IN CIVILIAN OCCUPATIONS AND ALMOST NO ORGANIZED EXGEN. HOWEVER THERE IS SUPPOSED TO BE A GROUP OF FEW HUNDRED UNORGANIZED EXGEN JUST NORTH OF AREA WHERE RHODESIAN ANGOLAN AND CONGOLESE FRONTIERS MEET. BUSINESS REASONS DOES NOT REPEAT NOT APPROVE OF ANOTHER SECESSIONIST ATTEMPT. SOME INTERESTS ARE PROBABLY BACKING AND ADVISING TSHOMBE BUT JUDGING FROM GENERAL SITUATION OF THINGS THEY ARE OF NO REPEAT NO SIGNIFICANCE. SECOND BECAUSE CIRCUMSTANCES HAVE COMPLETELY CHANGED EG KENNETH KAUNDA REPLACED ROY WELENSKY, ALSO MANY DISGRUNTLED EXGEN MAY NOT RESPOND AND THE ANC WHICH SHOULD BE DEPLOYED IN GRELLER STRENGTH MAY CONSTITUTE PARTIAL DETERRENT.
