

2. OVERVIEW. REPORTS INDICATE A RELATIVELY QUIET WEEKEND. ONE BANDIT ATTACK IN SECTOR 4.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. SECTOR 4: GISHOMA COMMUNE, KIRANGARA SECTEUR, MUTI CELLULE: 05 2359B AUG: AN ESTIMATED 30 BANDITS ATTACKED THE MUTI CELL STEALING AN UNDISCLOSED AMOUNT OF MONEY AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS. FIVE OF THE BANDITS WERE IDENTIFIED AS HAVING FIREARMS AND BELIEVED TO HAVE COME FROM ZAIRE. LOCALS IDENTIFIED ONE AS A FORMER RESIDENT OF MUTI CELLULE AND THE PREFECT OF CYANGUGU IDENTIFIED HIM AS BEING INTERAHAMWE. ONE WOMAN WAS SHOT AND KILLED IN THE INCIDENT. THE BANDITS GOT AWAY.

B. SECTOR 5: GISA SECTEUR (1913): REGARDING THE EXPLOSIVE DEMOLITION OF THE WATER PIPELINE ON 04 AUG. THE WATER SUPPLY TO THE TOWN AND BREWERY WAS RESTORED ON SATURDAY, 5 AUG.

5. POLITICAL.

6. REGIONAL.ZAIRE ACCORDING TO PRESS, ARMED ROBBERS SHOT A GROUP OF ITALIAN NATIONALS YESTERDAY (06 AUG) IN THE ZAIRIAN WILDLIFE PRESERVE OF VIRGUNA PARK. THE VICTIMS WERE CHARITY WORKERS FOR THE NGO "A JUST WORLD" WHICH IS HELPING TO BUILD WATER SUPPLY AND ELECTRIC POWER FOR THE REFUGEE CAMPS IN ZAIRE. REPORTEDLY, THE VICTIMS WERE PART OF A GROUP GOING TO VISIT THE PARK. THEY WERE STOPPED BY A GROUP OF ARMED MEN WHO FIRST ROBBED THEM, THEN BEGAN SHOOTING. ZAIRIAN OFFICIALS, INCLUDING THE CULTURE MINISTER, WERE ON THE SCENE YESTERDAY TO INVESTIGATE.

8. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1

(1) 48 SOLDIERS OF MALAWICOY ARRIVED AT TRANSIT CAMP FROM CYANGUGU AND 60 TROOPS LEFT FOR THEIR COUNTRY.

(2) 6 SOLDIERS FROM INDBATT WITH 2 TRUCKS REPORTED AT SECT 1B GITARAMA. DURING NEXT WEEK THE DETACHMENT WILL TRANSPORT 416 TONS OF FOOD DONATED BY WFP TO VARIOUS COMMUNES WITHIN THE SECTOR.

(3) MALICOY MOVED FROM GITARAMA TO GIKONGORO.

(4) IN KAYENZE COMMUNE (GR 8389), THE BOURGMESTRE REQUESTED FOR ASSISTANCE TO MOVE 18 TONS OF FOOD

DONATED BY WFP FROM GITARAMA AND BUILDING MATERIALS FOR MAKING MORE ROOMS FOR INMATES AT THE COMMUNE CACHOT. HAC COORDINATING.

B. SECTOR 2.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.

(2) ALL COYS NOW CONCENTRATED AT 5 LOCATIONS, KIBUNGO (GR 5549), KIYANJA (GR 5586), GISHALI (GR 4788) BARE (GR 5549) AND RUKIRA (GR 6556) IN LINE WITH THE CURRENT MANDATE FOR FINAL ABANDONMENT OF BICUMBI (GR 3876) AND RWANTERU (GR 7948) BASES.

C. SECTOR 3.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN GIKONGORO AOR. NTR.

(2) A HUMAN RIGHTS SEMINAR WHICH WAS HELD AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS ENDED TODAY. IT WAS ATTENDED BY PEOPLE FROM ALL WALKS OF LIFE BUT UNAMIR MILOBS WERE NOT ALLOWED IN.

D. SECTOR 4.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.

(2) THE SECOND GROUP OF SIXTY (60) PERSONNEL LEFT TODAY FOR KIGALI READY FOR DEPARTURE TO MALAWI ON 7 AUG 95.

(3) THE SITUATION IS STILL TENSE AFTER THE REPORTED SHOOTING INCIDENT OF 04 AUG 95. A MEETING WAS HELD AT THE RPA BN HQ AT GIHUNDWE TO DISCUSS THE INCIDENT. DETAILS FOLLOW.

(4) ON SAT 5 AUG 95, THREE MALAWIAN SOLDIERS DRESSED IN CIVIL WERE ARRESTED BY GENDARMERIE FOR ALLEGED MISCONDUCT. THEY WERE HOWEVER LATER RELEASED.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) A MILOB TEAM ACCOMPANIED A VISITING DELEGATION FROM MINISTRY OF FAMILLE ET PROMOTION FEMININE TO AN NGO CALLED SOLIDARITY IN MABANZA COMMUNE AND LATER ADDRESSED A GATHERING IN KIBUYE STADIUM. MILOBS DID NOT GET MUCH INFORMATION DUE TO LANGUAGE BARRIER.

F. FORCE SIG COY. CONTINUED WIRING WORK FOR TELE EXTENSION LINES AT NEW UNAMIR HQ, TRAFFIPRO.

G. FORCE ENGR COY. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE ENGR SP TO UNAMIR.

H. AUSMED.

(1) TREATED A TOTAL OF 03 OUT-PATIENTS AND CURRENTLY HOLDING 12 IN-PATIENTS.

I. AIR OPS. THE GENERAL SITUATION AT THE KIA REMAINED NORMAL.

J. UN MP COY.

(1) ONE TRAFFIC ACCIDENT INVOLVING A UNAMIR VEHICLE WITH ONLY MINOR DAMAGE AND INJURIES WAS RECORDED

(2) BOTH DETACHMENTS KIGALI AND BUTARE PROVIDED PREVENTIVE MOBILE PATROLS IN THEIR AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY.

(1) DELIVERED 40,000L WATER TO SHAGASHA FOR MALAWICOY.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 5: REGARDING THE SABOTAGE OF THE WATER PIPELINE (04 AUG) THE WATER SUPPLY TO THE TOWN AND BREWERY WAS RESTORED 5 AUG.

5. POLITICAL. SECTOR 5 MUGINA (9267): INDICATION OF CONTINUED TENSIONS IN THE SECTEUR. THERE HAVE BEEN NUMEROUS INCIDENTS AND REACTIONS TO THE DISMISSAL OF THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MUGINA. LOCALS ARE APPREHENSIVE THAT THE SITUATION IS GRADUALLY DETERIORATING TO PRE-GENOCIDE ERA.

8. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.
 - A. SECTOR 1
 - (1) 12 OFFICERS AND 320 OTHER RANKS OF ZAMBATT DEPARTED FOR THEIR COUNTRY TODAY.
 - (2) 87 IDPs ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP. 37 IDPs DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO THEIR RESPECTIVE HOME COMMUNES. A TOTAL NO OF 268 IDPs STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM NDERA CAMP.
 - (3) MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 26 MEDICAL AND 11 DENTAL PATIENTS AT OWN CLINICS.
 - (4) MALICOY MOVED FROM GITARAMA TO GIKONGORO TODAY. MILOBS TEAMS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN THEIR AOR. SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.
 - (4) MILOBS ASSESSED THAT RECENT INCIDENTS AND REACTION OF LOCALS TO DISMISSAL OF BOURGEMESTRE OF MUGINA COMMUNE (GR 9267) WERE INDICATORS OF CONTD TENSION IN THE SECTOR. LOCALS ARE APPREHENSIVE THAT THE SITUATION COULD DETERIORATE TO THE LEVEL OF THE PRE-GENOCIDE ERA.
 - B. SECTOR 2.
 - (1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.
 - (2) GHANBATT PROVIDED 2 X TCVs TO CONVEY SCHOOL FURNITURE AND STATIONERY FROM KIGALI TO BYUMBA (GR 0926).
 - (3) GHANBATT MED STAFF TREATED 35 LOCALS IN AOR.

(4) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE AOR AND THE SITUATION FOUND NORMAL.

C. SECTOR 3.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN GIKONGORO AOR. NTR.

(2) SENBATT HAD MEDAL PRESENTATION TODAY. THE CEREMONY WAS PRESIDED OVER BY THE FORCE COMMANDER.

(3) MILOB PATROLS TO RWAMIKO REPORTED THAT THE SECURITY SITUATION THERE SINCE THE DEPARTURE OF ZAMBATT HAD DETERIORATED. THERE WERE REPORTED INCREASING ACTS OF BANDITRY AND RPA HARASSMENT OF LOCALS INCLUDING RAMPANT/INDISCRIMINATE ARRESTS.

(B) MILOBS PATROL TEAM TO NYAMAGABE COMMUNE (GR 5427) WAS INFORMED BY LOCALS THAT AT RUSASA SECTOR (GR 5320), ON 29 JUL 95 AT ABOUT 2200 HRS FIVE ARMED SOLDIERS AND FOUR CIVILIANS BESIEGED THE RESIDENCE OF A LOCAL MALE. A GRENADE WAS LOBBED BY ONE OF THE SOLDIERS WHICH KILLED THE 27-YEAR-OLD WIFE OF THE LOCAL. VARIOUS UNSPECIFIED ITEMS WERE REPORTEDLY STOLEN FROM THE HOUSE. SIMILAR BANDITRY ACTIVITIES ARE TAKING PLACE IN THE AREA. MILOBS INVESTIGATING.

D. SECTOR 4.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.

(2) DFC PAID A WORKING VISIT TO OWN LOC.

(3) 60 SOLDIERS OF MALAWICOY MOVED TO KIGALI ON TRANSIT TO MALAWI ON ROTATION. THE ADVANCE PARTY FOR THE NEXT CONTINGENT ARRIVED AT SHAGASHA AND HANDOVER FORMALITIES ARE IN PROGRESS.

(4) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WAS RELATIVELY QUIET EXCEPT FOR CYANGUGU TOWN WHERE AN UNEASY CALM WAS REPORTED AFTER THE SHOOTING INCIDENT INVOLVING LOCAL RPA TROOPS AND MALAWICOY TROOPS ON 04 AUG 95. RPA IS APPARENTLY CARRYING OUT A DISINFORMATION CAMPAIGN ABOUT THE INCIDENT. AT 2030 HRS ON 04 AUG 95, A FEW LOCALS INTERCEPTED A MILOB AND ACCUSED HIM OF SHOOTING RPA SOLDIERS. AN INVESTIGATIVE PATROL CONDUCTED IN KAMEMBE REVEALED THAT WHILST SOME LOCALS REGARDED THE INCIDENT AS UNFORTUNATE, A CROSS SECTION BLAMED THE MALAWIANS FOR VIOLATING PROCEDURAL NORMS. ONE LOCAL, HOWEVER, WAS OF THE OPINION THAT THE RPA ARE FEELING RATHER PROUD FOR HAVING SHOT THE UNAMIR SOLDIERS. HE CLAIMED TO HAVE OVERHEARD RPA SOLDIERS SAYING THAT THE INCIDENT WAS THE BEGINNING OF MORE TO COME.

(5) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE DFC VISITED MALAWICOY AT

SHAGASHA AND WAS BRIEFED BY THE MILOBS SECTOR COMD ON THE EVENTS OF 04 AUG 95.

E. SECTOR 5.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) MILOB PATROLS TO KARISIMBI (GR 4035) WERE INFORMED BY AN NGO PERS WORKING IN THE VICINITY OF THE VOLCANO THAT BETWEEN 5 - 7 SHOTS OF AUTOMATIC RIFLE FIRE WERE HEARD IN THE AREA ON 03 AUG 95 AT ABOUT 1100 HRS. NO FURTHER DETAILS WERE GIVEN. MILOBS INVESTIGATING.

(3) ANOTHER TEAM PATROLLED NYAMUGALI COMMUNE WITH RPA LIAISON OFFICER AT RUHENGARI AS A FOLLOW UP TO EARLIER REPORTS ABOUT LAND MINES IN THE AREA WITH A VIEW TO IDENTIFYING THEIR LOCATIONS. THE TEAM DID NOT FIND ANY MINES.

(4) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO KANAMA (GR 2712) AND NYAMYUMBA (GR 2006) COMMUNES. AT KIGARAMA (GR 2807) IN KANAMA COMMUNE, LOCALS INFORMED MILOBS THAT RPA BEAT UP TEN MEN, WHO HAD BEEN APPOINTED AS LOCAL POLICEMEN, FOR VIOLATING CURFEW RESTRICTIONS IN THE AREA. THE POLICEMEN WERE PATROLLING THE AREA AT THE TIME. ALSO AT BAHIMBA CELLULE (GR 2807) RPA REPORTEDLY LOOTED THE PROPERTY OF A LOCAL TRADER FOR HAVING LISTENED TO A RECORDED CASSETTE PRAISING THE FORMER GOVERNMENT.

(1) VSAT TERMINAL AT KIBUYE REPAIRED AND MADE FUNCTIONAL.

(2) SIG COY PROVIDED 1 TRUCK FOR TRANSPORTATION OF WOOD FROM RUGALIKA TO NYAMAHURU AND FROM SHELII TO GHASAHURU ON THE REQUEST OF A LOCAL ORGANISATION - ARDEC.

(1) PROVIDED TWO DUMP TRUCKS FOR SHIFTING OF LATERITE FROM NYANZA SITE TO TRANSIT CAMP ANNEXE.

(1) TREATED A TOTAL OF 51 OUT-PATIENTS AND CURRENTLY HOLDING 11 IN-PATIENTS.

(2) RIFLE COY ELM MOV TO KAGITUMBA AND PROV ESCORT SECURITY TO THE HQ UNAMIR LOG STAFF RECCE AS IT RETURNED FROM KAMPALA.

1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

2. OVERVIEW. SECTOR 4: RPA/UNAMIR CONFRONTATION, TWO MALAWI COY PERSONNEL WOUNDED. SECTOR 5: KILLINGS OF THE 13 MINERS APPEARS TO BE A ROBBERY. ONE ACT OF "SABOTAGE".

3. RPA.

A. IN SECTOR 4: ON 041330B AUG 95 AN INCIDENT BETWEEN RPA AND MALAWI COY PERSONNEL RESULTED IN TWO UNAMIR PERSONNEL BEING SHOT AND ESCALATION TO ARMED CONFRONTATION. THE SITUATION WAS CLARIFIED AND DEFUSED BY MILOB SECTOR COMMANDER.

B. SECTOR 5: RWAMASIZI (4580): FURTHER TO YESTERDAY'S REPORT OF THE KILLING OF 13 MINERS AT RWAMASISI 01 AUG. A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM INVESTIGATED THE INCIDENT AND CONFIRMED THE MURDER OF 13 LOCALS. THE MOTIVE APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN THEFT VICE SUPPRESSION OF INTERAHAMWE AS CLAIMED BY THE BOURGEMESTRE.

A. SECTOR 4: KAMEMBE SECTOR (7825): 04 1030B AUG: A BN-2 ISLANDER OVERFLEW KAMEMBE SECTOR FROM SOUTH TO NORTH ALTITUDE 2,000 FEET AGL.

B. SECTOR 5:

(1). KIVUYE SECTEUR: LOCALS REPORTED THE PRESENCE OF INTERAHAMWE IN THE AREA. 4 INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED.

(2). RUBAVU COMMUNE (2213) GISA SECTEUR (1913): 04 0030B AUG: A WATER PIPELINE SUPPLYING THE TOWN AND LOCAL BREWERY WAS CUT BY 4 OR 5 INDIVIDUALS AT APPROXIMATELY 04 0030B AUG. THE PERPETRATORS USED EXPLOSIVES TO DESTROY A T-JUNCTION IN THE PIPELINE. A PASSING RPA PATROL FIRED INTO THE AREA BUT FAILED TO HIT OR APPREHEND ANYONE. ACCORDING TO ELECTROGAZ, REPAIRS SHOULD BE EFFECTED NO LATER THAN TOMORROW. COMMENT: THIS IS THE 3RD SABOTAGE INCIDENT IN THIS SECTOR SINCE END JUNE. RPA HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO APPREHEND PERPETRATORS AND THIS LEVEL OF HARASSMENT IS LIKELY TO CONTINUE.

A. SECTOR 1

A. SECTOR 1

(1) INDBATT REPORTED THAT MILOB SECTOR COMMANDER FROM GITARAMA VISITED INDBATT HQ AT 1000 HRS 04 AUG 95. CO INDBATT BRIEFED HIM ABOUT OPS IN SECTOR 1 WHILE HE BRIEFED CO INDBATT ABOUT THE SECURITY SIT IN GITARAMA PREFECTURE. HE ALSO HELD DISCUSSIONS ABOUT THE ASSISTANCE FOR SECTOR 1B WHICH IS OPERATIONALLY UNDER INDBATT'S AOR. CO INDBATT AGREED TO PROVIDE 2 TRUCKS FOR CONVEYANCE OF FOODSTUFFS FROM GITARAMA TO VARIOUS COMMUNES WITHIN THE SECTOR.

(2) INDBATT PROVIDED ONE TRUCK TO ARDEC FOR TRANSPORTING WOOD FOR MAKING OF BRICKS IN RUNDA PARISH.

(3) INDBATT REPORTED THAT NO IDPs ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP. 121 IDPs WERE DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO KIBUNGO, BUTARE AND NGENDA. A TOTAL OF 129 NOW AWAITING EVAC FROM NDERA CAMP.

(4) INDBATT MED STAFF TREATED 16 MEDICAL AND 08 DENTAL PATIENTS AT OWN CLINICS.

(5) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED TENSE. IN DISCUSSION WITH NGOS, LOCALS AND UN AGENCIES, THE RECENT SPATE OF MURDERS, ARRESTS AND THREATS INDICATE A TENSE ATMOSPHERE.

(6) MILOBS SECTOR COMMANDER MET WITH CO INDBATT IN KIGALI TO DISCUSS AVENUES OF ASSISTANCE. AN AGREEMENT WAS REACHED IN THE AREAS OF TRANSPORT AND EXCHANGE OF SITREPS.

ONE WAS SHOT ON A LEFT THIGH AND THE OTHER WAS SHOT ON A LEFT ARM. BOTH SOLDIERS HAVE BEEN ADMITTED AT GIHUNDWE HOSPITAL. THEIR CONDITION IS FAIR.

(3) MALAWICOY PROVIDED TPS TO ESCORT REFUGEES FROM CYANGUGU TO GIKONGORO.

(5) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE POLITICAL ADVISER TO THE SRSG, VISITED THE SECTOR AND ATTENDED A MEETING ARRANGED WITH THE PREFECT OF RUHENGERRI.

(6) MILOBS INVESTIGATED AN ACT OF SABOTAGE IN WHICH UNKNOWN ELEMENTS BLEW UP A TEE-JUNCTION IN THE PIPELINE IN GENERAL AREA OF GISA (1913) IN RUBAVU COMMUNE (2213). 

2. OVERVIEW. SECTOR 1: RPA KILLED ONE LOCAL IN MASANGO COMMUNE AND 13 IN SECTOR 5. NEW INFORMATION ON THE MURDERED GIKONGORO SOUS-PREFECT. RPA GETTING TWITCHY ABOUT MEDIA ALLEGATION INTO THE MURDERS.

3. RPA.

A. SECTOR 1: MASANGO COMMUNE: 01 2200B AUG: A LOCAL (MR BIRENYIMONA FRANCOIS) WAS KILLED BY RPA. THERE ARE CONFLICTING REPORTS OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES. MILOBS ARE INVESTIGATING.

B. SECTOR 5: 01 0500B AUG: RUSEBEYA (4783): RPA SOLDIERS ATTACKED A TIN MINING SITE IN THE NEARBY VILLAGE OF RWAMASIZI (????) KILLING 13 PEOPLE. THE CONSEILLER CLAIMED THE VICTIMS WERE INTERAHAMWE ALTHOUGH THE LOCALS CLAIM IT WAS DUE TO THE EXPLOITATION OF THE MINE. CIVPOL & MILOBS CONTINUE INVESTIGATION.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. SECTOR 1: REFERENCE THE MURDER OF THE SOUS-PREFET OF RUHANGO. THE UGANDAN PAPER "SUNDAY VISION" OF 30 JUL QUOTES A UNAMIR SPOKESMAN AS SAYING "OUR MILITARY ADVISERS SAW ONE GOVERNMENT SOLDIER IN UNIFORM OUTSIDE THE HOUSE". COMMENT: EVEN THOUGH THE INDIVIDUAL WAS MISQUOTED, WE MUST BE CAREFUL IN MEDIA RELEASES. WE CURRENTLY HOLD NO PROOF THAT THE MAN WAS A GOVERNMENT SOLDIER AND CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN WHEN SPEAKING TO THE MEDIA WHO HAVE ALREADY BEEN ASSUMING THE MURDERS TO HAVE BEEN DONE BY THE RPA AND BY IMPLICATION, SANCTIONED BY THE GOVERNMENT, OR ONE FACTION OF IT. THIS MURDER IS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE GOVERNMENT'S AUTHORITIES WITH A LEVEL OF HIGH PROFILE INTEREST. IT COULD WELL BE ANYTHING RANGING FROM POPULAR LYNCHING TO FRGF TO OUTRIGHT (REGIONAL) RIGHT-WING PLOT. UNAMIR IS FOLLOWING THE INVESTIGATIONS CLOSELY TO ASSESS THE TRUTH.

B. SECTOR 3: GIKONGORO TOWNSHIP: 01 AUG: WE'VE FOUND MORE INFO ON THE SOUS-PREFET OF GIKONGORO. ACCORDING TO REPORTS, HE WAS KILLED WITH A PISTOL ROUND TO THE RIGHT EAR. HOWEVER, WE ARE FOLLOWING UP THE COINCIDENCE THAT, SIMILAR TO THE SOUS-PREFET OF RUHANGO, THE MAN WAS MURDERED, WAS A MEMBER OF THE MRD (THE PRIME MINISTER'S PARTY) AND HIS NAME WAS NOT ON THE NEW LIST OF SOUS-PREFETS.





1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

2. OVERVIEW. SECTOR 1: A CATHOLIC PRIEST MURDERED. SECTOR 3: ANOTHER SOUS-PREFET DEAD.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. SECTOR 1: TABA COMMUNE (8883) KAMONYI SECTEUR (9079): 011930B AUG: A CATHOLIC PRIEST OF RWANDAN NATIONALITY MURDERED IN A BANANA PLANTATION NEAR HIS RESIDENCE. THE INCIDENT IS UNDER INVESTIGATION.

B. SECTOR 3: GIKONGORO TOWNSHIP: 01 AUG: ANOTHER SOUS-PREFET APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN MURDERED. THE INCIDENT REPORTEDLY OCCURRED BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2040 - 2200B. IT APPEARS THE SOUS PREFET MAY HAVE BEEN ABDUCTED AFTER LEAVING A RESTAURANT IN GIKONGORO. THE BODY WAS FOUND BESIDE A BRIDGE ALONG THE GIKONGORO-BUTARE ROAD (559 632) NEAR KAVUMU. THERE WERE NO APPARENT MARKS ON THE BODY. RPA HAVE INCREASED ITS PATROLS IN THE AREA. COMMENT: THE SOUS PREFET WAS A MODERATE HUTU COOPERATING WITH THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT AS WAS THE SOUS PREFET OF RUHANGO. BESIDES THE FACT THAT THEY ARE BOTH DEAD, THERE IS LITTLE ELSE TO LINK THE TWO INCIDENTS AT THIS TIME.

4. REFUGEES/IDPs.

5. POLITICAL. SECTOR 5: RUHENGARI: 2 AUG: THE PREFET OF RUHENGARI, RPA BATTALION COMMANDER AND HEAD OF GENDARMERIE IN RUHENGARI HELD A PUBLIC MEETING AT WHICH APPROXIMATELY 3,000 PEOPLE ATTENDED. THE MEETING WAS CALLED IN THE WAKE OF MONDAY'S PROTEST AGAINST THE PROMOTIONS OF TWO BOURGEMESTRES AND AN ANONYMOUS LETTER BEING CIRCULATED REGARDING THESE PROMOTIONS. THE ASSEMBLED CROWD WERE WARNED TO CURTAIL SUCH BEHAVIOUR AND THAT THE GOVERNMENT WOULD NOT TOLERATE SUCH DEFAMATION AND SCANDAL.

6. REGIONAL. BURUNDI: 7 PEOPLE ARE REPORTED DEAD FROM A GRENADE ATTACK IN NTEGA, MONDAY. THE PERPETRATOR APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN A RWANDAN FROM THE REFUGEE CAMP IN MARANGERA.

7. MISC. NSTR.

8. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1

(1) THE ADVANCED GUARD (ONE PLATOON) OF MALICOY DEPARTED TO GIKONGORO.

(2) INDBATT GUARD AT BBC REPORTED SOUND OF SEVEN SINGLE ROUNDS HEARD FROM THE GENERAL DIRECTION OF PARLIAMENT BUILDING. INVESTIGATION WAS INCONCLUSIVE.

(3) 32 IDPs ARRIVED NDERA CAMP FROM BUTARE. 66 IDPs WERE DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO KANZENZE. A TOTAL OF 132 IDPs STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM NDERA CAMP.

(4) INDBATT PROVIDED ONE TRUCK TO ARDEC FOR DELIVERY OF WOOD FOR COOKING BRICKS IN RUNDA PARISH. THE TRUCK CARRIED WOOD TO SOME PLACES WITHIN THE COMMUNE.

(5) MILOBS TEAMS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN THEIR AOR. ONE TEAM INVESTIGATED A REPORTED CASE OF MINES IN KANOMBE COMMUNE (KIGALI). THE BOURGMESTRE PROMISED TO ESCORT MILOBS TO THE SUSPECTED AREA ON 04 AUG 95.

(6) GITARAMA MILOB CONDUCTED PATROLS TO BULINGA (6679) AND NYAMABUYE (7570) COMMUNES. SEVERAL SECTORS IN THESE COMMUNES WERE VISITED. MILOBS HAD ACCESS TO COMMUNAL CACHOTS AND SAW THE INMATES. SITUATION WAS CALM. HOWEVER, REPORTS OF BANDITRY WERE RECEIVED.

(7) MILOBS CONDUCTED INVESTIGATIONS INTO THE MURDER OF A CATHOLIC PRIEST OF RWANDESE NATIONALITY AT KAMONYI SECTOR (9079) IN TABA COMMUNE (8883). THE PRIEST, FATHER PIE NTAHOBARI, WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE KAMONYI PARISH AND WAS SHOT LAST NIGHT. VARIOUS SOURCES GAVE DIFFERENT VERSIONS OF EVENTS. ONE RELIABLE SOURCE SAID THE PRIEST WAS STOPPED AT THE ENTRANCE OF HIS RESIDENCE BY SOME UNIDENTIFIED ARMED ELEMENTS IN UNIFORM. HE WAS THEN TAKEN TO A NEARBY BANANA PLANTATION AND SHOT. TWO GUARDS IN THE RESIDENCE CORROBORATED THIS VERSION BUT CLAIMED THE PRIEST ONLY STOPPED ABOUT A 100 METRES FROM THE RESIDENCE AND CALLED ONE OF THEM TO COME FOR THE CAR KEYS. THEY CLAIMED THEY DID NOT SEE ANYBODY STOPPING THE PRIEST. THIS COULD BE FOR FEAR OF CONSEQUENCES IN DENOUNCING THE MURDERERS. ALL SOURCES AGREED THAT THE PRIEST WAS STOPPED AT ABOUT 1900 HRS AND SHOT 30 MINUTES LATER. THE BODY WAS SEEN IN THE MORNING BY AN 11 YEAR-OLD BOY. WHEN MILOBS INTERVIEWED LOCALS, THEY CLAIMED THAT THEY DID SEE THREE RPA SOLDIERS GOING TO THE PRIEST'S RESIDENCE AND ONE OF THEM ENTERED THE BANANA PLANTATION WHERE THE PRIEST WAS SHOT. AT THE MURDER SCENE THIS MORNING WERE THE PREFECT OF GITARAMA, TWO REPS FROM INSPECTEUR DE POLICE JUDICIAIRE, A REPORTER FROM RADIO RWANDA AND ANOTHER FROM KENYA METEKE AND A FEW RPA SOLDIERS.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.

(2) GHANBATT REPORTED THAT 4 X APCs EVACUATED FROM BICUMBI GR 3876 AND RWANTERU GR 7984 TO GISHALI GR 4788 AND KIYSNJA PTL BASES RESPECTIVELY. EVAC OF TPS TO COY HQs COMMENCED.

(2) GHANBATT MED STAFF TREATED 95 LOCALS IN AOR.

(3) CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE MUHURA (GR 3008), MUVUMBA (GR 2646) AND GITI (GR 2303) COMMUNES TO MONITOR THE HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES OF NGOS AND THE CONDITIONS IN SOME OF THE LOCAL PRISONS. SITUATION WAS CALM.

(4) MILOBS KIBUNGO INVESTIGATED AND CONFIRMED THE OUTBREAK OF CHOLERA AND MENINGITIS IN THE RUSUMO AREA. THE BOURGEMESTRE REPORTED THE DEATH OF 6 PERSONS FROM THE OUTBREAK. FMO STAFF WIL INVESTIGATE FURTHER.

(5) MILOBS PATROLS FROM KIBUNGO TO SEVERAL AREAS REPORTED THE SITUATION WAS CALM. THERE IS LACK OF DRINKING WATER IN MOST COMMUNES.

C. SECTOR 3.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN GIKONGORO AOR. NTR.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED RUNYINYA (6012), SHYANDA (7718) AND GISHAMVU (6505) COMMUNES. LOCALS WERE SEEN GOING ABOUT NORMAL ACTIVITIES. SITUATION WAS CALM.

(3) MILOBS PATROLLED KANYARU-HAUTE BORDER POST. SOME RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI WERE SEEN GATHERED AT THE COMMUNE OFFICE BROUGHT BY UNHCR. IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS AT THE POST REPORTED A DECREASE IN OUTFLOW OF TRAFFIC TO BURUNDI DUE TO THE INSECURE SITUATION IN THAT COUNTRY.

D. SECTOR 4.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.

(2) MILOBS SECTOR COMMANDER VISITED NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP (8124) AND THE INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS AT KAMEMBE AND FOUND THE SITUATION CALM.

E. SECTOR 5.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) NICOY HOSTED FC ON HIS INITIAL VISIT TO NYUNDO SINCE MOV FROM BYUMBA. HE WAS BRIEFED BY THE CONTINCO NICOY AND MILOBS. THE FC VISITED MADAM CARR ORPHANAGE AT MUTURA.

(3) MILOB RUHENGIERI CONDUCTED HELI PATROL TO MANY COMMUNES AND THE CENTRAL HYDRO-ELECTRIQUE-NTARUKA (7137). THE HEADMASTER OF JANJA SECONDARY SCHOOL IN NDUSU COMMUNE COMPLAINED OF LACK OF MATERIALS, LOW ATTENDANCES POWER, LACK OF TEACHERS AND GENERATION.

(4) MILOBS REPORTED THAT OTHER PATROLS WENT TO MUKINGO (5029) AND NKULI (4724) COMMUNES. LIAISED WITH IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS AT CYANIKA BORDER POST.

(5) IN GISENY MILOBS ESCORTED FC'S TEAM DURING HIS VISIT TO NICOY LOC. THEY CONTINUED WITH THE TEAM TO MRS. CARR'S ORPHANAGE IN MUTURA COMMUNE.

(6) MILOBS REPORTED THAT IN KIBUYE MILOB TEAM PROVIDED ASSISTANCE TO A SIGNAL REPAIR TEAM THAT WENT TO UNAMIR REPEATER SITE ON KARONGI MOUNTAIN.

(7) MILOBS PATROLLED MORUNDA (3088) IN RUTSIRO COMMUNE. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO MEET THE DCMO WHO VISITED THE SECTOR LATER IN THE DAY.

1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

2. OVERVIEW. SECTOR 1: RPA ASSAULT UNAMIR PERSONNEL. SECTOR 4: A SUBSTANTIAL FIREFIGHT IN KAMEMBE RESULTS IN RPA THREATS TO LOCALS.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 4: KAMEMBE COMMUNE (8031): 30 ~0030B JUL: THE KAMEMBE COMMUNAL OFFICE, WHICH IS LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 35 METERS SOUTH OF THE KAMEMBE BRIGADE, WAS ATTACKED BY UNIDENTIFIED HOSTILE ELEMENTS, RESULTING IN AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN RPA AND THE ATTACKERS. THE ATTACKERS USED TWO RIFLE GRENADES AGAINST THE BUILDING. AN EXCHANGE OF SMALL ARMS FIRE LASTED APPROXIMATELY 20-30 MINUTES. AFTER THE ENGAGEMENT, RPA TROOPS DEPLOYED TO THE SHORE OF LAKE KIVU IN AN ATTEMPT TO CUT OFF WITHDRAWAL ACROSS THE LAKE. NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED ON EITHER SIDE. SUBSEQUENT TO THIS INCIDENT, THE BOURGEMESTRE OF KAMEMBE CALLED A MEETING OF THE LOCALS, THEY WERE ADDRESSED BY THE LOCAL RPA BATTALION COMMANDER (MAJOR WILSON). HE ISSUED A WARNING THAT LOCALS REFRAIN FROM PROVIDING ANY ASSISTANCE TO HOSTILE ELEMENTS ELSE FACE SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES (REPORTED THE EXACT WORDS WERE "THEY WOULD BE KILLED"). MAJOR WILSON BELIEVES THAT WITHOUT LOCAL SUPPORT, SUCH AN INCIDENT AS THIS COULD NOT HAVE OCCURRED. THE THREATS AND THE LARGE CONTINGENT OF RPA SURROUNDING THE ASSEMBLY OF LOCALS WAS VIEW BY MANY AS INTIMIDATING, AND THAT IF FUTURE MEETINGS WERE HELD IN SUCH A MANNER, THEY WOULD NOT ATTEND. COMMENT: NOT A HEARTS AND MIND THING.

4. REFUGEES/IDPs. SECTOR 1 BURUNDI BORDER: 02 0900B AUG: 15 RETURNEES WILL BE CONVEYED INTO RWANDA FROM BURUNDI BY UNHCR. THEY WILL SPEAK TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES WHO WILL INFORM THEM OF THE SITUATION IN RWANDA. THE RETURNEES WILL THEN BE RETURNED TO THE BURUNDI CAMPS TO ENCOURAGE OTHERS TO RETURN.

2. OVERVIEW. RUMOUR OF INFILTRATION IN SECTOR 5 RAISES MY EYEBROW. RUHANGO INCIDENT STILL BEING INVESTIGATED. A MINOR DEMONSTRATION IN RUHENGARI. BRITAIN INCREASING AID.

3. FRGE/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 5: NYAMUTERA COMMUNE (5819): RUMOUR OF INFILTRATION BY FORMER MILITIAS IN COMMUNE OF NYAMUTERA. MILOBS BELIEVE THIS RUMOUR IS IN CIRCULATION AMONGST LOCALS. COMMENT: ALTHOUGH RUMOUR, IT SHOULD NOT BE DISCOUNTED. THE AREA IS A CHOKE POINT FOR A MAIN LOC RUNNING SOUTH FROM RUHENGARI AND A SECONDARY LINE OF COMMUNICATION TO THE WEST, BYPASSING RUHENGARI. MILOBS WILL INVESTIGATE.

5. POLITICAL.

A. SECTOR 1: RUHANGO: THERE APPEAR TO BE AT LEAST TWO PARALLEL INVESTIGATIONS INTO THE RECENT MURDER/ARSON IN RUHANGO. THE PRIMARY BEING LED BY THE GENDARMERIE, ANOTHER BY THE RPA. THERE APPEARS TO BE HIGH LEVEL INTEREST IN THE CASE. SOME INFORMATION GATHERED SUGGESTS A POSSIBILITY THAT THE MURDERS MIGHT HAVE BEEN A CALCULATED POLITICAL ACTION, VICE A SPONTANEOUS LYNCHING. (MRD KOLONI WAS A MEMBER OF MRD)

B. SECTOR 1: KIGALI. 30 JUL: THE BRITISH MINISTER FOR OVERSEAS DEVELOPMENT, BARONESS LYNDAL CHALKER, WAS IN KIGALI SUNDAY AND YESTERDAY. SHE DECLARED THAT BRITAIN WILL PROVIDE A FURTHER 3.2 MILLION DOLLARS (US) IN AID TO RWANDA, BRINGING ITS TOTAL CONTRIBUTIONS SINCE APRIL 94 TO 146 MILLION DOLLARS. SHE ALSO STATED THAT HER COUNTRY SUPPORTED THE IDEA OF CONVENING A REGIONAL CONFERENCE TO DISCUSS THE PROBLEMS OF THIS REGION. COMMENT: BRITAIN IS GETTING INTO RWANDA "LIKE A DIRTY SHIRT".

C. SECTOR 5: DEMONSTRATIONS: RUHENGARI: THERE WAS A PEACEFUL DEMONSTRATION BY ABOUT 15-20 GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND CIVILIANS PROTESTING THE PROMOTIONS OF THE BOURGEMESTRES OF ROHONDO AND KIGOMBE TO SCUS-PREFETS OF RUHENGARI AND KIBUYE RESPECTIVELY. SOME OF THE DEMONSTRATORS WERE ARRESTED BY RPA.

WAS BROUGHT AND KEPT IN FRONT OF UNAMIR TRANSIT CAMP IN KIGALI BY SOME LOCAL BOYS AT 311045 HRS. THE BOYS RAN AWAY AND THE BOX WAS LATER HANDED OVER TO MP COY.

(4) INDBATT GUARD AT UNAMIR HQ APPREHENDED 2 LOCAL BOYS TRYING TO STEAL PVC PIPE AT 311730 HRS, MPs INFORMED.

(5) NO IDPs ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP. 11 IDPs DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO KIBUNGO. A TOTAL OF 118 IDPs STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM NDERA CAMP.

(6) MILOB SECTOR COMD WAS BUSY LIAISING WITH THE PRISON AUTHORITIES TO ARRANGE TOMORROW'S VISIT BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NONCE APOSTOLIQUE.

THE WORKERS ALSO REPORTED THAT NUMEROUS PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED IN LAST JULY AND AUGUST 94 AND HAD BEEN MURDERED BY THE RPA SOLDIERS WHO OCCUPIED THE HOUSE WHEN THE SISTERS HAD FLED.

(8) MILOB ALSO REPORTED THAT THE LOCALS INFORMED THEM ABOUT RPA SOLDIERS WHO THREW GLOWING PIECES OF WOOD AND OTHER MATERIALS INSIDE THE COMMUNE CACHOT TO FORCE DETAINEES TO ATTEMPT ESCAPE SO THAT THEY COULD BE SHOT. THIS SCHEME FAILED AS THE DETAINEES MANAGED TO PUT OUT THE FIRE IN THE JAIL. THIS IS THE SAME COMMUNE WHERE A JUDGE WAS KILLED BY RPA SOLDIERS ON 01 JULY 95.



SECTOR 4: NYAMASHEKE SUB-SECTOR, KAVUNE CELL (9740): 27 ~2300B: SEVERAL BANDITS, STRENGTH UNKNOWN, ARMED WITH FIREARMS AND MACHETES APPROACHED A LOCAL'S HOUSE WITH THE LIKELY INTENTION OF ROBBING IT. THE SON OF THE OWNER THEM ENTRY AND SWUNG AN AXE AT A RIFLE WHICH HAD BEEN PUSHED THROUGH A BROKEN WINDOW. THE SON WAS SHOT THROUGH THE HAND, HOWEVER THE SHOOTING ALERTED NEIGHBOURS. THE BANDITS FLED WITH A 12 MAN RPA PATROL ARRIVING SHORTLY THEREAFTER.

4. REFUGEES/IDPs. SECTOR 3: MUBUGA COMMUNE: THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MUBUGA COMMUNE CLAIMS THAT THERE ARE 236 IDPS IN THIS COMMUNE WHO ARE WILLING TO RETURN TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES IF TRANSPORTATION WAS PROVIDED.

A. SECTOR 1: RUHANGO: (772 523): THE MURDER INVESTIGATION IS BEING HANDLED BY THE GENDARMERIE. A LOT OF NEW INFORMATION IS BEING DISCOVERED. THERE IS A HIGH LEVEL OF POLITICAL INTEREST IN THE CASE BECAUSE OF THE PRECEDENT THIS MIGHT SET. COMMENT: IT IS NOW KNOWN THAT THE SOUS-PREFET HAD BEEN ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE BY ONLY ONE WITNESS WHO HAD GIVEN A DISTORTED ACCOUNT. IF THE MURDER IS DISCOVERED TO HAVE BEEN A VIGILANTE ACTION, COULD UNDERMINE THE EFFORTS OF THE COMMISSION DE TRIAGE BY ESTABLISHING THE PRECEDENT THAT, IF CLEARED BY THE COMMISSION, THE PERSON CLEARED, AND HIS FAMILY, MAY FEAR HE STILL FACES A LYNCHING.

1. OVERVIEW. MORE INFORMATION ON THE MURDER/ARSON IN RUHANGO.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 4: BUGERAMA COMMUNE, BUNYERERI SECTOR (9417) 27 ~2200 JUL: A GROUP OF ARMED MEN ATTEMPTED TO ROB A COFFEE TRADER. RPA PATROLLING THE AREA FIRED WARNING SHOTS AND THE ARMED MEN FLED EMPTY HANDED. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED.

4. REFUGEES/IDPS. NSTR.

5. POLITICAL.

A. SECTOR 1: RUHANGO: (772 523): MILOS MET WITH RPA BRIGADE COMMANDER (LCOL KAYONGA) REGARDING THE SOUS-PREFET INCIDENT OF 27 JUL. THE BDE COMD STATED THAT THE SOUS PREFET (KOLONI PLACIDE) WAS ONE OF THE VICTIMS ALONG WITH HIS FAMILY. HE CLAIMED THAT THEY WERE HATED BY ALL THE LOCALS AS HE WAS ALLEGED TO HAVE KILLED MANY PEOPLE DURING THE GENOCIDE PERIOD. HE OPINED THAT THIS AND THE FACT THAT HE HAD RESUMED HIS DUTIES AS SOUS PREFET MAY HAVE PROMPTED SOME OF THE LOCALS TO ACT. MILOBS HAVE THE DETAILS. COMMENT: FIVE BODIES WERE FOUND IN THE HOUSE. ALTHOUGH NONE WERE POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED, THE INDICATORS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THEM PROBABLY BEING THE SOUS-PREFET, HIS WIFE, TWO DAUGHTERS AND THEIR DOMESTIC WORKER.

B. INTERNATIONAL FRANCE: ACCORDING TO PRESS, ON FRIDAY, FRENCH POLICE ARRESTED A RWANDAN CATHOLIC PRIEST ACCUSED OF ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE GENOCIDE. THE PRIEST, FATHER WENCESLAS MUNYESHYAKA, HEADED THE SAINTE-FAMILLE PARISH HERE IN KIGALI. HE FLED TO FRANCE WITH THE AID OF THE FRENCH CATHOLIC CHURCH AROUND SEPTEMBER 94 AND WAS GRANTED A LONG TERM VISA. COMMENT: THE ACCUSATIONS AGAINST THE PRIEST ARE FAIRLY WILD, HOWEVER, A FORMAL LAWSUIT WAS FILED AND THE PRIEST WILL BE BROUGHT TO TRIAL.



(4) INDBATT GUARDS AT PRESIDENTIAL HANGAR SUSPECTED A RPA SGT HAVING PICKED UP BATTERIES WHILE WALKING PAST AT 270015 HRS. WHEN THE GUARDS ASKED FOR A SEARCH THE SGT COOPERATED AND THE BATTERIES WERE RECOVERED.

(5) 110 IDPs ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP FROM GISENYI AND GASHORA. 119 IDPs WERE DISPATCHED BY UNHCR TO KIBUNGO, KIGALI AND GASHORA. A TOTAL OF 249 IDPs STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM NDERA CAMP.

(6) INDBATT PROVIDED ONE TRUCK TO ARDEC (AGENCE RWANDAISE POUR DE DEVELOPPEMENT ET LA COOP) FOR TRANSPORTATION OF WOOD FOR COOKING BRICKS IN RUNDA PARISH. THE TRUCK CARRIED WOOD FROM KIBAYA TO RUNDA, SHEL I TO YAMAHARO AND BISENYI.

(7) MEDICAL STAFF PROVIDED FIRST AID TO A 10-YR-OLD BOY WHO WAS BROUGHT BY MPs TO INDBATT RAP AT SOALTEE AT NOON. HE WAS IN A CRITICAL CONDITION AFTER BEING HIT BY THE ZAMBIAN ARMY COMMANDER'S ESCORT VEHICLE. HE WAS RESUSCITATED AND TRANSFERRED TO CIVIL HOSPITAL IN INDBATT AMBULANCE. HE REMAINS IN CRITICAL CONDITION.

(8) INDBATT MED STAFF TREATED 24 MEDICAL AND 01 DENTAL PATIENT IN AOR.

(9) MILOBS PATROLS IN MUSASA AND MBOGO COMMUNES AND MET WITH THE BOURGEMESTRES OF THE TWO COMMUNES. THEY FOUND THE TWO COMMUNES TO BE AGRICULTURALLY RICH. THE SIT WAS CALM IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED.

(10) ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED NTONGWE COMMUNE (GR 9057) AND MET WITH THE BOURGEMESTRE. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED THE COMMUNE CACHOT AND NOTICED AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF PRISONERS THERE FROM THE PREVIOUS TOTAL OF 175 IN JUNE TO THE PRESENT TOTAL OF 237. MILOBS BELIEVED RECENT INCREASE DUE PARTLY TO TOUGH STAND OF BOURGEMESTRE AGAINST GENOCIDE SUSPECTS. BOURGEMESTRE IS SAID TO HAVE LOST ALL HIS FAMILY MEMBERS IN THE GENOCIDE. PRISON CONDITIONS WERE REPORTED TO BE BAD. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED SHYIRA SECTEUR (GR 9151) AND RECEIVED COMPLAINTS FROM LOCALS ABOUT SHORTAGE OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL MATERIALS.

(11) ANOTHER MILOB PATROL ASSISTED THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES TO CONVEY STATIONERY FROM THE PREFECTURE TO NYABIKENKE COMMUNE (GR 7292).

(12) CIVPOL PATROLS TO MASANGO COMMUNE (GR 6254) REPORTED RUMOURS AMONG LOCALS OF ATROCITIES TO BE COMMITTED AGAINST THEM ONCE THE ARMED UN TROOPS LEAVE THE AREA. LOCALS ALSO REPORTED OF ALLEGED TORTURE OF PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT. ALL AREAS PATROLLED WERE FOUND CALM. MILOBS TO INVESTIGATE REPORT.

(13) MILOBS REPORTED THAT AT 2200 HRS ON 27 JUL 95 A SOLDIER FROM THE MALI PLATOON LOCATED AT RUHANGO (GR 7723) NOTICED AN ARMED RPA SOLDIER AT THE FRONT ENTRANCE OF THE SOUS PREFECT'S HOUSE. AT ABOUT 2230 HRS, A LOUD SCREAM WAS HEARD AND AFTER A SHORT TIME THE HOUSE EXPLODED IN FLAMES. NO NEIGHBOURS CAME TO THE SCENE TO HELP. SINCE THE HOUSE WAS SURROUNDED BY A FENCE THE MALI PLATOON COULD ONLY WATCH THE HOUSE BURN. AT 2320 HRS TWO RPA SOLDIERS REPORTEDLY WENT INSIDE THE HOUSE PERIMETER AND PICKED UP A 20-LITRE PLASTIC JERRYCAN WHICH WAS LEFT THERE. THEY ASKED THE MALIAN TROOPS WHETHER THEY KNEW IF ANYONE LIVED IN THE HOUSE. THE RPA SOLDIERS DECIDED TO GO AND SEEK INFO ELSEWHERE WHEN THEY RECEIVED A NEGATIVE ANSWER. MILOBS DO NOT YET KNOW WHETHER ANYONE WAS IN THE HOUSE PRIOR TO THE FIRE. HOWEVER, ARSON AND A POSSIBLE MURDER OF THE SOUS-PREFECT OF GITARAMA IS SUSPECTED. A JOINT MILOB/CIVPOL TEAM WILL VISIT SITE FIRST LIGHT 28 JUL 95 FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS.

(2) GHANBATT REPORTED THAT RPA INTENSIFIED SY MEASURES ALONG THE RWANDA - BURUNDI BORDER.

(2) GHANBATT REPORTED THAT A TRUCK FULLY LOADED WITH RPA SOLDIERS PASSED BARE (GR 5347) TO MUGANGARA (GR 5442).

(3) GHANBATT PROVIDED 1 VEH TO CONVEY WFP FOOD FOR DISTRIBUTION TO REMERA (GR 4292) AND RUKARA (GR 5499).

(4) SUB-SECTOR CHARLIE PROVIDED TPT FOR CARTING FIRE-WOOD FROM GISHALI (GR 2573) TO RWAMAGANA SECONDARY SCHOOL.

(5) MED STAFF TREATED 68 LOCALS IN AOR.

C. **SECTOR 3.** CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(1) MILOBS PATROL TO RWAMIKO COMMUNE (GR 4914) REPORTED THAT ALL IDPs WHO HAVE SINCE RETURNED TO THE VARIOUS SECTORS HAVE BEEN WELL SETTLED WITH THEIR RELATIVES. THE TEAM WAS ALSO INFORMED BY THE INSPECTOR OF SCHOOLS THAT SCHOOL ATTENDANCE HAS BEEN INCREASING DAILY DUE TO THE RETURN OF IDPs.

(2) THE PATROL TEAM TO KARAMA COMMUNE (GR 6327) WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE DCMO. THE DCMO INTERACTED WITH LOCALS AND ADVISED THEM TO BE SELF-RELIANT BY LEARNING TO MANUFACTURE SIMPLE FARMING TOOLS FOR THEMSELVES. THE TEAM WAS INFORMED BY LOCALS THAT IDPs WHO RETURNED FROM KIBEHO IDP CAMP WERE LIVING IN VERY DEPLORABLE CONDITIONS DUE TO LACK OF FOOD AND FARMING IMPLEMENTS.

D. SECTOR 4. CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR.

(1) MILOBS PATROL TO KAGANO COMMUNE WERE INFORMED BY THE BOURGEMESTRE THAT LATE IN THE EVENING OF 25 JUL 95 (EXACT TIME UNKNOWN) A BOAT WITH AT LEAST TWO BANDITS FROM IJWI ISLAND CAME TO ISHARA PENINSULA (EXACT LOCATION UNKNOWN). THERE WAS AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN RPA TROOPS AND THE BANDITS RESULTING IN THE DEATH OF ONE BANDIT WHILST AN RPA SOLDIER WAS INJURED IN THE ANKLE. THE INJURED SOLDIER WAS TREATED AT THE GIHUNDWE HOSPITAL IN CYANGUGU ON 26 JUL 95 AND DISCHARGED. A STAFF AT NYAMASHEKE HOSPITAL CONFIRMED INCIDENT TO MILOBS.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE AOR. PATROL TEAM TO RUSIZI I REPORTED THAT AN EX- MEMBER OF THE FRGF WAS AMONG RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE WHO ARRIVED AT THE BORDER. HE WAS IDENTIFIED BY THE LOCAL CHIEF OF GENDARMERIE TO MILOBS AND UNHCR REPS. HE WAS ESCORTED TO THE LOCAL GENDARMERIE OFFICE FOR AN INQUIRY INTO HIS INVOLVEMENT OR OTHERWISE IN GENOCIDE. THE MAN WISHES TO SERVE WITH THE PRESENT GENDARMERIE AT GITARAMA. UNHCR WILL FOLLOW CASE. SITUATION WAS NORMAL IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED.

E. SECTOR 5. CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(1) MILOB TEAMS PATROLLED HONDO (GR 6829), BUTARO (GR 8144), KIDAHU (GR 7147) AND CYERU (GR 8035). MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT A GROUP OF PEOPLE FROM UGANDA BORDER HAD STOLEN A MINERAL CALLED WOLFRANG FROM A MINE AT RWERERE (GR 8534) IN COMMUNE CYERU. COUNSELLOR OF SECTEUR RWERERE HAS BEEN ARRESTED ON SUSPICION FOR COLLABORATING WITH THE THIEVES.

(2) MILOBS PATROLS TO RWERERE COMMUNE (GR 2722) REPORTED SEVERAL INCIDENTS OF THEFT OF PERSONAL EFFECTS AND LIVESTOCK. IN MUHANDA (GR 2419), LOCALS REPORTED THAT THE THIEVES WHO ALWAYS CAME ARMED DID NOT OFFER VIOLENCE UNLESS WHEN PROVOKED. LOCALS ALSO REPORTED THAT ONE OF THE THIEVES USUALLY CAME WEARING A PAIR OF MILITARY TROUSERS AND A T-SHIRT WITH MNRD WRITTEN ON IT. A LETTER PURPORTED TO HAVE BEEN WRITTEN BY A LT OF THE FRGF, NOW KNOWN TO BE IN GOMA, WAS FOUND AT THE SCENE OF A RECENT THEFT.

(3) MILOB TEAM DESPATCHED TO THE UNHCR CAMP AT KABAKI (GR 3018) TO INVESTIGATE CASES OF STEALING OF UNHCR

ITEMS HAD DISCUSSIONS WITH THE RPA COY COMD AT THE LOCATION. RPA COMD RESOLVED TO ADDRESS THE SITUATION. THE SITUATION WAS NORMAL IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED.

(4) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KIBUYE TOWN (GR 2772) IN GITESI COMMUNE AND MURUNDI (GR 5573) AND NYAMINAMBE (GR 4968) IN BWAKIRA COMMUNE. AT THE KIBUYE HOSPITAL WHERE A WARD HAS RECENTLY OPENED FOR INMATES OF THE KIBUYE PRISON MILOBS MET TWO MEN WITH WOUNDS RESULTING FROM BEATING. ONE WAS BEING TREATED FOR A FLAYED CHEST ALLEGEDLY CAUSED BY A RIFLE BUTT. BOURGEMESTRE INFORMED MILOBS THAT THE INJURIES WERE CAUSED BY POLICEMEN WHO HAVE SINCE BEEN ADVISED AGAINST FUTURE ASSAULTS OF INMATES.



1. OVERVIEW. RPA HANDING OVER SOME CELLULE SECURITY TO LOCALS IN SECTOR 1. SECTOR 4: A SUSPICIOUS MURDER OF A BUSINESSMAN BEING JOINTLY INVESTIGATED BY MILOB AND RPA. BOURGEMESTRES REQUESTING UN ASSISTANCE IN REPATRIATION OF IJWE REFUGEES.

2. RPA:

A. SECTOR 1: MUSAMBIRA (8274) AND RUNDA (882) COMMUNES. RPA SOLDIERS NO LONGER CONDUCTING COUNTER-BANDITRY NIGHT PATROLS. TASK HAS BEEN RELEGATED TO LOCAL PATROL GROUPS AT CELULLE LEVEL. (THE NEIGHBOUR HOOD WATCHES)

B. SECTOR 2: BUZIBA 26 JUL: A FUNCTIONARY OF BYUMBA PREFECTURE WAS SEVERELY BEATEN BY RPA SOLDIERS. THE MAN WAS ACCOMPANYING A ROUTINE MILOB PATROL. REPORTEDLY, HE WENT TO OPEN AN ABANDONNED RPA CHECK POINT FOR THE PATROL AND WAS BEATEN BY RPA SOLDIERS AND ACCUSED OF WORKING FOR UNAMIR.

C. SECTOR 4: KAMUHOZA (8127): SECTOR COMMANDER AND RPA LIAISON OFFICER ARE INVESTIGATING THE KILLING OF A LOCAL BUSINESSMAN. REPORTEDLY, TWO ARMED MEN, ONE IN UNIFORM, ONE IN CIVILIAN DRESS, ENTERED THE VICTIM'S HOUSE AND SHOT HIM AT CLOSE RANGE WITH ONE AK 47 ROUND. THE EVENT WAS WITNESSED BY THE VICTIM'S 12 YEAR OLD SON. NO LOOTING TOOK PLACE AND THE PERPETRATORS FLED IMMEDIATELY.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 4: GAKOMBE CELLULE (7906): 25 2200B JUL: A GROUP OF TWENTY BANDITS ARMED WITH SMALL ARMS AND MACHETES ROBBED TWO HOUSES IN GAKOMBE CELLULE TAKING 4 CATTLE, ONE SHEEP AND 20,000 RF. ONE OF THE BANDITS WAS RECOGNIZED AS A PRE-WAR RESIDENT OF THE AREA.

4. REFUGEES/IDPS. SECTOR 4/IJWE ISLAND: REPORTS THAT INTERAHAMWE CONTINUE TO PREVENT RETURNEES FROM IJWE ISLAND. BETWEEN 21-22 JUL, THE BOURGEMESTRE OF GATARE SENT 6 PERSONS TO DELIVER A LETTER OF ENCOURAGEMENT TO THE REFUGEES ON IJWE ISLAND. THIS IS SIMILAR TO THE ACTIONS OF THE BOURGEMESTRE OF KAGANO. THE THREE BOURGEMESTRES OF GATARE, KAGANO AND KIRAMBO ARE ASKING FORMAL UN INVOLVEMENT TO PROVIDE BOATS FOR THE SAFE RETURN OF REFUGEES.

(9) TEAM CONDUCTED PATROL AT MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE (GR 8274) AND RUNDA COMMUNE (GR 9882). REPORTED THAT THERE WERE BANDITRY ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE COMMUNE. THE HEALTH CENTRE AT GIHARA SQ 9686 TO MEET A LOCAL WHO WAS BADLY BEATEN BY RPA SOLDIER IN RUNDA COMMUNE CACHOT LAST MONTH AND WAS HOSPITALIZED AT THAT TIME. HE HAS RECOVERED AND HAS STARTED WALKING AROUND THE CLINIC.

ONE OF THE BANDITS WAS IDENTIFIED AS A RESIDENT OF GATARE (GR 7808) BEFORE THE WAR.

- (1) MILOBS PATROL IN VARIOUS AREAS WITHIN THE SECTOR REPORTED THAT THE ROAD CONDITIONS ARE NOT GOOD BUT MOTORABLE. THE OVERALL SITUATION WAS REPORTED TO BE CALM.

HOWEVER, THEIR LOCATION (RIGHT ON THE RIVER AND CLOSE TO THE PANZI CAMP AREA) DOES NOT MAKE IT CLEAR WHETHER A MILITIA HARASSMENT EFFORT OR AN FRGF OR RPA PROTECTIVE MEASURE.

(2) KAMEMBE MARKET (786 263): 24 JUL: AT 24 1800B JUL, A MAN WAS ADMITTED TO GIHUNDWE HOSPITAL AFTER HAVING STEPPED ON AN ANTI-PERSONNEL MINE IN KAMEMBE MARKET EARLIER. ALTHOUGH THE VICTIM WAS UNDER ANESTHESIA AND COULD NOT BE INTERVIEWED, AN MSF REP EYE-WITNESS CONFIRMED THE INCIDENT. COMMENT: THE LAST MINE INCIDENT IN KAMEMBE OCCURRED DURING THE GENOCIDE ANNIVERSARY PERIOD. (MILOBS, IS IT SAFE TO SAY, CONSIDERING THE HIGH TRAFFIC PATTERN IN THIS AREA, THIS MINE APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN FRESHLY LAID?)



B. SECTOR 4: YESTERDAY (24 JUL), THE BOURGEMESTRE OF GISHOMA REPORTED THAT MILITIA FROM ACROSS THE BORDER HAD CONDUCTED OPERATIONS DURING THE PERIOD 21-22 JUL:

6. REGIONAL. ZAIRE: COMMANDER SECTOR 5B REPORTS A "FLURRY OF FIRE" IN THE AREA OF GS1514 ON THE EVENING OF 22 JUL (SATURDAY), BEGINNING 1715B AND LASTING APPROXIMATELY 20 MINUTES.
