Your Excellency:

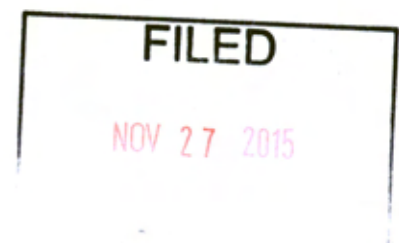
