2. YOU MAY HOWEVER WISH TO REQUEST FOR A MEDIUM RANGE VEHICLE FROM THE ETHIOBATT OR A CANADIAN HELICOPTER FROM KIGALI WHENEVER ONE IS COMING TO CONVEY THEM (THE FAMILY MEMBERS) TO KIGALI. THIS IS ALSO WITH A PROVISIO THAT WE ARE INFORMED WELL AHEAD OF TIME TO FACILITATE INFORMING THE FAMILY MEMBERS CONCERNED.
