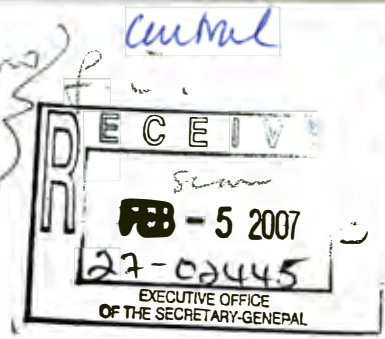

*Cyprus Q*

Dear Administrator,

Upon instructions from my Government, I am writing with regard to the intention of UNDP to open a Partnership for the Future (PFF) "logistics facility" in the occupied areas of the Republic of Cyprus.

The Government of Greece has supported, both in the context of the UN and of the EU, the economic development of the Turkish Cypriot community as an essential element for a comprehensive solution to the Cyprus Problem, so long as this is accomplished through and in full consultation with the Government of the Republic of Cyprus, in accordance with relevant Security Council and General Assembly resolutions and in full respect of the UN Charter.

It is indeed regrettable that these fundamental principles and rules of the United Nations have been ignored by the UNDP Administration and that the Government of the Republic of Cyprus has not been consulted appropriately in advance, nor has its prior approval been obtained.

In light of the above, my Government strongly requests for an immediate suspension of any plan for the opening of the UNDP of a "logistics facility" in the occupied areas of the Republic of Cyprus.

Please accept, dear Administrator, the assurances of my highest consideration.
