Subject: SPONSORSHIP OF RUSAYO ORPHANAGE BY MDM

B. Sector 4 figures for blankets dated 26 Oct 95.

1. Please be advised that MDM's terms of contract with the Rusayo Orphanage expired in September 1995. Since then MDM does not render any assistance to this orphanage. However the medicines that were provided by MDM for the orphanage will enable the orphanage to sustain itself medically until the end of this year.

2. Having done some inquiries, the assessment of the situation at the Rusayo Orphanage is as follows:

a. The greatest problem the orphanage faces is insufficient food supply. The daily ration for the children in the orphanage has been reduced by half compared with previous months when MDM was sponsoring it.

b. It is therefore expedient if not imperative to find another NGO which can effectively cater for the Rusayo Orphanage.

3. It might also interest you to know that MDM is also responsible for the Kibogora Orphanage but their contract with this orphanage is due to expire in October 1995. However there is another NGO which is prepared to takeover the sponsorship of the Kibogora Orphanage from MDM.

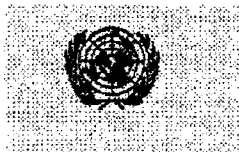
4. You will be furnished with any future developments in respect of the orphanages. Any assistance from your outfit to the orphanages will be highly appreciated.

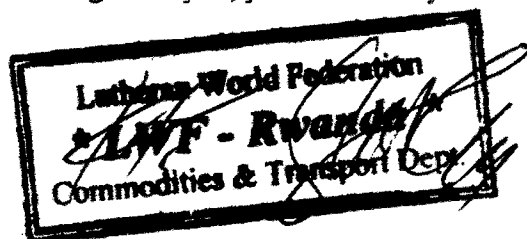
Dear Sir,

LWF is operating the UNHCR-Main Warehouse in Kigali and UNHCR's Substores in Butare, Cyangugu, Gisenyi, Kibungo and Nyagatare.

In Nyagatare housing is scarce. Our staff-members have therefore received secondhand tents. However these tents are of poor quality: During daytime they heat up; during night-time they get too cold. Snakes, scorpions and other molesting creatures cannot be kept out efficiently enough.

I therefore kindly request you to help us out with four or five single tents or any other suitable shelter ('Eight-man tent', 'apartment containers' or the like), until we are able to arrange a more convenient solution for our staff.

Re: Request for loan of generator for Cyanika Health Centre


Dear Sir,

During the genocide of last year one of the worst killings in the South-West region took place in Cyanika parish. Somewhere in the region of 5,000-6,000 people were killed. All the buildings, including the Health Centre, were looted and all the valuables were taken. After August of last year Trocaire - the Irish Catholic agency for world development - helped in the rehabilitation of the Health Centre; that programme has been very successful and the Centre is now fully operational.

The only remaining problem is that the generator which was supplying the power to the Centre and to the parish was stolen. This means that at night we can only operate with the aid of small kerosene lamps. I am therefore requesting UNAMIR to kindly loan us a generator so that we can supply light and power to the Centre during the night.

I hope that this request meets with your kind consideration. A reply can be sent to me c/o Trocaire (PO Box 2040 Kigali, or fax no. 77673, or tel. no. 76442).

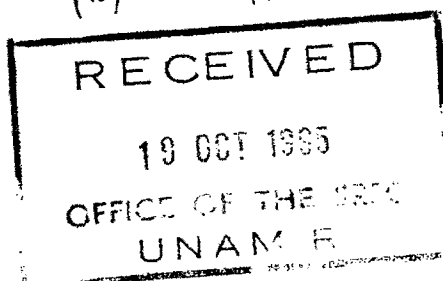




SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR HUMANITARIAN SUPPORT-

SUBJECT: HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

1. As you are aware, the subject of Humanitarian assistance has been discussed on several occasions in the past few months.
2. Considering that UNAMIR has very limited assets and money available for the Services Contract to support the Mission, it has been decided that only very specific WORs requesting services would be authorized once approved by HAC and CISS/CAO. These WORs once approved will be executed in the normal course of activities.
3. However, some of the tasks not eligible to be executed on a WOR will be considered to be accomplished by UNAMIR military, civilian and Contractor staff during their free time. This concept based on my previous experience in past missions was proposed a few weeks ago and was accepted by all concerns.
4. Therefore, prior your departure on leave a few weeks ago, I asked you to discuss the matter with your international and TCN employees to see if some of them (mainly in the services and transport activity sectors) would agree to give some of their time to provide humanitarian assistance. Mr Tompkins, in your absence, indicated that indeed some of your employees would be happy to help.
5. Following the reception of this positive answer, I informed the HAC civilian representative, Mr Lombardo. I asked him to have HAC to review the requests that they had received so far in order to provide me a list of services requested. This list was

received at my office this morning and is attached to this memo.

6. As previously mentioned, these tasks should be executed only when the equipment is not required for official UNAMIR tasks. Employees involved will not be paid during the time they execute those tasks but they will be considered on duty. UNAMIR will accept the liability if an accident, not due to gross negligence, occurs and will provide the fuel/maintenance of the vehicles/equipment involved to provide this assistance.

7. Mr Lombardo will monitor the situation and screen these humanitarian assistance requests to ensure that only valid requests are accepted and that your personnel is not overtaxed. Each case will be allocated a priority (1 to 5) and within each priority group, tasks should be executed according to the reception date of the request. I would appreciate that you inform me and CHAO and STO periodically (suggest every two weeks) on the tasks which have been accomplished. New task requests will be sent to me and I will forward them to you.

8. On behalf of UNAMIR, I take this opportunity to thank you and your staff to accept to participate in this program and to help the Rwandese community.

1. Reference your letter No 5000.1(HAC)/A/1 dated 22 Sep 95. The recce team from this Coy and representatives of Milobs sector 5A visited the site concerned on 06 Oct 95.

2. The recce team noted that the existing bridge is a 50 ft double - single Bailey bridge at Nyamutera. The existing bridge is presently resting on stone masonry abutment. One of the abutment is in very bad shape. This abutment requires urgent attention. The second abutment has also developed a crack, which in due course of time will be a cause of concern.

3. The details of abutment are as under :-

- (a) Width - 8.0 m
- (b) Height - 4.0 m (above water level)
- (c) Length - 5.0 m


4. As an immediate solution to the problem, it is suggested that one bay each may be added on both the sides of the bridge. This will enable the bridge to rest on hard surface. Latter on the abutment can be repaired. As a second option the bridge should be delauched and to be launched again after repairing/constructing abutments.

5. Stores required for extension of bridge are held with Minitraps only. For release of stores necessary liaison has to be done at the ministry level. Stores required for repair of abutment are as under :-



The A/M bridge is situated at the borderline of Commune Gashora of Kigali Prefecture and Commune Sake of Kibungo Prefecture, about 70 km from Kigali via Nyamata. It is a D/S Bailey type with a span of 24 m (80 ft).

The bridge was destroyed during the war and a temporary by-pass constructed. This by-pass is unreliable since, it was once washed away during heavy rains. It is very important that the Bailey Bridge is reinstated since the route is an important link between Kibungo & Kigali and other Prefectures like Gitarama & Butare. It is a very helpful route for resettling returning refugees.



MEDICAL SUPPORT

1. Medical Treatment.

- (a) The Indian Battalion provided medical treatment to 438 local patients in Kigali and dental treatment to 30 local patients. The medical team also visited Butamwa commune and treated 50 local patients.
- (b) The Ghanaian Companies provided medical treatment to 274 local patients in Kibungo.
- (c) The Mali Company provided medical treatment to 17 local patients in Gikongoro.
- (d) The Nigerian Company treated 14 children at Imbabazi orphanage, 32 local patients in Kayove commune, and four local patients at Nyundo camp

ENGINEERING SUPPORT

- 2. Transit Camp at Byumba. The Force Engineer Company has completed levelling of an area of approximately 5,600 square meters for the new transit camp at Byumba. The task involved 32 hours of dozer work.

3. Nsinda Prison. The Force Engineer Company carried out improvement of 200 m long approach track to Nsinda prison. Two dump trucks were employed for the purpose.

4. Rehabilitation School in Butare. The Force Engineer Company is continuing work at the Rehabilitation School. The details of tasks undertaken are :-

(a) Electrification work in the school is in progress. New fittings and wiring worth \$3,500 have been installed during the week.

(b) Water supply restoration work at the school is continuing.

5. Support to Orphanage. The Indian Battalion engineers carried out repairs of water pipeline, water supply fittings and electrical repairs in the Missionaries of Charity (Mother Teresa Group) Orphanage in Kigali.

DONATIONS

6. The Indian Battalion donated ten packets of essential life-saving drugs to Butamwa commune local dispensary. The drugs were provided by the Indian Red Cross Society.

7. The Nigerian Company donated 50 mattresses for returnees, to the Prefect of Gisenyi on behalf of Federal Republic of Nigeria and UNAMIR.

TRANSPORTATION SUPPORT

8. Transportation of Food.

(a) The Indian Battalion provided three trucks to the government for transportation of 15 tons of rations from Kigali to Butare on 03 Oct.

(b) The Ghanian Companies provided two trucks to WFP on 02 Oct for transportation of food from Rwamagana to Sake, for distribution to the locals.

(c) The Mali Company provided following transport support during the week for move of food items :-

- (i) Two trucks to NGO CARE.
- (ii) Four trucks to NGO TROCAIRE
- (iii) Four trucks to NGO CARITAS.
- (iv) Five trucks to NGO PAM

9. Transportation of Aid Items.

- (a) The Indian Battalion transported eight tons of seeds from Kigali to Butamwa commune on 06 Oct.
- (b) The Indian Battalion transported 14 tons of fertilisers from Kigali to Gitarama, Runda and Musambira communes on 05 Oct.
- (c) MILOBS in Gitarama prefecture transported 52 boxes of UNICEF schooling materials from Gitarama to various communes in the prefecture.
- (d) MILOBS in Kibungo prefecture transported and organised distribution of 150 blankets each to Kibungo, Rwamagana and Rwinkwavu hospitals. The blankets were provided by Austrian Relief Programme.
- (e) MILOBS in Kibuye prefecture delivered, by helicopter, humanitarian aid comprising of medicines from UNAMIR, 500 kg of seeds from PAM and 100 kg of plastic sheets from UNHCR to Bwiza commune for the returnees.

10. Miscellaneous Transportation Support.

- (a) The Indian Battalion provided transport as follows :-
 - (i) One truck to WFP for transporting Rubhalls from Kigali to Kibungo on 02 Oct.



REFERENCE: Milob visit to Bwiza Returnee Camp, dated 28 Sep 95.

1. A humanitarian tm composed of Milobs, the Prefet, UNHCR and WFP representatives visited the returnees in Bwiza (SC3794). This visit revealed that the 500 families there require much support. In particular seeds (beans, peas, mais and potatoes), hoes (100), tarps (200), cooking materials, blankets, and medical support are the biggest priorities. UNHCR will take the lead in coordinating their needs.

2. UNAMIR is requested to establish 5 water point in the area of grids 355968, 358962, 365965, 3697 and 3698. An engr recce is required to confirm the technical feasibility of these sites.

3. UNAMIR is also requested to provide medical support to this remote location. This could take the form of a twice weekly medical visit for several weeks until health conditions have improved. After that a once weekly schedule would greatly help these people.


