

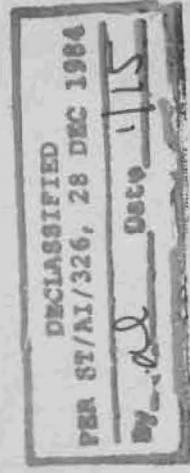

Born at London, U.K., 19th of October 1937

Place of residence: Johannesburg, South Africa and Katanga. Mr Osborn claims that his passport has been taking care of by the Katanga Government.

1/ Mr. Osborn was deported from Leopoldville to Brazaville in the later part of April. He travelled by air from Brazaville to Johannesburg.

2/ Mr. Osborn claims that he returned to Katanga in the later part of May without the knowledge of the officials of the South Africa Government.


3/ Concerning Mr. Osborns return to Katanga he refuses to answer any question, except for that his main reason was to collect money he was due in Katanga.

4/ About the anti UN - newspaper article signed by Mr. Osborn he states that as far as he is concerned it was not directed against UN. The treatment he had received in Kamina prior to beeing taking to Leopoldville was contrary to colonel Egges instructions, and in Mr. Osborns oppinion close to inhuman. Mr. Osborn refuses to contradict his statements in the article.

5/ Mr. Osborn refuses to answer any other question about his whereabouts.


