

THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Excellency,

With the consent of your Government, and after consultation with the heads of the various organizations of the United Nations system, I have the honour to designate Ms. Anita Nirody as the Resident Coordinator of the United Nations system's operational activities for development in the Republic of Uzbekistan. The functions of the Resident Coordinator are outlined in paragraph 34 of the annex to General Assembly resolution 32/197 of 20 December 1977, which provides for arrangements for the better coordination of operational activities for development by the United Nations system at the country level.

In accordance with these provisions, Ms. Nirody, on behalf of the United Nations system, will have overall responsibility and exercise team leadership for the coordination of operational activities for development in the Republic of Uzbekistan. She will be responsible to me for discharging these functions which will be carried out in conformity with the priorities established by your competent national authorities.

These arrangements do not affect relations between your Government and individual organizations of the United Nations system or the direct lines of authority and communication between the representatives of these organizations at the country level and their own executive heads.

It would be appreciated if your Government could keep the Resident Coordinator informed of matters relevant to the exercise of her functions to ensure the better coordination of the system's operational activities.



Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.

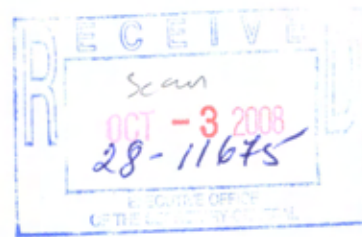
