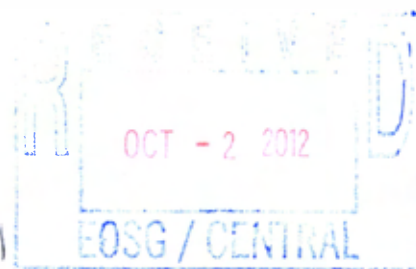

Excellency,

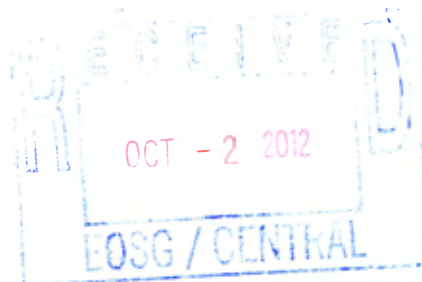

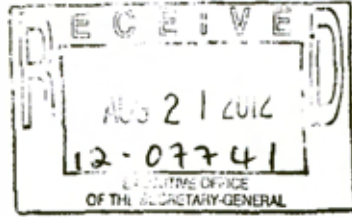

We look forward to your continued support and cooperation in celebrating the Nelson Mandela International Day and other activities in the near future.

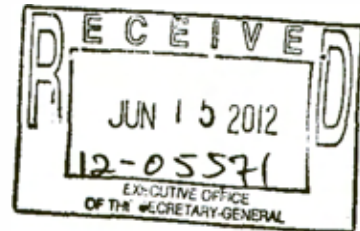

Nelson Mandela International Day (18 July) ✓

As in past years, the Department of Public Information (DPI) is working with the Permanent Mission of South Africa to the United Nations to organize a public service activity in observance of Nelson Mandela International Day on 18 July.

The Day was established by the General Assembly in recognition of Mr. Mandela's contributions to democracy, racial justice, reconciliation and his service to humanity. The Nelson Mandela Foundation encourages individuals around the world to mark the day by devoting 67 minutes of their time to changing the world for the better – one minute of public service for every year that Mr. Mandela devoted in service to humanity.

This year, staff from the UN Secretariat and the Permanent Mission of South Africa will meet at the Bowery Mission – an institution that has been providing meals, shelter, clothing and medical care to homeless men and women in Manhattan – on 18 July to prepare and serve meals. Through its worldwide network of UN information centres, DPI is also encouraging staff in the field to organize public service activities that contribute to the common good.

We would like to invite you to join the UN volunteers at the Bowery Mission any time between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., or between 3:30 and 6:00 p.m. We would hope that you would help to prepare or serve meals, and also make brief remarks to the media. We would also be honoured if Mrs. Ban would consider joining you on this occasion.

Your participation in this event would serve as a timely opportunity to reach out to the New York-based media as well as to media in Africa, particularly in South Africa. DPI would also use its social media platforms and traditional media channels to disseminate the images and messages generated by the event worldwide.

We hope that you will be able to take part in this outreach initiative.
