGAGED BY RPA, OCCUPANTS RETURNED FIRE AND WITHDREW.

(3) NYAKARENZO (7919): 310100B APR 95. SATURDAY MORNING THE ADMINISTRATOR OF AMORA SECTOR WAS BEATEN WITH STICKS BY SEVEN PERSONS. ONE ROUND WAS FIRED BY THE ATTACKERS. NFI

(4) MBLIZI: 311000B, 4 LOCALS WERE WOUNDED BY ANTI-PERS MINE IN THE VICINITY OF THE PREVIOUS DAY'S ANTI-TANK MINE EXPLOSION.

(5) GISHOMA: 312200B, THE VICE-BURGEMESTRE OF GISOMA COMMUNE WAS KILLED.

(6) ISHARA PENINSULA; MUKINJA (4235): 312300B, 25-30 BANDITS LOOTED A HOME OF LIVESTOCK, HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND MONEY. THEY THEN RETURNED AND KILLED THE RESIDENT. A LOCAL NEIGHBOUR HAS BEEN IMPLICATED.

(7) GASHARO(9838):012330B, MILITIA/RPA MEETING ENGAGEMENT. ONE RPA SOLDIER WOUNDED BY GRENADE.

(8) ISHARA PENINSULA; MUKINJA AREA: 312400B, BANDITS FROM IJWE ISLAND CONDUCTED A SIMILAR ROBBERY AS MUKINJA, NO FATALITIES REPORTED.

(9) COMMENT: INCREASED MILITIA/FRGF ATTACKS AND ROBBERIES ARE LIKELY DURING THIS PERIOD. INCREASED RPA PRESENCE APPEARS TO BE DETERRENCE PATROLLING AND REINFORCEMENT OF ITS INTERNAL SECURITY MEASURES.

6. REGIONAL.

A. BURUNDI:

(1) SOME SHOOTING STILL CONTINUED IN BUJUMBURA. COMMENT: APPARENTLY THE ARMY HAD NOT SWEEPED THE HUTU GANG STRONGHOLD OF KAMENGE DURING LAST WEEK'S CORDON

AND SEARCH OPERATION. UNTIL THIS AREA IS SECURED, ARMY/HUTU CLASHES IN THE CAPITAL ARE LIKELY TO CONTINUE.

(2) FRANCE IS PUSHING THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY TO URGENTLY PROVIDE FOOD AID AND RECONSTRUCTION HELP TO BURUNDI. COMMENT: HUTU REFUGEES FROM RWANDA RECEIVE FOOD AID WHILE BURUNDIAN TUTSI IDPS GO WITHOUT. THIS IS ONE EXACERBATING FACTOR WHICH COULD BE NEUTRALIZED BY THE INFLUX OF FOOD AID.

B. BURUNDI/TANZANIA: SOME OF THE REFUGEES DENIED ENTRY TO TANZANIA ARE BEING TRUCKED BACK TO THEIR CAMPS OF RUVUMU AND KIBEZI, BUT THOSE FROM MAGARA WILL BE TEMPORARILY SETTLED AT A SITE AT KABANGA. UN REFUGEE AGENCY IS ATTEMPTING TO PERSUADE AUTHORITIES TO ALLOW THOSE REFUGEES TO RETURN TO MAGARA, BUT THE BURUNDIAN MILITARY CLAIMS IT IS TOO DANGEROUS FOR THEM TO RETURN. COMMENT: IT IS IN BURUNDI'S BEST SECURITY INTERESTS THAT THE CAMPS DO NOT REAPPEAR.

C. UGANDA: A UGANDAN REBEL GROUP WHICH WANTS TO ESTB A TRIBAL KINGDOM FOR THE COUNTRY'S LARGEST ETHNIC GROUP HAS THREATENED TO LAUNCH A FULL-SCALE CIVIL WAR. THIS THREAT WAS ISSUED AFTER UNIDENTIFIED GUNMEN ABDUCTED THE UGANDAN HEALTH MINISTER (JAMES MAKUMBI) NEAR KASANGATI (16KM N OF KAMPALA). POLICE HAVE ARRESTED SEVERAL PEOPLE IN CONNECTION, HOWEVER THE MINISTER'S WHEREABOUTS AND CONDITION ARE UNKNOWN. COMMENT: THERE IS NO COLLATERAL TO INDICATE THAT THE THREAT OF CIVIL WAR IS NOTHING MORE THAN POLITICAL RHETORIC.

(2) GHANBATT PROVIDED SY FOR THE OAU SEC GEN WHO VISITED TWO ORPHANAGES IN NYAMATA BETWEEN 1300 - 1500 HRS. HE ALSO MET WITH RPA SECTOR COMMANDER.

(3) GHANBATT PTL BASE AT RUSENYI GR 6862 MOVED TO A NEW LOC AT GITUKU GR 703637 ON 01 APR 95.

(4) AT ABOUT 022130B APR 95, A LOCAL FROM RILIMA GR 2561 REPORTED THE MURDER OF A LOCAL MALE AGED 29 YRS, 6 KM FROM RILIMA TOWARDS KABUKUBA GR 2069. HE WAS ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN SHOT BY UNIFORMED PERSONS. DECEASED WAS KNOWN TO BE WORKING FOR THE LOCAL AUTHORITY IN RILIMA. MILOBS AND LOCAL AUTH INFO AND INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS.
