


1. In reference A, you had requested for blankets. I will need to clarify several points with you regarding your letter requesting for assistance dated 18 Nov 95 in which you had requested for blankets.

a. Firstly we do not have the blankets, but we have requested all NGOs for assistance and the "Austrian Relief Service" have kindly donated several thousand which have been distributed by MILOBS in the various sectors according to the receipt of requests on a first come first serve basis. Blankets will therefore be issued to your sector once they become available.

b. In regards to the relationship between the Prefect and UNAMIR, please note that the Prefecture citizens and their authorities have received a tremendous amount of assistance from UNAMIR. A complete list of this assistance will be forwarded to you in due course. This list is to convince the prefect and other authorities that the UN is trying its best to provide as much as it can despite the limited resources it has not only to Kibuye but to Rwanda as a whole. It is sad to note here that despite these assistance they are still not satisfied and appreciate very little even arresting people and putting them in jail for speaking to UNAMIR. Assistance rendered to date is even to the extent of providing the Prefect of Kibuye with a UNAMIR vehicle which is serviced at the workshop when it is due, that should be a good point of contention.

2. In the meantime we will endeavour to acquire more blankets from NGOs which will be issued to you for distribution by MILOBS in your sector.

1. At reference A it was approved that combat rations be issued to MILOBS Sector 4 and Sector 5B as requested by them.

2. These rations are to be consumed in emergency situations only. In the event of a sudden large influx of refugees into Rwanda, roads leading to and from border posts and most main roads will be rendered impassable, resulting in MILOBS patrols stranded in one location for hours, or even overnight, therefore the need for emergency ration is obvious.

3. It is requested that the sectors be issued with two 48 hours combat rations for two people for 18 vehicles.

2. ADRA is in the process of repairing the roof and installing doors and windows and repairing the infrastructure of this facility. This work is proceeding on schedule and will be completed by Feb 96. Milobs visited the classrooms while school was in progress and they desperately need the following supplies:

100x student desks and chairs (or benches)
450x school notebooks
450x pencils and pens
10x boxes of chalk (assorted colours)
450x erasures
Any other paper, crayons or school supplies which are available.

3. This school is in a remote area and has not received proper support in the past. Milobs Kibuye have a truck available which could pick up these supplies from Kigali if they are available in the next two weeks.

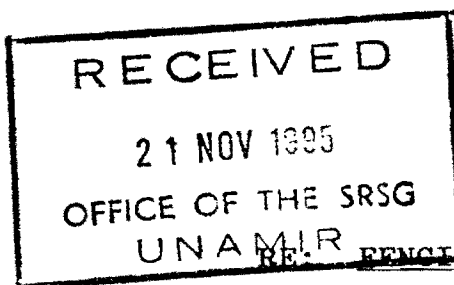

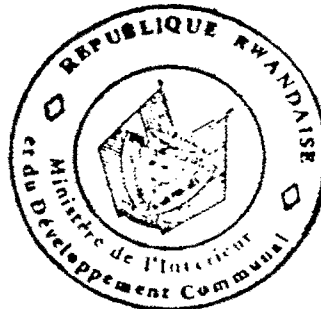
I wish to refer to our verbal discussion on the above subject. With the cadets now in place, the school needs to be fenced urgently.





Par contre, je demande qu'en compensation pour tout ce qui ne peut être évalué et réparé, la MINUAR laisse quelques voitures à la communauté lors de votre départ. Aujourd'hui, je compte refaire une liste de ce qui a pu être brisé par vos hommes et la présenter au responsable.

SUBJECT : REQUEST FOR COMBAT RATIONS/FIRST AID KITS

1. The purpose of this letter is to request Sector 5B MILOBS be issued combat rations/first aid kits for emergency use should the refugee influx occur.
2. It is very likely that the roads leading to and from the border posts and most main roads will be rendered impassable during a large influx. This may result in MILOB patrols being stranded in one location for some hours, even overnight. Given the possibility that the MILOBS could be isolated, the need for one first aid per vehicle is obvious.
3. We will require 48 hours combat rations for two people for nine vehicles and nine first aid kits based on one per vehicle.

ASSISTANCE TO THE AIRPORT.

For the last one year we have had a very useful and mutually beneficial relationship with UNAMIR.

Now that UNAMIR is slowly phasing out activities I wish to appeal that this International airport be considered for substantial material assistance in the following areas critical in airport operations:-

PROVISION OF WATER

The airport does not receive enough piped water and for this reason our own old water truck and UNAMIR's water truck have been relieving each other in shifts to provide water for the airport. If this service is phased out it leaves us with only one old truck and this will definitely impair our capacity to provide sufficient water for the airport consumption. Our request therefore is that UNAMIR donates one water truck to the airport.

POWER GENERATION

Commercial power is not yet enough to supply the whole country twenty four hours. Yet the airport is a twenty four hour user of power.

Our own standby capacity is under 400 KVA per generator and for the last year we have been boosted by a UNAMIR 700 KVA generator which in comparison with the smaller engines

even consumes less fuel. Our standby power requirement, if we supply to the whole airport is 1000 KVA. Our request is that UNAMIR secures and donates to the airport a 1000 KVA generator

AIRPORT AMBULANCE/FIRST AID VEHICLE

This airport has not had an ambulance service for long and we have always relied either on UNAMIR or private arrangements of patients. But an airport must have its own ambulance/first aid service vehicle.

Our request is that UNAMIR secures and donates to the airport atleast one ambulance/first aid service vehicle.

TRACTORS FOR GRASS CUTTING/LAWN MOWING

The airport has an expanse of land covered with grass that has to be cut always to give the airport a good face. Unfortunately one tractor simply does not measure up to the task.

Our request therefore is that UNAMIR secures and donates to the airport one tractor with a rotorised mower.

TARMAC REPAIR EQUIPMENT

The airport technical capacity to do daily repairs to the tarmac infrastructure that we have in abundance was seriously impaired by the war. All repair equipment was damaged beyond economic repair. Now right from small runway repairs, apron and taxi way repairs, parking lot repairs, drive way repairs which we would be doing as part of ordinary and daily work either goes for weeks undone or is not yet done altogether. Yet this is the nerve centre of airport operations.

Our request therefore is that UNAMIR secures and donates to the airport a surface repair unit consisting, inter alia, of:-

- a Compactor Truck
- a Stone crusher
- a Concrete mixer.

This Campaign is jointly organised by FAO and MINAGRI, with the participation of RDO.

However, the team responsible for this operation is facing a very serious problem of transport which may compromise the development of the operation. That's for this reason that we are seeking for assistance from you. If you could make at our disposal one or two Pick-up for 3 or 4 weeks period. The team is located in Nyagatare and, everyday, it has to move together with all the equipment of vaccination and the vaccins, to new sites of vaccination according to the schedule pre-established.

National Vaccination [and Rehabilitation of the Animal Health Delivery Service] Programme for the control and eventual eradication of contagious bovine pleuro-pneumonia and the for prevention of rinderpest.

1. Introduction.

Following the cessation of the civil conflict in 1994, Rwanda saw the return of large pastoralist herds of cattle, principally into the Mutara area of Byumba Prefecture. These herds, variously estimated to comprise a total of between 200,000 to 600,000 heads, had been previously kept by Rwandan exiles in grazing areas in Uganda and Tanzania. These areas have been the subject of reported outbreaks of contagious bovine pleuro-pneumonia [CBPP]. It was not long before cases of CBPP were being reported in the recently arrived Mutara herds which provided a cause of much concern, as Rwanda had previously been free of this insidious and economically damaging condition.

In response to these reports the FAO commissioned a Veterinary programme, OSRO/RWA/501/SWE, for the "Emergency aid to the livestock sector and control of animal diseases" This programme, working in collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture [MINAGRI] and various Non-Governmental Organisations [NGO's] involved with the livestock sector, has confirmed the presence of CBPP in Rwanda and in response, a National Vaccination Programme has been prepared. Because of the real, and prospectively devastating risk of rinderpest [RP] also being introduced into the country, the vaccination programme will provide cover for both CBPP and RP.

The National Vaccination Programme will provide additional benefits to Rwanda which may be listed as follows:-

- form the basis by which a sustainable National Animal Health Delivery Service can be established with integrated Government, NGO and private sector components.
- facilitate a national disease surveillance programme to determine the prevalence and distribution of economically important and zoonotic livestock diseases - from which prioritised control programmes can be developed.
- provide accurate information on the current distribution and herd composition of livestock in Rwanda - to quantify areas where overstocking is occurring and to confirm areas that require to be restocked.
- enable Rwanda to participate in a Regional CBPP and RP control programme with Uganda and Tanzania - a vital necessity for the long term control of these diseases and for providing the framework within which the pastoralist system can operate freely to ensure the conservation of the valuable grazing resources of the three countries.

We urgently require funds to implement the first round of vaccination. This course of action will achieve the following: curtail further spread of CBPP in Rwanda preventing the establishment of new pockets of infection; provide accurate information on the current prevalence and distribution of CBPP in Rwanda, and enable an informed technical response to the control of the disease; provide the basic infrastructure necessary for a sustained campaign of vaccination [requiring 4 further rounds of vaccination in the infected areas] and for addressing, on a sustainable basis, other animal health needs of the livestock sector. It has been agreed by MINAGRI that farmers will contribute to the cost of vaccination. A charge of 100 RF will be charged per animal vaccinated.

2. National Vaccination Programme - Plan of Action.

Following discussions with MINAGRI and the two principal NGO's with livestock programmes in Rwanda [Action Nord Sud -ANS and Rwanda Development Organisation - RDO], the following strategies for the control of CBPP and RP in Rwanda have been agreed.

- a] Vaccination within, and immediately around, the infected Prefectures of Byumba and Kibungu Regions.
- b] Strengthening and extending the functions of the disease control posts established at strategic points bordering the infected areas.
- c] Vaccination within the areas currently considered non-infected - all Prefectures excluding Byumba and Kibungu. [The term "non-infected area" must be used with caution as the movement of infected animals throughout the country may have occurred, or may be currently occurring].

The vaccination programme is targeted, funds dependant, to commence, in the infected area, on the 16th of November. The programme will be extended to the other Prefectures once resources allow and sufficient preparation has been made. The first round of vaccination is targeted to be completed within the space of 3 months.

Vaccination in infected areas will be repeated for a total of 4 further occasions, following the first vaccination round, at 3, 6, 12 and 12 monthly intervals respectively making a total of 5 vaccination rounds. Provided the non -infected status of a Prefecture can be confirmed from sero- and clinical surveillance, and there exists adequate movement control measures, it may not be necessary to repeat vaccination in the non-infected Prefectures at the same level of intensity.

3. The control of CBPP through the adoption of cost -recovery mechanisms - an opportunity to create the foundation of a sustainable Animal Health Delivery Service in Rwanda.

The NVP, if properly funded, will provide Rwanda with a unique opportunity to develop a privatised animal health delivery service. Practising the policy of cost-recovery will be a vital first step towards this goal. The programme will initially be necessarily delivered by a centrally administered NVP co-ordination unit, but has been budgeted in such a way that it could be awarded as a contract for private delivery in any given Prefecture. The capital items [vehicles, equipment etc] could be provided as part of a loan agreement, with an affordable repayment schedule. These materials would then provide the basis by which the delivery of other animal health services sought by livestock owners could be delivered. The three year term of the programme will provide adequate contract work to enable the private practise to establish itself. This policy has now been approved and the support of donor assistance to implement the NVP, on the basis of cost recovery, will now be actively pursued.

The privatisation of Veterinary Services cannot operate in a vacuum. If this policy is to be successful it will be important to provide, in parallel, livestock development programmes aimed at increasing livestock farming returns through increased productivity, marketing etc. In addition there will be a need to provide adequate extension services so that farmers are properly informed of the choices and opportunities available to them through improved livestock management practice. Above all it will be essential to involve the livestock farmers, through their appropriate representatives and existing organisations working closely with them, to solicit their views on the form of animal health service they require, their suggestions as to how it should be delivered and to respond positively to any other problems they are facing in the maintenance of, and income generation from, their livestock.

1. Refer FEO letter No 30001.1(FEO)/OPS/-1 dated 21 Sep 95.
2. One excavator cum digger and two dozers have been working in Gikongoro for digging of canal. Initially the request was for digging the existing canal (desilting) which was being done by the dozer and excavator. But due to the soft soil and water in the canal dozer could not work and got stuck in the canal. Later the agriculture department modified the requirement and requested for digging a fresh canal. This was also attempted by our detachment for few days but the area is marshy and water logged. Soil is also soft and caves in frequently.
3. Site conditions are such that mechanical means for digging cannot be used in this area and perforce it has to be done manually. Since no useful purpose is being served by keeping the dozer detachment who have been out since 01 Oct 95, dozers and excavator cum digger is being called back.
