Thank you for the kind invitation to attend the signing ceremony of the Paris Agreement on April 22, 2016, in New York.

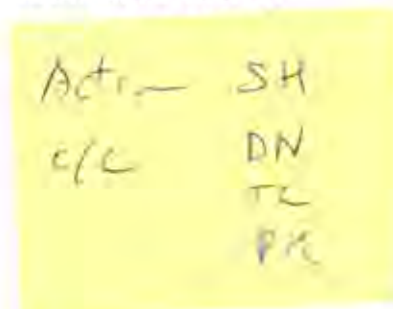
