
Dear Mr. Zimonyi,

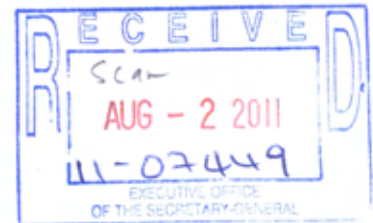

In accordance with the note verbal no. EOSG/SOSG/GA66/0001 dated 20 July, 2011 the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Hungary has the honour to request a bilateral meeting between H.E. Mr. Ban Ki-moon, Secretary-General of the United Nations and H.E. Mr. Pál Schmitt, President of the Republic of Hungary.

H.E. Mr. Pál Schmitt, President of the Republic of Hungary will be in New York between September 19-23, 2011. According to the provisional speakers list His Excellency will be delivering his speech on the 23 September, as the first speaker in the afternoon session and would leave New York thereafter.

The proposed topics for discussion would include:

- Follow-up of the Secretary-General's visit to Hungary
- Prevention and control of non-communicable diseases – Hungary's contribution
- Outcomes and lessons learned of the Hungarian EU Presidency in the UN
