1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION REMAINS GENERALLY CALM.

b. BORDERS.

(1) **SECTOR 1** - KAGITUMBA, RUSUMO, RUTETE AND GATUNA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(2) **SECTOR 3** - KANYARU-HAUTE AND KANYARU-BAS BORDER CROSSINGS WERE OPENED TO NORMAL FLOW OF TRAFFIC BETWEEN RWANDA AND BURUNDI.

(3) **SECTOR 4** - ALL BORDERS WERE ALL OPENED TODAY.

(4) **SECTOR 5** - ZAIRIAN/RWANDAN BORDER IS CLOSED ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE FOR IMMIGRATION OF RWANDAN NATIONALS. THE BORDER REMAINS CLOSED TO HUMANITARIAN AND UNAMIR TRAFFIC. UGANDA/RWANDA BORDER (CYANIKA BORDER POST) IS OPENED FOR NORMAL TRAFFIC.

(ii) SECTOR 3 (BUTARE) - PATROLLED AND MANNED ALL IMPORTANT PLACES AND CHECK POINTS.

(iii) AIR OPS CELL (KIA)--THE RPA CONTINUES TO MAINTAIN STRICT SECURITY AT KIA.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

(1) A MILOBS TEAM CONDUCTED A PATROL TO RUSUMO COMMUNE AND VISITED NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP, RUSUMO BORDER POST, KARAMBI AND BIRENGA TRANSIT CAMPS. THE SITUATION WAS FOUND TO BE CALM.

(2) MILOBS TEAM ALSO VISITED RUTETE BORDER, DIHIRO AND

BYUMBA TRANSIT CAMPS .THE SITUATION WAS ALSO CALM.

C. SECTOR 2 - GITARAMA.

(1) THE ACTING FORCE CDR TOGETHER WITH CMO VISITED THE SECTOR HQ THIS MORNING .THE SECT CDR AND OPS OFFR (DESIGNATED SECT CDR) BRIEFED THE VISITORS ON THE CURRENT SITUATION IN THE SECTOR AND THE LATEST ON THE GENERATOR EPISODE THE SECTOR CDR ALSO PROJECTED THE NEED TO MAINTAIN AN OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION IN KIBUYE TO FACILITATE PATROLLING IN THE KIBUYE PRIFECTURE. THE ACTING FORCE CDR AGREED IN PRINCIPLE AND SAID IT WOULD BE REVIEWED WITHIN HIS HEADQUATER. HE SPECIFICALLY HAD IN MIND THAT A ROOM COULD BE RESERVED IN THE HOTEL WHERE THE GHANA PLATOON IS ACCOMMODATED .FEEDBACK ON THIS ISSUE IS REQUESTED .

TEAM ALSO PATROLLED TO RUKONDO(GR5538) COMMUNE OF GIKONGORO PREFECTURE .SITUATION IS NORMAL.THE ASST BOURGERMESTRE INFORMED THE TEAM THAT CERTAIN NGOS LIKE CARITAS, WFP,AND UNHCR HAD PROMISED TO PROVIDE ROOFING MATERIALS TO THE REFUGEES WHO ARE MANAGING TO BUILD THEIR HOUSES BUT NONE OF THE NGO HAS GIVEN ANY HELP . THE HELP IS NOW URGENTLY REQUIRED DUE TO THE RAINING SEASON

- RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MILOBS AND LOCAL RPA
SUB - UNITS COMD .
- CONDUCT OF JOINT PATROLS .

(2) THE 59 BN(RPA) COMD, MAJOR DAWIE ALSO PAID A BRIEF
VISIT TO SECTOR 5HQ. HE HIGHLIGHTED ON INCIDENT THAT
OCCURRED AT NYAKINAMA(5827) ON 19 JAN 96.

(3) MILOBS TEAM PATROLLED KINGI (GR5341), NKUMBA (GR6639),
KIDAHU (GR7049) AND SATINSYI (GR5800) COMMUNES. THE SECURITY
SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM. INFORMATION OBTAINED
REVEALED THAT AT KIDAHU AND KINGI COMMUNES, THE
REPRESENTATIVE OF MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION INFORMED TEAM
THAT 29 RETURNEES OF 1959/60 ARRIVED FROM ZAIRE SINCE 01 JAN
TO DATE. HOWEVER, 59 RETURNEES OF 1994 HAVE SO FAR BEEN
REGISTERED AT KINGI COMMUNE FROM 06 JAN 96.



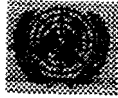

1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION REMAINS GENERALLY CALM.

b. BORDERS.

(1) **SECTOR 1** - KAGITUMBA, RUSUMO, RUTETE AND GATUNA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(2) **SECTOR 3** - KANYARU-HAUTE AND KANYARU-BAS BORDER CROSSINGS WERE OPENED TO NORMAL FLOW OF TRAFFIC BETWEEN RWANDA AND BURUNDI.

(3) **SECTOR 4** - ALL BORDERS WERE ALL OPENED TODAY.

(4) **SECTOR 5** - ZAIRIAN/RWANDAN BORDER IS CLOSED ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE FOR IMMIGRATION OF RWANDAN NATIONALS. THE BORDER REMAINS CLOSED TO HUMANITARIAN AND UNAMIR TRAFFIC. UGANDA/RWANDA BORDER (CYANIKA BORDER POST) IS OPENED FOR NORMAL TRAFFIC.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. THE PRESIDENT, MR. PASTEUR BIZIMUNGU, AND VICE-PRESIDENT, MAJ GEN PAUL KAGAME DEPARTED GISENYI ON A WORKING VISIT AT ABOUT 1900 HRS ON 21 JAN 96.FOLLOWING POINTS WERE COVERED DURING THE MEETING:

- SECURITY. INCREASE OF CIVILIANS VOLUNTARILY PATROL FROM ONE TO FOUR FOR THE GUARDING OF 10 HOUSES;
- DEFORESTATION. THE NEED TO CONTROL THE FALLING DOWN OF TREES IN GISHWATI FOREST RESERVE;
- RESETTLEMENT OF THE 1959/60 RETURNEES WITHIN GISENYI PREFECTURE AWAY FROM THE FOREST RESERVE;
- IMPROVEMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURES.

b. MILITARY.

(1) RPA.

(I) SECTOR 1 (KIBUNGO) - CONTINUES CONDUCTING VEH AND FOOT PATROLS IN KIBUNGO AND KIGALI PREFECTURES, BOTH DAY AND NIGHT.

(ii) SECTOR 3 (BUTARE) - PATROLLED AND MANNED ALL IMPORTANT PLACES AND CHECK POINTS.

(iii) AIR OPS CELL (KIA)--THE RPA CONTINUES TO MAINTAIN STRICT SECURITY AT KIA.

(2) FRGE. NTR.

(3) OTHER. NTR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - KIBUNGO.

(1) A MILOBS TEAM CONDUCTED A PATROL TO CYUNUZI, NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP, RUSUMO BORDER POST, MURAMBI (GR9359), NYABUBASE (GR9464) AND BIRENGA TRANSIT CAMP. THE SITUATION WAS FOUND TO BE CALM.

c. SECTOR 1A - KIGALI.

(1) A PATROL SENT TO DIHIRO TRANSIT CAMP REPORTED THAT SINCE 18 JAN 96 NO RETURNEES CROSSED THE BORDER FOR THIS CAMP.

(2) MILOBS VISITED BYUMBA TRANSIT CAMP AND REPORTED THAT 49 RETURNEES LOCATED IN THAT CAMP HAD BEEN SENT TO THEIR NATIVE COMMUNES WITHIN BYUMBA PREFECTURE BY UNHCR VEHs ON 23 JAN 96. NO RETURNEES IN THAT CAMP AT PRESENT.

d. SECTOR 2 - GITARAMA.

(1) THE SECT CDR VISITED THE GITARAMA PRISON AND MET WITH THE PRISON DIRECTOR. THERE ARE 6351 INMATES INCLUDING 219 WOMEN AND EXCLUDING 32 INFANTS. THE GENERAL SITUATION HAS AGAIN IMPROVED QUITE A LOT, AND THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT THE OVERALL DETENTION CONDITIONS ARE FAR BETTER THERE THAN IN ANY OF THE 17 GITARAMA COMMUNE CACHOTS.

(2) ONE MILOBS TEAM WENT TO MUGINA (GR9267) AND RUNDA

UN RESTRICTED

(GR9882) COMMUNES AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM. OFFICIALS IN TWO COMMUNES COMPLAINED OF POOR HARVEST. IN MUGINA THE TEAM WAS TOLD BY THE IPJ THAT 26 PEOPLE HAD BEEN ARRESTED SINCE 1 JAN 96, AMONG THEM 16 FOR GENOCIDE. TOTAL NUMBER OF PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE JAIL IS 328.

(3) THE TEAM ALSO VISITED THE RUYENZI TRANSIT CAMP (GR9783) AND CONFIRMED THE ARRIVAL OF 226 RETURNEES ON 19 JAN 96 AND 71 ON 20 JAN 96, TOTALLY 297. THEY HAVE BEEN DISPATCHED TO THEIR HOME PREFECTURES.

(4) ANOTHER TEAM WENT TO MASANGO COMMUNE (GR6254) AND REPORTED GENERAL SITUATION AS CALM. ONLY TWO RETURNEES HAVE ARRIVED IN THE COMMUNE ON 19 JAN 96. NUMBER OF PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE JAIL IS 296 INCLUDING 9 FEMALES, 288 OF THEM ACCUSED FOR GENOCIDE.

e. **SECTOR 3 - BUTARE.** MILOBS PATROL TEAMS VISITED KANYARU-BAS BORDER CHECK POINT AND UNHCR OFFICE IN BUTARE TO COLLECT FIGURES OF RETURNEES.

f. **SECTOR 4 - CYANGUGU.** MILOBS PATROL TEAM VISITED GISHOMA (GR8111), GATARE (GR1345), THE BORDERS AND THE TRANSIT CAMPS. NO PROBLEMS IN RESPECT OF REFUGEES REPORTED.

g. **SECTOR 5 - GISENYI.**
(1) MILOBS TEAMS PATROLLED RWERERE (GR 2722), KIBILIRA (GR 5785) AND RUBAVU (GR 2213) COMMUNES. THE SITUATION REMAINED CALM. IN RWERERE COMMUNE MILOBS WERE INFORMED BY THE BURGOMASTER THAT THE COUNCILLORS OF

UN RESTRICTED

FIVE SECTORS WERE RELIEVED RECENTLY, THREE OF THEM FOR COLLABORATION WITH FRGF AND TWO FOR SEGREGATING TRIBES.

(2) THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF GISHWATI RETURNEE CAMP (GR2497) IN KAYOVE COMMUNE INFORMED THAT 100 FAMILIES OF 1994 RETURNEES ARRIVED IN THE COMMUNE ON 18 JAN 96. IN ADDITION, HE SAID THEY WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO 2 GISHWATI CAMPS.

h. **AIR OPS.**

(1) THE GENERAL SITUATION AT THE KIA REMAINS NORMAL.

(2) A TOTAL OF 10 FLIGHTS OPERATED TODAY. DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(i) UNAMIR	- 05
(ii) HUMANITARIAN	- 01
(iii) OTHERS	- 04

4. **HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.**

a. THERE IS NO WATER IN NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP (SECT 1 KIBUNGO) DUE TO LACK OF DIESEL TO RUN THE PUMPS.

b. UNHCR IS REHABILITATING A SECONDARY SCHOOL IN LIREHE SOUS PREFECTURE, SECT 1 KIBUNGO, CLOSE TO NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP WHICH WAS PREVIOUSLY BEING USED AS A RECEPTION CENTRE FOR RETURNEES. MR. CASPAR, THE REHABILITATION OFFICIAL, REQUESTED FOR UNAMIR ASSISTANCE.

c. THE GOVERNMENT SUPPORTED BY IWF HAS STARTED THE

UN RESTRICTED

REPAIR OF THE NASHO TRACK (IN SECT 1 KIBUNGO). THIS TRACK IS 10 KM LONG LEADING FROM THE MAIN ROAD TO NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP. THE PROGRESS IS SLOW AND UNHCR IS SEEKING FOR UNAMIR ASSISTANCE TO SPEED IT UP.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS. BOTH INCOMING AND OUTGOING G3 OPS SO2 OF UNAMIR HQ VISITED **SEC 2 GITARAMA** TO ASSESS THE GROUND SITUATION AT THE ECONOMAT WHERE UNAMIR GENERATORS AND THE VEHICLE HAVE BEEN IMPOUNDED. THEY WERE BRIEFED BY THE LOG OFFR AND THE REQUIREMENT TO MAINTAIN THE SECURITY ELEMENT IN PLACE AS LONG AS THE STAND OFF PERSIST. IT WAS LEARNT BY THE SECT CDR FROM THE COS THAT A COUNTER OFFER WOULD HAVE BEEN SENT TO FATHER VJEKO IN EUROPE.

(2) SECTOR 5A (RUHENGERI) - AT 1300 HRS IT WAS CONFIRMED BY ONE NGO THAT THE RPA HAVE STOPPED ALLOWING LOCALS INCLUDING TOURISTS TO ENTER THE FOREST/TO SEE GORILLA.

(1) SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) - ON 29 DEC 95 AT ABOUT 0030 HRS THE NYAMASHEKE MEDICAL CENTRE WAS ATTACKED BY GUNMEN SUSPECTED TO BE THE FRGF MEMBERS. THREE GRENADES WERE LAUNCHED AT THE MEDICAL CENTRE BY THE ATTACKERS. IT WAS OBSERVED THAT THE ATTACKERS CAME VERY CLOSE TO THE CENTRE BUILDING AND DIRECTED FIRE ON TWO OF THE WARDS.

GRENADE SPLINTERS AND 15 EMPTY CASES OF 7.62 MM ROUNDS WERE PICKED AT THE SCENE OF THE INCIDENT. THE ROUNDS USED WERE NOT THE TYPE FOR AK 47 COMMONLY USED BY THE RPA.

FROM THE SPLINTERS, IT WAS EVIDENT THAT TWO TYPES OF GRENADES WERE USED BUT THEIR MAKES COULD NOT BE ASCERTAINED. THERE WAS NO CASUALTY RECORDED BUT THE WINDOWS AND THE WALLS OF THE CENTRE WERE DAMAGED.

ASSESSMENT: THE ACTION APPEARS TO BE AN INSURGENT ACTION. THE INSURGENTS ARE BELIEVED TO HAVE CROSSED FROM THE LAKE WHICH IS JUST SOME 250 METERS FROM THE SCENE OF INCIDENT.

CONSIDERING THE FACT THAT THE SCENE OF INCIDENT IS JUST ABOUT 150 METRES FROM THE RPA PLATOON HQ AND TROOP RESIDENCE ALSO, IT IS INFERRED THAT THE INSURGENTS CHOSE A TARGET SO CLOSE TO DEMORALIZE THE FORCE.

(1) RUSIZA 3027, LOCALS REPORT THAT ON 27 DEC ONE RPA SOLDIER ON LEAVE FROM KIGALI WAS KILLED AND HIS BROTHER WOUNDED AT APPROX 2100 HRS. IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE ACTION WAS BETWEEN SUSPECTED INTERAHAMWE AND THE RPA PERSONNEL. IT WAS FURTHER REPORTED THAT THE TUTSI RETURNEES (59/60) ATTACKED THE LOCAL HUTUS ACCUSING THEM OF HARBOURING THE INSURGENTS. ONE HUTU WAS KILLED AND FOUR WOUNDED. ALL INJURED WERE TAKEN TO THE KABATWA CLINIC 3327. ALL HAVE NOW BEEN DISCHARGED. PARC VOLCAN/BUTAKA 3229, LOCALS REPORT A CLASH BETWEEN THE RPA AND THE FRGF ON THE NIGHT 28/29 DEC. DETAILS ARE SCETCHY, HOWEVER, IT IS THOUGHT THAT THE RPA TOOK SOME CASUALTIES. THE LOCAL RPA DETACHMENT WAS VISITED HOWEVEVER, DECLINED TO AUTHENTICATE THE REPORT.

K. **SECTOR 5C - KIBUYE.**

ONE HUMANITARIAN PATROL WENT TO MUBUGA 2463 IN THE GISHYITA COMMUNE. THE SITUATION IS REPORTED AS CALM.

4. **HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.**

A. SECTOR 2A (BYUMBA) - MILOBS TEAM VISITED THE SCENE OF ACCIDENT INVOLVING A TRUCK BELONGING TO THE WFP IN MURAMBI

COMMUNE. THEY ESTABLISHED THAT THERE WERE NO INJURIES TO ANY PERSON BUT A LIMITED EXTENT OF DAMAGE TO THE WFP VEHICLE. THE VEHICLE HAS SINCE BEEN RECOVERED. THE ACCIDENT TOOK PLACE AT GR 448037. THE TRUCK WAS CONVEYING TO NYAGATARE SOME 500 BAGS OF YELLOW PEAS AND 300 BAGS OF MAIZE FOR THE RETURNEES. THE TRUCK WAS INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT BECAUSE OF BREAKS FAILURE ABOUT 3 KM NORTH OF MURAMBI COMMUNE CENTRE.

B. SECTOR 2B (KIBUNGO) - THE BOURGEMESTRE OF KAYONZA HAS DIRECTED THE SECTOR LEADERS TO RETURN THE PROPERTIES BELONGING TO THE RETURNEES ON THEIR ARRIVAL TO THE COMMUNE. IN ADDITION 94 PLOTS OF LAND HAVE BEEN EARMARKED FOR ALLOCATION TO THE RETURNEES WITHOUT ANY LAND. THE BOURGEMESTRE HAS ALSO REQUESTED ASSISTANCE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ACCESS ROAD OF APPROX 2.5 KM LENGTH TO THESE PLOTS. PREPARATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF 70 HOUSES IS UNDER WAY FOR ALLOTMENT TO THE RETURNEES. THE HOUSES ARE EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BY FEB 95.

C. SECTOR 5C (RUHENGERI) - THE SECTOR TRANSPORTED A TRUCK LOAD OF FIRE WOOD FROM MUBUGA TO KIBUYE, FOR ECOLE NORMALE TECHNIQUE. THE TCV OF THE GHANCOY PLATOON WAS USED TO CONVEY THE WOOD.

5. **CIVILIAN AFFAIRS.**

A. SECTOR 1A (KIGALI) - 24 RETURNEES JOINED KANOMBE COMMUNE IN DECEMBER SO FAR.

B. SECTOR 2A (BYUMBA) - IN KIZIGURO HOSPITAL OF MURAMBI COMMUNE MILOBS FOUND OUT THAT PATIENTS NOW WERE BEING ASKED TO PAY FOR THEIR TREATMENT, THUS MAKING IT DIFFICULT FOR THE LOCALS TO GO FOR TREATMENT DUE TO THAT, THEY WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO MEET THE EXPENSES INVOLVED.

C. SECTOR 2B (KIBUNGO) - THERE ARE 02 RETURNEES LEFT IN BIRENGA TRANSIT CAMP. 28 RETURNEES WERE TRANSPORTED TO VARIOUS COMMUNES.

D. SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) - THERE ARE 4 REFUGEE LEFT IN THE BUGARAMA CITE TRANSIT CAMP AND 120 REFUGEES IN NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP.

E. SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) - THERE ARE 332 RETURNEES REMAINING IN NKAMIRA TRANSIT CAMP. 203 RETURNEES WERE TRANSPORTED TO VARIOUS COMMUNES TODAY.

F. SECTOR 5C (KIBUYE) - 10 RETURNEES WERE TRANSPORTED TO NYAMISHABA TRANSIT CAMP. THERE ARE TOTAL OF 10 RETURNEES AT THE CAMP.


