SUBJECT: Dutch Children.

Captain Hook has told me that he is verifying the nationality of the two children you referred to me.

He tells me that he has asked the British authorities for permission to send all Dutch children who are en route to Holland to Ebensee. This has not been cleared with the American military so far as I know. He has written to all the districts for lists of the Dutch children, but so far has received no answers. He is very anxious to get them all out as soon as possible. I think that we have arranged that they can go from Ebensee to Lins and whenever there is someone in whose charge they can be put, they can go by the Arlberg express, and the French authorities arrange for their transportation to a reception centre in Holland.
