FOR DAYAL VAN HORN. YOUR SIGNAL SV 40 DATED 30 NOV REFERS.
AN IDENTIFICATION CHECK OF ALL EUROPEANS CARRIED OUT AT STANLEYVILLE
ON SUNDAY 27 NOV. REASONS FOR CHECK GIVEN AS FOLLOWS. LOCAL
AUTHORITIES SUSPECTED THAT RECENTLY SOME EUROPEANS HAD ARRIVED IN THE
TOWN WITHOUT ANY VALID REASON. IT WAS FEARED THAT THEY WERE HERE TO
WORK FOR INTERESTED POLITICAL PARTIES OUTSIDE THE PROVINCE. CHECKING
STARTED AT 0730 HRS BY COLLECTING ALL EUROPEANS IN MILITARY TRUCKS
AND TAKING THEM TO THE DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS OFFICE. UN CIVILIAN
EMPLOYEES NOT TAKEN TO CHECKING POINT EXCEPT 2 WHO WERE RELEASED AFTER
THEIR IDENTITY WAS ESTABLISHED. ALL EUROPEANS ALLOWED TO PROCEED
AFTER CHECKING OF DOCUMENTS EXCEPT 14, 14 BELGIANS INCLUDING 1 LADY NOW
IN PRISON FOR NOT HAVING PROPER IDENTIFICATION. PRISON HAS SPECIAL
QUARTERS FOR EUROPEANS WHICH ARE REASONABLY COMFORTABLE. DURING
NEGOTIATIONS WITH GIZENGA AND LOUIS LUMUMBA PROVINCIAL MINISTER FOR
INTERIOR EYE OFFERED TO EVACUATE THOSE PRISONERS DESIRONS OF LEAVING
STANLEYVILLE. LUMUMBA STATED THAT FURTHER CHECK OF THEIR CREDENTIALS
IS BEING MADE AND THOSE FOUND INNOCENT WILL BE RELEASED TOMORROW.
REMAINING WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE COUNTRY. SABENA PLANE BEING ARRANGED
BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES TO FLY DEPORTEES DIRECTLY TO USUMBURA. THEY DO
NOT AGREE TO THE DEPORTEES BEING TAKEN BY UN PLANE INITIALLY TO LEO.
SOME INCIDENTS OF MALTREATMENT ARE LIKELY TO HAVE OCCURRED DURING

Reur B-1533 , I am quite concerned about the Stanleyville development and believe that in the interest of complete impartiality we must without delay go on record with circulated report concerning treatment of UN personnel in that area . This would seem the more necessary because future developments in the same direction are not unlikely to occur .

You might consider urgently to present a note to Mr Gizenga (unaddressed , in order to maintain constitutional properties), protecting against mistreatment of UN personnel . Were we to come to face a " two front " affair , it is essential to maintain the same standards with regard to both sides . Brzak should of course prepare a detailed report on the events .

2 . It would also seem advisable to prepare a report , although not for publication , on the treatment of Europeans . In this connexion it must of course continue to be our task to maintain to the fullest degree possible peace and order and it would be imperative to provide all possible protection to persons subjected to mistreatment , irrespective of race .

3 . In view of developments which are likely to occur in Stanleyville before too long , it would seem advisable to build up our staff there and a few fairly senior persons should be immediately sent . While you will be in a position to judge best as to who could most suitably be sent to Stanleyville , in view of certain legal aspects likely to develop there , Berthoud might be one suitable candidate . It will be essential to establish good communications with Stanley in order to receive information as quickly as possible .
