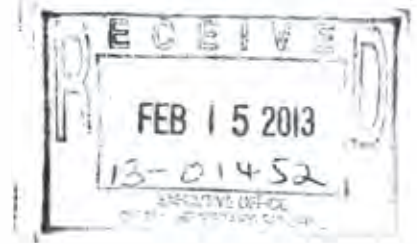

Thank you for all you do for our poor old battered up World!

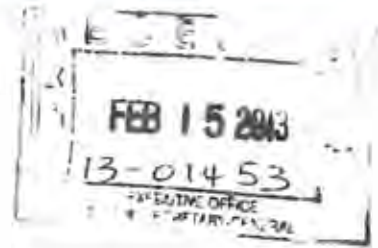
