INTER - OFFICE MEMORANDUM

OBJET :

For order's sake I send you below translation of a passage from a letter of January 15 written by the Chairman of the Swedish Save the Children Fund on the Kasai operation:

"We have sent you two cables, but since the first one was addressed to the Stanley Hotel, it apparently has not reached you.

"In the first cable we informed you that we reserved Cr. 150,000 for the Kasai refugees, and asked you for your kind advice as to how to use these funds, and as to suitable distribution channels.

"Whilst waiting for your cabled reply we had a visit from representatives of the Danish Save the Children Fund who wanted to discuss with us a possible joint Kasai contribution.

"Furthermore, the Svenska Missionsförbundet (Missionary Council) offered us to pool our goods via their organisation in Kasai, an American Mission disposing of 54 small hospitals and as many dispensaries. They told us that UN also uses the Mission as distributors to the refugees of the goods the Swedish Missionary Council is sending down, and also of so-called UN goods. They also stated that the Swedish Missionary Council was dependent on UN transport.

"Is it advisable that the Save the Children Fund uses the system applied by the Swedish Missionary Council, that is to say, connecting with the UN?

"At present Save the Children Fund disposes of more than Cr. 300,000 for the Congo operation. If you could possibly cable us any further advice as to how to use this sum, we will be very grateful."


