DAILY SITREP FOR 22 FEB 96

1. HIGHLIGHTS

A. THE OVERALL MILITARY SITUATION IN RWANDA IS STABLE AND CONTINUES TO IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. SITUATION ALONG THE BORDER AREAS REMAIN TENSE. RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES CONTINUES.

B. BORDER CROSSING:

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE DAY WAS 4338. 339 CAME FROM ZAIRE, 256 CAME FROM TANZANIA AND 3743 CAME FROM BURUNDI. OUT FLOW IS NIL.

(2) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE MONTH TO-DATE IS 25498. OUT FLOW-NIL.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.

A. THE SRSG MET WITH THE AMBASSADORS OF BRITAIN AND FRANCE IN RWANDA , AND EXCHANGED VIEWS WITH REGARD TO THE OVERALL SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY AND FUTURE UN PRESENCE IN RWANDA. THEREAFTER ,THE SRSG HELD A MEETING WITH MR IAN MARTIN OF HRFOR AND VIEWED PROGRESS REGARDING HUMAN RIGHTS SITUATION IN COUNTRY. IN THE EVENING THE SRSG HELD A RECEPTION ON THE OCCASION OF THE 1ST ANNIVERSARY OF RADIO UNAMIR.

B. ACCORDING TO RADIO RWANDA, THE GOVERNMENT HAD EXPRESSED ITS DISSATISFACTION OVER THE DELAY IN THE OPERATIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA. THE RWANDAN MINISTER OF JUSTICE, MRS MARTHE MUKAMURENZI, STATED THAT LACK OF EVIDENCE AGAINST THE SUSPECT, AS VIEWED BY THE TRIBUNAL, DOES NOT HOLD GOOD, BECAUSE HER GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN PROVIDING ALL POSSIBLE EVIDENCE AGAINST THEM AND SHALL CONTINUE TO DO SO IN THE FUTURE.

3. OWN ACTIVITIES THE FORCE COMMANDER VISITED KABUGA PRISON UNDER RENOVATION IN KIGALI AND MET WITH THE RWANDESE DEPUTY MINISTER OF JUSTICE, MR GERALD GAHIMA, WITH WHOM HE DISCUSSED THE ISSUE OF RENOVATION/IMPROVEMENT OF EXISTING LOCAL FACILITIES TO BE USED AS PRISONS IN AN ATTEMPT TO DE-CONGEST THE EXISTING OVERCROWDED PRISONS IN THE COUNTRY.

4. MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA/GENDARMERIE. NSTR.

B. FRGF/MILITIA.

(1) IN SECTOR 2 (GITARAMA) AT GISOVU COMMUNE (GR 2951) AND GISHYITA COMMUNE (GR 2062) OF KIBUYE PREFECTURE THE BOURGEMESTRE REPORTED OF SOME INTRUSIONS FROM ZAIRE WHICH RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF TWO PERSONS IN BISESERO SECTOR (GR 2660) IN JANUARY 96 AND TWO PERS INJURED IN MUSENYI SECTOR (GR 2263) LAST WEEK.

(2) IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) IT WAS MADE KNOWN BY THE BOURGEMESTRE OF KIBOGORA (GR 0443) THAT TEN ARMED MEN PASSED THROUGH HIS COMMUNE AT ABOUT 2300 HRS ON 21 FEB 96. THEY WERE SAID TO HAVE HEADED FOR THE FOREST. THE RPA WERE SPOTTED COMBING THE GENERAL AREA.

(3) IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) AT RAMBA COMMUNE (GR 3123), IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE SABOTAGE AND STEALING ACTIVITIES ARE STILL ACTIVE IN THE COMMUNE BY THE SUSPECTED INTERHAMWE ELEMENTS.

5. HUMANITARIAN.

A. 70 RETURNEES ARRIVED AT RUYENZI OWS FROM NKAMIRA. 128 RETURNEES DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO GISENYI, KIBUNGO, GITARAMA, BYUMBA AND KIGALI. A TOTAL NO OF 465 RETURNEES STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM RUYENZI CAMP.

B. INDBATT PROVIDED FOUR TRUCKS TO UNHCR FOR TRANSPORTING RETURNEES FROM DIHIRO TRANSIT CAMP. THEY ALSO DONATED 1300 CEMENT BLOCKS TO MISSIONARIES OF CHARITY (MOTHER TERESA'S GROUP) .

C. FORCE ENGINEER COY PROVIDED ONE VEHICLE TO ARDEC FOR TRANSPORTING WOOD FROM KIGALI TO BUTARE. ALSO PROVIDED ONE VEHICLE TO ARDEC FOR TRANSPORTING WOOD AND DEPLOYED ONE DOZER FOR WFP IN KIGALI.

D. FORCE SIGNAL COY PROVIDED ONE TRUCK FOR TRANSPORTATION OF WOOD FROM RUNDA TO RUGALIKA AND RUGALIKA TO NYAMAHURU ON THE REQUEST OF LOCAL ORGANISATION ARDEC.

H. UNAMIR MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 96 AND 14 DENTAL PATIENTS.

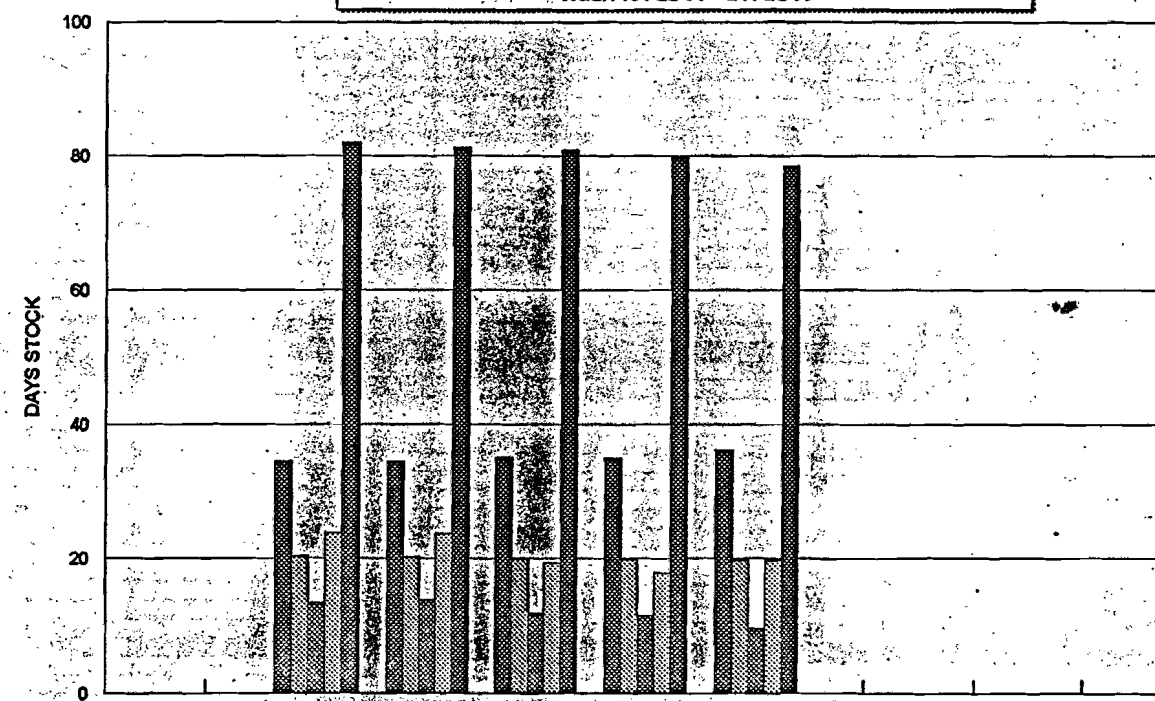



DAILY SITREP FOR 23 FEB 96

1. HIGHLIGHTS

A. THE OVERALL MILITARY SITUATION IN RWANDA IS STABLE AND CONTINUES TO IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. SITUATION ALONG THE BORDER AREAS REMAIN TENSE. RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES CONTINUES.

B. BORDER CROSSING:

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE DAY WAS 629. 444 CAME FROM UGANDA, 39 FROM BURUNDI AND 146 FROM ZAIRE. OUT FLOW IS NIL.

(2) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE MONTH TO-DATE IS 26127. OUT FLOW IS NIL.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.

A. THE SRSG MET WITH MR. GREENE OF THE IRISH FOREIGN MINISTRY AND HELD DISCUSSION REGARDING BILATERAL AID TO RWANDA. HE ALSO HELD SEVERAL INTERNAL MEETINGS WITH STAFF MEMBERS AND FINALLY MET WITH MR. FREDERICK PFICHER OF LE MONDE FOR AN INTERVIEW.

B. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT WILL NOT HAVE POLITICAL NEGOTIATIONS WITH RDR AND RWANDA POUR TOUS AS DOING SO WOULD TANTAMOUNT TO ACCEPTING THE LEGITIMACY OF THEIR LEADERSHIP. THE LEADERS OF THESE GROUPS BELONG TO MRND AND CDR, THE POLITICAL PARTIES WHICH PLANNED AND CARRIED OUT THE GENOCIDE. THE OFFER BY THESE GROUPS FOR DIALOGUE RIGHTLY CONFIRMS THE GOVERNMENT'S APPREHENSIONS THAT SUPPORT IS OFFERED TO THEM BY SOME POWERFUL MEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY.

C. THE RADIO FURTHER REPORTED THAT ZAIRE HAS BANNED RDR AND STOPPED UNHCR ACTIVITIES IN KIBUMBA AND NYANGEZI REFUGEE CAMPS.

3. OWN ACTIVITIES THE FORCE COMMANDER VISITED MILOB SECTOR 3 HQ (BUTARE), ALTERNATE TRANSIT CAMP (BUTARE) AND KANYARU-HAUTE BORDER CHECK POINT WHERE HE WAS BRIEFED BY THE MILOB SECTOR COMMANDER AND UNHCR OFFICIALS REGARDING THE REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES AND ASSISTANCE REQUIRED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ALTERNATE TRANSIT CAMP.

4. MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

(3) IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) ON THE 15 FEB 96, SOME INFILTRATORS ENTERED RUTUMBA SECTOR (GR 6743) OF NKUMBA COMMUNE AND KILLED ONE PERSON. FOUR PERSONS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN THIS REGARD.

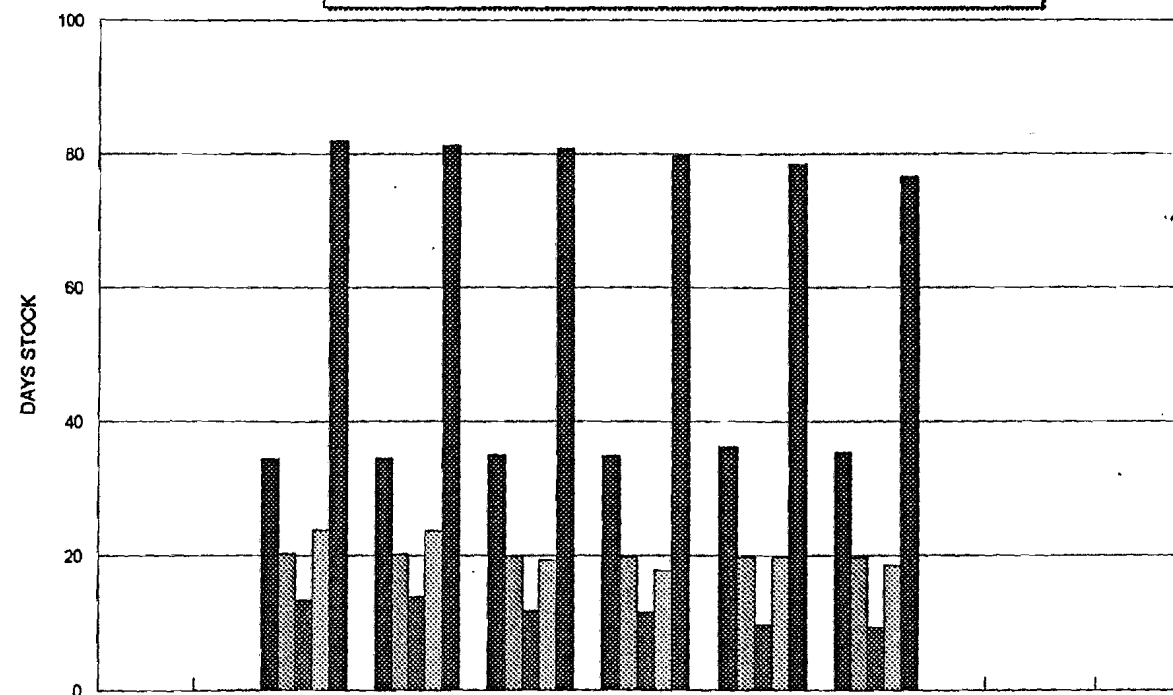



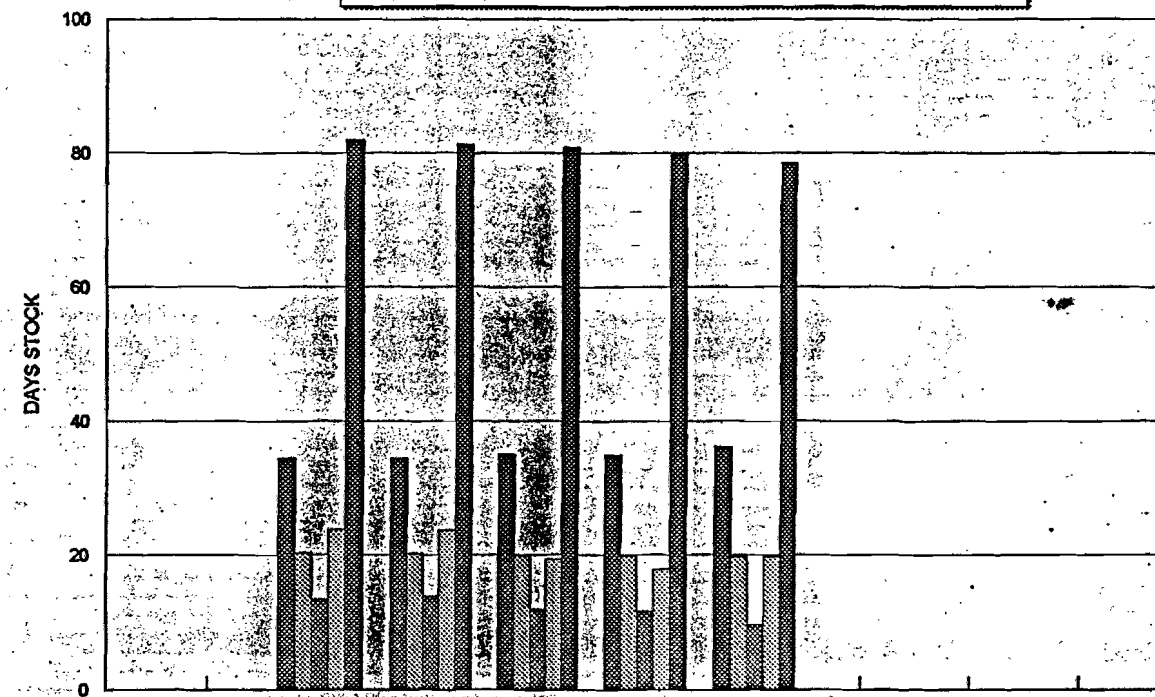

DAILY SITREP FOR 21 FEB 96

1. **HIGHLIGHTS**

A. THE OVERALL MILITARY SITUATION IN RWANDA IS STABLE AND CONTINUES TO IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. SITUATION ALONG THE BORDER AREAS REMAIN TENSE. RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES CONTINUES.

B. **BORDER CROSSING:**

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE DAY WAS 3500. 466 CAME FROM ZAIRE AND 3034 CAME FROM BURUNDI. OUT FLOW IS NIL.

(2) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE MONTH TO-DATE IS 21160. OUT FLOW-NIL.

2. **POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.**

A. THE SRSG ATTENDED A MEETING OF THE MILITARY OBSERVERS IN KIBUNGO AND WAS BRIEFED ABOUT THE SECURITY ASPECTS CONCERNING THAT SECTOR.

B. LATER MR GREENE OF IRISH FOREIGN MINISTRY CALLED ON THE SRSG AT HIS OFFICE AND DISCUSSED THE FOLLOW-UP OF SOCIO-ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE TO RWANDA. IN THE AFTERNOON THE SRSG MET WITH PRESIDENT PASTER BIZIMUNGU IN ORDER TO DISCUSS THE FUTURE UN PRESENCE IN RWANDA.

C. IN THE EVENING THE SRSG HELD AN INFORMAL DISCUSSIONS WITH AMBASSADOR DUSSAULT OF CANADA AND EXCHANGED VIEWS ON THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY.

D. RWANDA GOVERNMENT HAD SIGNED A PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH UNDP TO REHABILITATE AND EQUIP COMMUNAL BUILDINGS AND TO PROVIDE FACILITIES TO ACCOMMODATE BOURGMESTRES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY AT A COST OF 3.6 MILLION DOLLARS.

3. **OWN ACTIVITIES**

A. THE MALAWI DELEGATION LED BY MAJ GEN BINAULI, CALLED UPON THE ACTING FORCE COMMANDER IN THE MORNING. THE ACTING FORCE COMMANDER LATER MET REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE CANADIAN DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL TRADE WHO WERE ON A VISIT TO RWANDA AND DISCUSSED THE OVERALL SECURITY SITUATION.

B. SECTOR 1 (KIBUNGO) - MILOBS SECTOR COMMANDER'S CONFERENCE WAS HELD ON 21 FEB 96 AT THE SECT HQ ATTENDED BY

THE SRSG, CMO, SOO, SMPO, G3 OPS AND OTHER STAFF OFFICERS FROM MILOB GROUP HQs. DISCUSSIONS WERE BASED ON THE RETURNEES SITUATION, UNAMIR WITHDRAWAL, COOPERATION WITH UN AGENCIES AND OTHER NGOS, THE RECONCILIATION PROCESS, STATE OF PRISONS AND THE ROLE OF RPA.

4. **MILITARY ACTIVITIES.**

A. **RPA/GENDARMERIE.** SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) - ON 17 FEB 96, TWO RETURNEES BOTH JUVENILES SUSPECTED TO BE INVOLVED IN GENOCIDE, WERE ARRESTED IN GAKARARA (GR 3921) OF Koba SECTOR AFTER THEY RETURNED FROM ZAIRE ON 16 FEB 96.

B. **FRGF/MILITIA.**

(1) SECTOR 2 (GITARAMA) - IN GIKOMA SECTOR (GR 8153), FOUR ARMED BANDITS SHOT DEAD ONE PERSON AT ABOUT 2300 HRS ON 18 FEB 96. THE WIFE OF THE DECEASED WAS SEVERELY BEATEN AND ROBBED OF 14000 FRW AND TWO CASES OF BEER. RPA CARRYING OUT INVESTIGATIONS.

(2) SECTOR 2 (GITARAMA) - IN MUSAMO SECTOR GS 7952, ARMED BANDITS ATTACKED ONE FAMILY AND DEMANDED MONEY. AS THE MONEY WAS NOT FORTHCOMING, THEY BEAT UP FAMILY MEMBERS SEVERELY. NO ARRESTS HAVE BEEN MADE SO FAR.

(3) SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) - FIVE ARMED MEN IN DIFFERENT INCIDENTS ON 09, 16 AND 17 FEB 96 ROBBED HOUSES IN RUBONA (GR 0854), CYARWA (GR 1257) AND A SHOP IN MUTANDA (GR 1355) SECTORS. THEY ESCAPED WITH 1,000,000 AND 69,000 FRW FROM HOUSES AND ALL THE VALUABLES FROM THE SHOP RESPECTIVELY. THE LOCALS SUSPECT THE INVOLVEMENT OF RPA BECAUSE ONE OLD LADY RECOGNISED THREE OF THE FIVE AS RPA SOLDIERS.

(4) IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) ON 10 FEB 96, ONE PERSON THREW A GRENADE ON RPA PATROL. THE SUSPECT WITH ONE RPA SOLDIER WERE KILLED AND THREE OTHER SOLDIERS WERE INJURED AND CURRENTLY BEING TREATED AT RUHengeri HOSPITAL.

(5) IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) ON 19 FEB 96 AT ABOUT 2000 HRS ONE TEACHER WITH ANOTHER PERSON WERE SHOT DEAD BY TWO UNKNOWN ARMED PERSONS IN MUKINGO COMMUNE (GR 5129). ON THE SAME DAY IN KANZA SECTOR (GR 6029) OF NYAKIMANA COMMUNE (GR 5927) THERE WAS AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN AN RPA PATROL AND SUSPECTED INTERAHAMWE. NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED ON EITHER SIDE.

(6) IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) ON 14 FEB 96, ONE PERSON WAS SHOT IN THE SHOULDER BY ARMED UNIFORM MEN SUSPECTED TO BE FRGF.

5. HUMANITARIAN.

A. 1993 RETURNEES ARRIVED AT RUYENZI OWS FROM GITARAMA. 1869 RETURNEES DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO BUTARE. A TOTAL NO OF 523 RETURNEES STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM RUYENZI CAMP.

B. INDBATT PROVIDED 04 TRUCKS TO UNHCR FOR MOVEMENT OF RETURNEES FROM DIHIRO TRANSIT CAMP TO NGENDA AND NEARBY COMMUNES. A TOTAL OF 174 WERE TRANSPORTED.

C. INDBATT ALSO TRANSPORTED 600 CEMENT BLOCKS FOR KIGALI ORPHANAGE (MOTHER TERESA'S GROUP) FROM KACYIRU AND CARRIED OUT ELECTRIFICATION OF MISSIONARIES OF CHARITY ORPHANAGE IN KIGALI.

D. FORCE ENGR COY PROVIDED ONE VEHICLE TO ARDEC FOR TRANSPORTING WOOD, DEPLOYED ONE DOZER FOR LEVELLING OF GROUND IN KIGALI AND DESPATCHED AN EXCAVATOR CUM DIGGER FOR ICRC FOR CREATING SANITARY FACILITIES IN A DETENTION CENTRE IN KIBUNGO.

F. FORCE SIGNAL COY PROVIDED ONE TRUCK FOR TRANSPORTATION OF WOOD FROM RUNDA TO RUGALIKA AND RUGALIKA TO NYAMAHURU ON THE REQUEST OF LOCAL ORGANISATION ARDEC.

G. UNAMIR MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 95 MEDICAL AND 12 DENTAL PATIENTS.

DAILY SITREP FOR 16 FEB 96

1. HIGHLIGHTS

A. THE OVERALL MILITARY SITUATION IN RWANDA IS STABLE AND CONTINUES TO IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. SITUATION ALONG THE BORDER AREAS REMAIN TENSE. RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES CONTINUES.

B. BORDER CROSSING:

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE 1480. 264 CAME IN FROM TANZANIA, 685 FROM BURUNDI, 244 FROM UGANDA AND 287 FROM ZAIRE. OUTFLOW IS NIL.

(2) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE MONTH TO-DATE IS 16935. OUTFLOW-NIL.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.

A. THE RWANDAN GOVT IS EXPLORING THE POSSIBILITY OF TRANSPORTING SECOND HELICOPTER FROM ZAIRE BY THE UNAMIR PLANE.

B. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT AS PER THE RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY THE TRIPARTITE MEETING BETWEEN UNHCR, BURUNDI AND RWANDA, ALL REFUGEE CAMPS IN BURUNDI ARE TO BE CLOSED WITH EFFECT FROM 15 FEB 96. CONSEQUENTLY AROUND 100,000 REFUGEES IN NGOZI ARE READY TO RETURN. AS SUCH THE CONCERNED INSTITUTIONS WERE LOOKING INTO THE MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION FOR REFUGEES. IT IS EXPECTED THAT FOUR CAMPS IN THAT AREA WOULD BE EMPTIED BETWEEN 5 - 10 DAYS.

C. THE RADIO FURTHER REPORTED THAT THE GERMAN TECHNICAL COOPERATION "GTZ" HAS PLEDGED 2,000,000 DM TO THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE, TO HELP BUILDING THE RWANDAN JUDICIAL SYSTEM.

(2) IN SECTOR 5 (KIBUYE) SOUND OF FIRING WAS HEARD OFF THE SHORE OF KIVU AT ABOUT 0100 HRS ON 16 FEB 96, BODIES OF TWO SUSPECTED INFILTRATORS WERE SWEEPED ASHORE AND FOUND AROUND THE GUEST HOUSE POSSIBLY KILLED DURING THE EXCHANGE OF FIRE. HUMAN RIGHT WAS INFORMED.

H. UNAMIR MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 76 MEDICAL AND 13 DENTAL PATIENTS.

THERE HAS BEEN NO APPRECIABLE CHANGE IN THE NUMBER OF RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE AS WELL. NECESSARY CORDINATION HAS BEEN CARRIED OUT WITH UNHCR AND GOVT OF RWANDA TO MEET ANY SUCH CONTINGENCY.

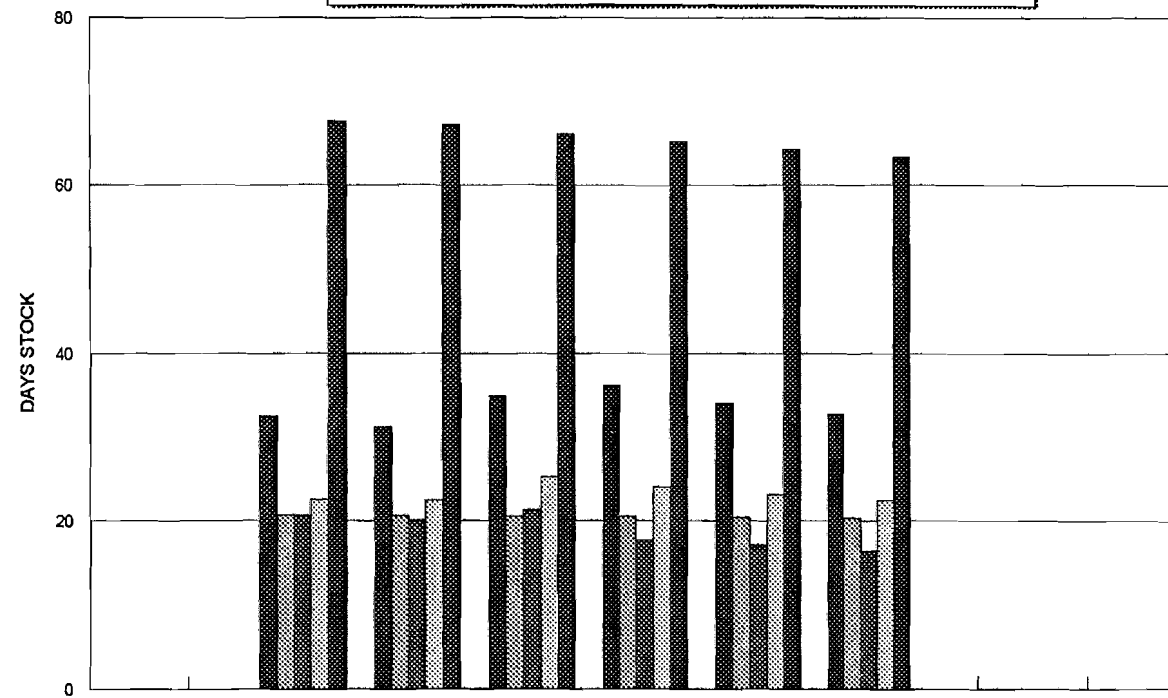



1. HIGHLIGHTS

A. THE OVERALL MILITARY SITUATION IN RWANDA IS STABLE AND CONTINUES TO IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. SITUATION ALONG THE BORDER AREAS REMAIN TENSE. RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES CONTINUES.

B. BORDER CROSSING:

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE DAY IS 2640. 387 CAME IN FROM TANZANIA, 2082 FROM BURUNDI AND 171 FROM ZAIRE. OUTFLOW IS NIL.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.

1. HIGHLIGHTS

A. THE OVERALL MILITARY SITUATION IN RWANDA IS STABLE AND CONTINUES TO IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. SITUATION ALONG THE BORDER AREAS REMAIN TENSE. RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES CONTINUES.

B. BORDER CROSSING;

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE DAY IS 300. 114 CAME FROM TANZANIA AND 186 CAME FROM BURUNDI. OUT FLOW-NIL.

(2) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE MONTH TO-DATE IS 11936. OUT FLOW-NIL.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

A. SRSG, DCOS(OPS), MILOB SECTOR 5 CDR AND NICOY CDR ALONGWITH THE RWANDAN FOREIGN MINISTER WITNESSED THE HANDING OVER CEREMONY WHERE THE ZAIRE GOVT HANDED OVER CERTAIN WEAPONS AND EQPTS TAKEN BY FRGF DURING THEIR RETREAT TO ZAIRE, TO THE RWANDAN GOVT OFFICIALS ON 13 FEB 96 AT THE ZAIRE/RWANDAN BORDER IN GISENYI. B. THE SRSG REVIEWED PLAN PRESENTED BY UNHCR TO ACCEPT LARGE NUMBER OF REFUGEES IN CASE THEY RETURN TO RWANDA FROM ZAIRIAN

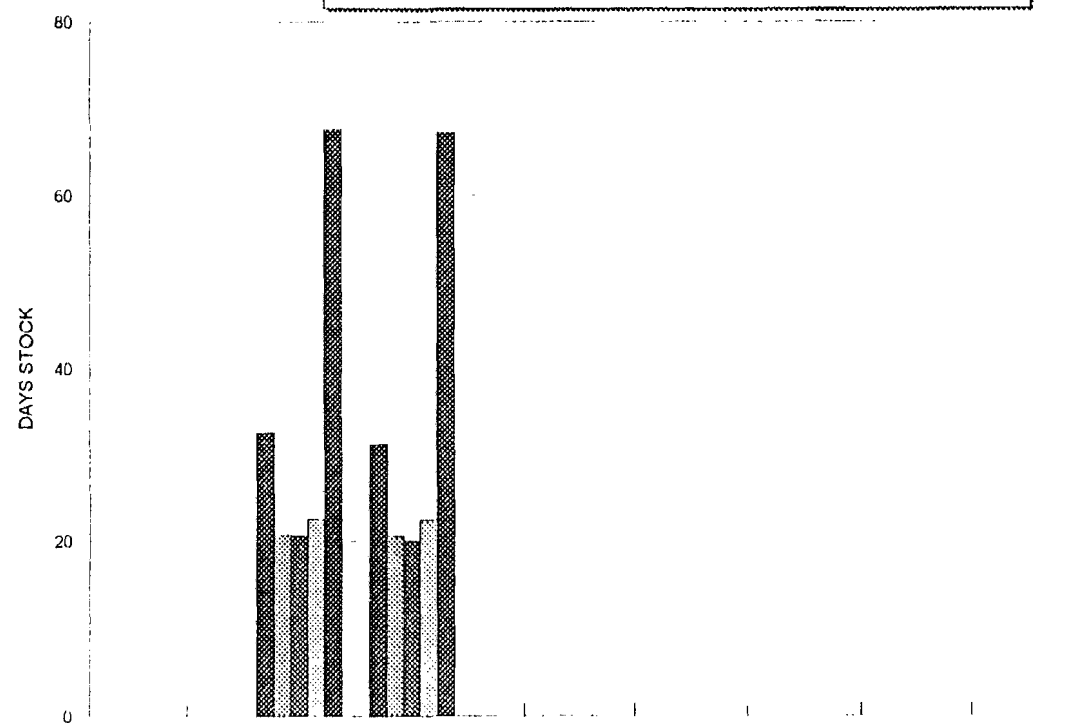

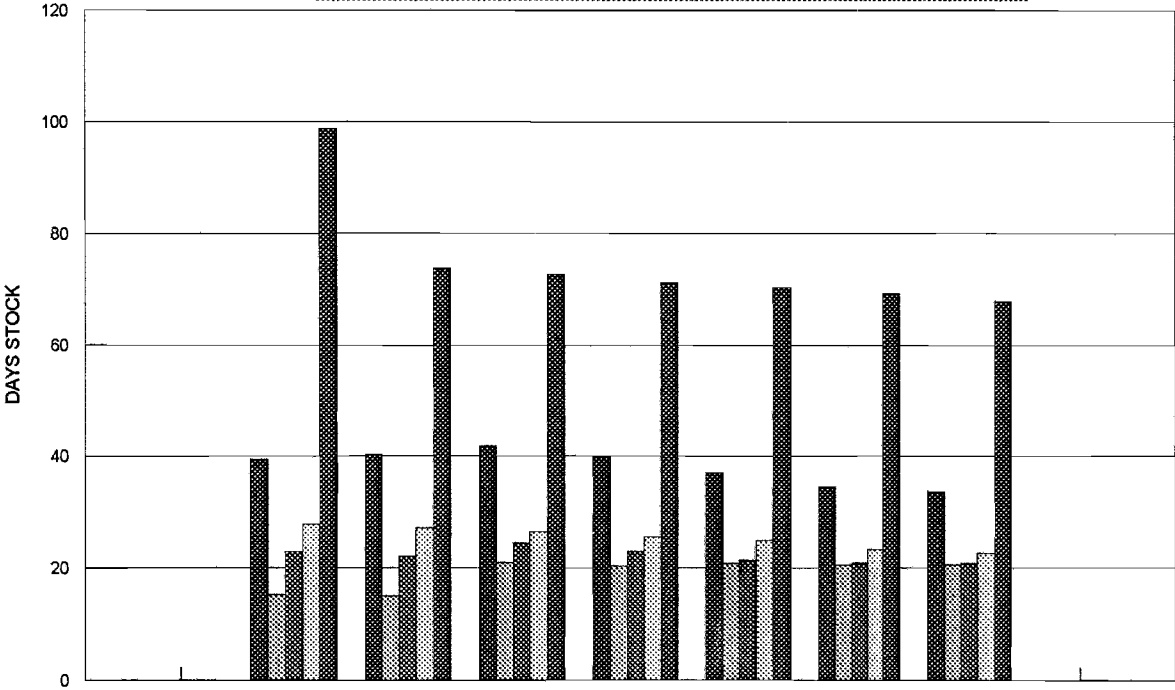



A. THE OVERALL MILITARY SITUATION IN RWANDA IS STABLE AND CONTINUES TO IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. SITUATION ALONG THE BORDER AREAS REMAIN TENSE. RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES CONTINUES.

B. **BORDER CROSSING:**

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE DAY IS **945**. ALL CAME FROM ZAIRE. OUTFLOW IS **NIL**.

(2) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE MONTH TO DATE IS **8978** AND OUTFLOW IS **NIL**.

2. **POLITICAL ACTIVITIES** RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT ZAIREAN SOLDIERS AND INTERAHAMWE MILITIAS ARE CARRYING OUT VIOLENT ACTS AGAINST THE ZAIREAN PEOPLE OF RWANDAN ORIGIN OF 1885 AND 1920. AMONG THE 3000 RETURNEES, 2700 WERE OLD IMMIGRANTS OF 1885 TO 1958. THIS SHOWS THAT RETURNING REFUGEES ARE MIXED WITH ZAIREANS OF RWANDAN ORIGIN.

B. **FRGF/MILITIA**. IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI), ON 06 FEB 96 SOME INFILTRATORS ENTERED A HOUSE IN RUSIZA SECTOR (GR 3028) AND GOT AWAY WITH MOST OF THE OWNERS BELONGINGS.

4. **OWN ACTIVITIES**. THE ACTING FORCE COMMANDER VISITED SHAGASHA AND KIBUYE ON 09 FEB 96. AT SHAGASHA, HE VISITED THE LOG BASE WHERE HE DISCUSSED THE REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES. AT KIBUYE, HE VISITED THE PLATOON EX-GHANCOY AND ALSO MET THE EXPERTS OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL WORKING THERE, EXHUMING THE REMAINS OF GENOCIDE VICTIMS.

5. **HUMANITARIAN**

A. NO RETURNEES ARRIVED AT RUYENZI CAMP. 161 RETURNEES WERE DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO BYUMBA, BUTARE, GISENYI, KIGALI TOWN, KIGALI RURAL, GITARAMA, KIBUYE AND KIBUNGO. A TOTAL OF 120 RETURNEES ARE AWAITING EVACUATION.

B. INDBATT PROVIDED TWO TRUCKS TO "CONCERN WORLD WIDE" FOR DISTRIBUTION OF BLANKETS AND FOOD STUFF TO VARIOUS COMMUNES IN BUTARE. THEY ALSO TRANSPORTED 08 TONNES OF FOOD TO VARIOUS SECTORS IN KIGALI PREFECTURE AND TRANSPORTED BUILDING MATERIALS FOR AN NGO "FOURTH WAVE" FROM GIKONGORO TO KIGALI.

C. NICOY ASSISTED "FOOD FOR THE HUNGRY" WITH 2 TRUCKS TO TRANSPORT BURNT BRICKS WITHIN GISENYI PREFECTURE.

D. FORCE ENGR COY PROVIDED ONE VEHICLE TO ARDEC FOR TRANSPORTATION OF BRICKS/WOOD, DEPLOYED ONE DOZER FOR TRANSIT CAMP IN CYANGUGU, ONE EXCAVATOR CUM DIGGER AND TWO DUMPERS TO RPA KIGALI AND ALSO DESPATCHED A TEAM FOR SECURITY FENCING AND LIGHTING IN BUTARE PRISON.

E. FORCE SIG COY PROVIDED ONE TRUCK FOR TRANSPORTATION OF WOOD FROM RUNDA TO KIBAYA ON THE REQUEST OF ARDEC.

F. UNAMIR MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 142 MEDICAL AND 13 DENTAL PATIENTS.

6. **CIVILIAN AFFAIRS.** IN SECTOR 1 (KIBUNGO) - THREE UNAMIR REPRESENTATIVES AND THREE OTHERS FROM THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE VISITED THE KIBUNGO PRISON TO CHECK ON THE CONDITION OF PRISONERS. SECURITY WAS PROVIDED BY THE RPA.

7. **SECURITY AND SAFETY OF PERSONNEL** IN SECTOR 2 (GITARAMA), ON 09 FEB 96 THE RADIO ANTENNA OF RURAL SHOOT WAS STOLEN.

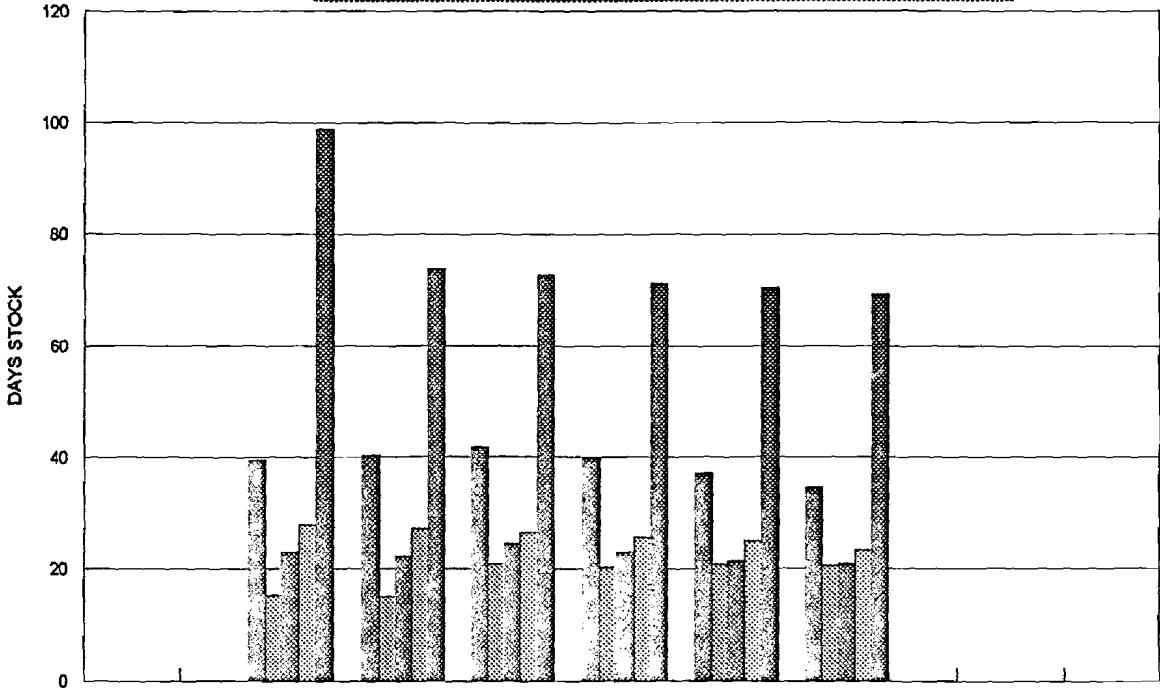

RUSIZI BORDER POSTS AND UVIRA BORDER POST OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IN SECT 5 IS CLOSED TO RWANDAN NATIONALS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL, ON THE ZAIRIAN SIDE. B. BORDER CROSSING:

(1) TOTAL INFLOW FOR THE DAY IS **1351**. 944 CAME FROM ZAIRE AND 407 FROM BURUNDI. OUTFLOW IS **NIL**.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

A. IN AN INTERVIEW WITH RADIO RWANDA ON 07 FEBRUARY, PRESIDENT PASTEUR BIZIMUNGU APPEALED TO INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY TO MONITOR THE DELIVERY OF ARMS IN THE REFUGEE CAMPS WHICH COULD BE USED FOR ATTACK AGAINST RWANDA. HE ALSO CALLED FOR PUTTING PRESSURE UPON ZAIRE, SO THAT RWANDA COULD RECEIVE ITS REMAINING PROPERTY, BESIDES THE HANDING OVER OF TWO HELICOPTERS OUT OF NINE HELI BY ZAIRE. THE HANDING OVER CEREMONY WILL TAKE PLACE ON 12 FEB 96.

B. WITH REGARDS TO THE RETURN OF REFUGEES, PRESIDENT BIZIMUNGU SAID, THE RWANDAN OFFICIALS' VISITS, LIKE THE RECENT VISIT OF THE RWANDAN PRIME MINISTER TO TANZANIA, WERE MEANT TO GIVE REFUGEES ASSURANCE, SO THAT THEY CAN COME HOME, AND IF THEY DON'T, THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT WILL HAVE AN EVIDENCE, THAT IT HAD DONE ITS UTMOST TO ENCOURAGE THEM TO COME BACK. HE INDICATED THAT THE TANZANIAN GOVERNMENT WAS IN THE PROCESS OF SEPARATING INTIMIDATORS FROM THE REST OF RWANDAN REFUGEES SO THAT THEY CAN FREELY RETURN HOME.

A. RPA/GENDARMERIE

(1) IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) ONE PERSON WAS KILLED BY RPA IN NYAKINAMA (GR 5827), WHEN HE REFUSED TO STOP AFTER BEING CHALLENGED DURING CURFEW HRS.

(2) THE RPA DEMINING TEAM HAS COMMENCED WORK IN KINGI (GR 5440) ALONG THE TRACKS AND FOOTPATHS AND WOULD SOON

MOVE TO CYERU (GR 8935) AND BUTARO (GR 8144).

(3) THE LOCAL RPA CDR REPORTED THAT THERE WAS SECOND ANTI PERS MINE INCIDENT ON 06 FEB 96, NEAR KINHIRA RESETTLEMENT CAMP (GR 2896). THE INCIDENT OCCURRED WHEN PEOPLE RUSHED TO HELP THE INJURED PERSON IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE FIRST INCIDENT AT 0800 HRS. IN THIS A WOMAN LOST HER LEG AND A MAN WAS INJURED. THEY HAVE BEEN ADMITTED AT GISENYI HOSPITAL.

B. FRGF/MILITIA.

(1) IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) IN SATINSYI COMMUNE (GR 5800) THE ASST BURGOMASTER REPORTED THE DEATH OF AN UNKNOWN PERSON IN MATYAZO SECTOR [GR 5908]. HIS BODY WAS FOUND BY THE LOCALS ON THE ROAD SIDE OF THE SECTOR.

(2) IN CYBINGO COMMUNE, SECTOR NYUNDO (GR 6123) THREE FRGF MEN WERE KILLED BY LOCALS WITH MACHETES ON 08 FEB 96, THEY WERE REPORTED TO HAVE INDULGED IN STEALING FROM THE LOCALS IN THE AREA.
