RE: Comments on the Hendrickson Mediterranean
Mission Directives.

Attached are our comments on the Hendrickson Mediterranean Mission directives, together with those of Welfare, Health and Personnel.

All but those of Personnel point out what I feel to be the major error -- the attempt to subordinate the functional people and isolate them from their respective directors.

We, and to some extent Health, should not only resist this with respect to having our people work only through District Administrators but also with respect to the matter of having a single head of services under the Chief of Mission and above our people. The latter arrangement overlooks the international and inter-area character of our work and interposes difficulties of communication which are only too well exemplified by recent events in Cairo.

The former item -- that of having to go through district administrators to get to the functional chief -- is equally objectionable to Welfare as to us, and seems to me indefensible.
