

ПРИНИМАЯ ВО ВНИМАНИЕ, что

восстановление и развитие экономики стран Азии и Дальнего Востока должно быть направлено таким образом, чтобы содействовать ликвидации колониальной и полуколониальной зависимости, в которой находятся еще многие народы Азии и Дальнего Востока, и чтобы содействовать развитию национальной самостоятельности и государственной независимости всех народов этого района;

Экономический и Социальный Совет ПОСТАНОВЛЯЕТ:

Рекомендовать Экономической Комиссии для Азии и Дальнего Востока /ЭКАДВ/ :

1. Содействовать развитию в странах Азии и Дальнего Востока своей национальной промышленности, включая развитие тяжелой промышленности - металлургия, машиностроение, химическая промышленность, строительство электростанций и т.д. Эта неотложная задача должна быть разрешена как путем широкой мобилизации и использования национальных ресурсов стран Азии и Дальнего Востока, так и путем оказания этим странам экономической помощи со стороны промышленно развитых стран. Однако, эта помощь не должна, во-первых, обуславливаться требованиями политических, экономических или военных привилегий, и, во-вторых, должна осуществляться в рамках Организации

Объединенных Наций.

2. Содействовать развитию торговли между странами Азии и Дальнего Востока, а также между этими странами и странами других районов, на основе взаимного уважения суверенитета и без какой-либо дискриминации.

3. Содействовать развитию сельского хозяйства, для чего разработать рекомендации по восстановлению и развитию ирригационных сооружений, по организации дешевого сельскохозяйственного кредита для крестьян, особенно мелких крестьян, по снабжению их на льготных условиях удобрениями, сельскохозяйственным инвентарем, семенами и т.д.

В соответствии с вышеизложенным, Экономический и Социальный Совет рекомендует ЭКАДВ создать надлежащие рабочие органы, которые занялись бы изучением соответствующих вопросов и подготовкой необходимых рекомендаций. В числе таких рабочих органов должны быть созданы: Комитет по содействию развитию национальной промышленности в странах и территориях Азии и Дальнего Востока, Комитет по содействию восстановлению и развитию сельского хозяйства и Комитет по развитию торговли и экономических связей между странами Азии и Дальнего Востока.

China: Draft Resolution

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

HAVING noted the recommendations of the Economic Commission for Asia and the Far East at its Third Session regarding the establishment of a Bureau of Flood Control based upon a preliminary study undertaken by the Executive Secretary of the ECAFE in consultation with FAO,

HAVING noted the functions contemplated for the Bureau by the ECAFE at its Third Session, and

RECOGNIZING the great importance and urgency of the problem of flood control which affects the livelihood and welfare of over half a billion human beings in the valleys of great rivers in Asia and the Far East that are subject to the danger of floods and consequent famines,

RESOLVES

1. that a Bureau of Flood Control be established and that the Bureau be composed of not more than five experts with high technical qualifications; that these experts be appointed by the Secretary-General of the United Nations out of a panel of names to be submitted by Member Governments, except that one expert be appointed by the Director-General of FAO on his own initiative; that the Chairman be appointed from among the experts by the Secretary-General of the United Nations and that the Bureau be initially started with a minimum of three experts; and

2. that the Bureau shall be responsible to the ECAFE and that the Executive-Secretary of the ECAFE shall assist and collaborate with the Bureau in all necessary ways in its organization and operation.


At the 38th meeting of the Economic Commission for Asia and the Far East the Chief Delegate of the U.S.S.R. said "he had been informed that last November the Republic of Viet Nam had made an application to become an Associate Member of the Commission".

At the 39th meeting, the Chairman in reply said "he had now received a letter from the Soviet Delegate enclosing a copy of an application forwarded by the Viet Nam Government to the Economic Council for Asia and the Far East. The Secretariat of the Commission had not received any such application and from the way in which the address was given it was possible that the application had been received by the Economic and Social Council. He therefore proposed to have these papers sent to the Council and to ask whether they had received the application; if they have had, it would be open to the Commission to consider what action should be taken".

In accordance with the undertaking given by the Chairman to the Soviet Delegate, I now enclose a letter dated November 22, 1947, to the Head of the Delegation of the U.S.S.R. at the United Nations Economic Council for Asia and the Far East transmitting a letter already sent in the name of the Government of Viet Nam to the President of the United Nations Economic and Social Council for Asia and the Far East. The above letter was received by the Chairman of the Commission under cover of a letter of transmittal from the Soviet Delegation dated June 9, 1948. I also enclose a communication, with enclosure, received from the President Viet-Nam Government delegation for the South East Asia dated June 7, 1948.




