THE ITURIAN ABANDON THEIR IDEAS OF A NEW PROVINCE SEEMS  
TO HAVE FAILED. PRESIDENT KELEHKO IS REPORTED TO HAVE HAD  
A SHOWDOWN WITH VICE PRESIDENT TSHOMBE AND THE ITURIAN

1. CIV OPS- THE AGRIC CONFERENCE HAS FINISHED ITS WORK. THE AGENDA MADE UP BY THE TECHNICAL COMMISSION HAS BEEN FOLLOWED WITH SMALL RECTIFICATIONS MADE BY MENISTERS AND ALL POINTS HAVE BEEN DISCUSSED. CONFERENCE IS CONSIDERED TO HAVE BEEN FAIRLY SUCCESSFUL AS THE MEMBERS LIMITED THEMSELVES MOSTLY TO PURELY TECHNICAL MATTERS AND REFRAINED FROM POLITICAL DEBATES. JUDGES SHAFIK AND BOGOSHIAN ARRIVED IN STAN TODAY.

2. ADMIN- CHIEF AUDITOR MARTIN HAS ARRIVED IN STAN ON SHORT INSPECTION VISIT.

MANZIKALA. AS EARLIER REPORTED TUPA IS BELIEVED TO BE ONE OF THE  
LEADERS BEHIND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SO-CALLED SHOCK TROOPS.  
THE FOLLOWIND DETAILS HAVE BEEN REPORTED REGARDING THE MASS ESCAPE  
FROM THE PRISON SATURDAY AFTERNOON TWO ANC ADJUTANTS ONOKOLO  
GREGOIRE AND VARMA JEAN VISITED MILITARY PRISONERS. WHILE ONE OF THE

THE SEARCH FOR THE REST OF THE ESCAPEES HAS BEEN CARRIED OUT ENERGETICALLY AND FURTHER THE POLICE IS CHECKING THE IDENTITY OF THOSE WHO HAVE ENTERED THE PROVINCE WIT OUT PROPER IAPERS. ABOUT 200 OF THEM HAVE BEEN APPREHENDED PENDING FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS . PRESIDENT LOSALA, MINISTER JUSTICE YALEKO TOGETHER WITH JUDGES AND MAGISTRATES HAVE BEEN IN THE PRISON THE WHOLE MORNING AND STARTED AN INQUIRY AS TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES BEHIND THE ESCAPE. THE DIRECTOR OF THE PRISON HAS BEEN ARRESTED. THE TWO ADJUTANTS HAVE ALSO BEEN ARRESTED AND ARE AT PRESENT IN THE MELITARY CAMP. THE TWO ADJUTANTS ARE IONSIDERED HERE TO BE GIZINGAS FOLLOWERS. NOBODY HAS YET BEEN KILLED BUT SOME PRISONERS HAVE BEEN SEVERELY BEATEN UP ON RECAPTURE.


