Excellency,



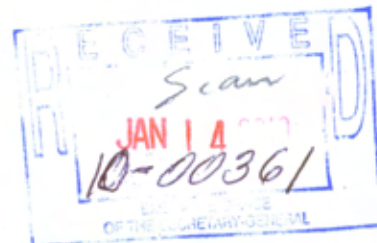

In response to your appeal to provide assistance to the people of Haiti struck by the devastating earthquake, I am authorized to inform you that the Government of Georgia has allocated both human personnel and first aid provisions. Cargo plane, carrying 15 rescue rangers and 5 medical doctors, alongside with the 40 tons of emergency supplies, is en route to Port-au-Prince and will tentatively arrive on January 15, in the afternoon.
