The convening of the Summit of Head of States of the South American and African States on 15 and 16 May 2012 was not raised with the Permanent Representatives of Turkey and San Marino and the Office of the President of the General Assembly.

The Executive Office of the Secretary-General would further like to inform that, based on consultations with the Office of the President of the General Assembly, it has been jointly decided by the aforementioned offices that a change of date is no longer considered feasible since the preparations for the HLTD are at an advanced stage and the joint invitations by the Secretary-General and the President of the General Assembly have already been sent to all Heads of State and Government.

In this regard, given the importance of the meeting and the keen interest by the two aforementioned offices to ensure the widest participation possible, the Executive Office of the Secretary-General would be grateful if the concerned Member States could consider sending a Cabinet-level representative to participate in the HLTD on their behalf.

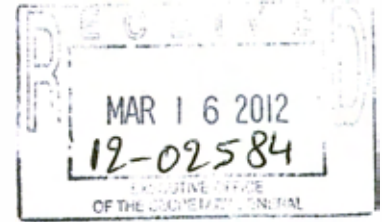
