STRANGELY THE BOURGMASTRE HAD KNOWLEDGE ONLY OF THE ARRESTS OF 10 PEOPLE ALL OF WHO ARE TWAS. HE ALSO MENTIONED THAT ONE WEAPON WAS RECOVERED.

D. TEAM 3. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL KIVU COMMUNE (4004) TO CONFIRM REPORTS RECEIVED ABOUT SOME PEOPLE KILLED IN THE GAHULIZO SECTOR (3611). THE LOCALS CONFIRMED IN ADDITION TO HAVING KNOWLEDGE OF THE INCIDENT OF KILLINGS IN THE FOREST WEST OF SHABA SECTOR (397155) ON 25th DEC 95, THAT THERE WERE ALSO SOME PEOPLE KILLED ON 27th DEC 95 AND 28th DEC 95 . 

B. MILITARY. REPORTS WERE RECEIVED BY THE HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM IN GIKONGORO OF PEOPLE HAVING BEEN KILLED IN THE FOREST NEAR SHABA SECTOR (397155) OF KIVU COMMUNE. PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATIONS HAVE REVEALED THE FOLLOWING :

(i) ON 17 AUGUST 1995 , CONSEQUENT TO THE ARREST OF A LARGE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN RWAMIKO COMMUNE (4914) , LOCALS HAD FLED THE COMMUNE IN FEAR. APPARENTLY THESE PEOPLE HAD ESTABLISHED A CAMP IN THE FOREST WEST OF SHABA (APPROXIMATE LOCATION GR 3414). NOT MANY PEOPLE WERE AWARE OF THE EXISTENCE OF THE CAMP.

(ii) THE LOCALS REPORTED THAT ON 25 NOVEMBER 1995 THEY HEARD FIRING FROM THE GENERAL LOCATION OF THE CAMP FROM ABOUT 0900 HRS TO 1600 HRS. THE LOCALS ALSO REPORTED THAT A DAY PRIOR TO THE INCIDENT THEY HAD NOTICED 8 PEOPLE IN MILITARY UNIFORM IN SHABA AND THESE PEOPLE HAD LEFT ON 26 NOVEMBER.

(iii) ON INFORMATION BEING RECEIVED A MILOB TEAM ALONG WITH A HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO INVESTIGATE THE INCIDENT. ABOUT 40 TO 50 LOCALS ACCOMPANIED THE TEAMS TO THE SITE. THE

TEAM REPORTED THAT THEY OBSERVED A CAMP WHICH WAS LOOTED AND DESTROYED AND COULD COUNT UPTO 20 DEAD PERSONS. ONE OF THE SURVIVORS FROM THE CAMP SAID THAT PRIOR TO THE INCIDENT ABOUT 135 PEOPLE WERE STAYING IN THE CAMP AND DURING THE SHOOTING PEOPLE FLED INTO THE FOREST. THE EXACT NUMBER OF DEAD COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED SINCE A NUMBER OF BODIES ARE SUSPECTED TO HAVE BEEN DROPPED IN THE VALLEY AND ALSO SPREAD OUT IN THE FOREST.

(iii) THE SECOND IN COMMAND OF THE RPA BN IN GIKONGORO WAS CONTACTED ON CONFIRMATION OF THE INCIDENT AND WAS ASKED TO ACCOMPANY ANOTHER MILOB TEAM TO THE SITE. THE RPA DENIED KNOWLEDGE OF THE INCIDENT AND ALSO SAID THAT IT WOULD BE POSSIBLE FOR THEM TO COME TO THE SITE ONLY TOMORROW (02 DEC 95). MILOB TEAMS ARE ACCOMPANYING THE RPA TO THE SITE FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS.

THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 400 IDPs IN THE COMMUNE AWAITING TRANSPORT TO RETURN TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES. THE IPJ IN THE COMMUNE HAS TRIED AND RELEASED A FEW PRISONERS. THERE ARE 11 PRISONERS IN THE CACHOTS OF MUSEBEYA AND MUKO AWAITING TRANSFER TO GIKONGORO PRISON. THE SECURITY SITUATION IS GENERALLY CALM. HOWEVER TODAY MORNING SOME SHOTS WERE HEARD FIRED IN THE BUSHIGISHIGI SECTOR, POSSIBLY BY SOME MISCREANTS SYMPATHETIC TO THE FORMER GOVERNMENT. THE CRETE-ZAIRE-NIL PROJECT FOR AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT IS STILL NOT FUNCTIONAL THOUGH A STATEMENT WAS MADE BY THE GOVERNMENT THAT THE PROJECT WOULD BE ACTIVATED EARLIEST.

C. TEAM 2. THE TEAM WAS STAND BY DUE TO NON AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

THE IRISH PRIEST FATHER NICOLAS TOLD THE TEAM OF THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WHERE REPORTEDLY A MASS GRAVE IS LOCATED BEHIND THE PRIMARY SCHOOL. APPARENTLY NO LOCAL INFORMS THE AUTHORITIES OF THE GRAVE AND A WOMAN WHO INFORMED THE PRIEST OF THE GRAVE DIED A WEEK AFTER THE MATTER WAS REPORTED. THERE HAVE BEEN NO ARRESTS FROM THE SECTOR FOR REASONS OF GENOCIDE AS IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE LOCALS ARE ABSOLUTELY SILENT ON THE ISSUE AND DO NOT GIVE ANYONE AWAY. FATHER NICOLAS IS OF THE OPINION THAT THE BANDITRY ACTIVITIES COULD BE RELATED TO THE INCIDENTS MENTIONED ABOVE. IN KIRAMBI SECTOR THE SURVIVORS OF GENOCIDE DO NOT WISH TO RETURN . EFFORTS BY FATHER NICOLAS TO BUILD HOUSES FOR THE SURVIVORS OF GENOCIDE HAS NOT SUCCEEDED AS THE LOCALS REFUSE TO ASSIST AND THE SURVIVORS FEAR RETURN .

THE ORPHANAGE IS FACING PROBLEMS OF WATER AND ELECTRICITY. THERE IS NO SOURCE OF WATER AVAILABLE TO THE ORPHANAGE AND THE SISTERS HAVE MENTIONED THAT THEY ARE TRYING TO BUILD SOME CHANNELS ALONG THE ROOF TO COLLECT RAIN WATER. WATER AND ELECTRICITY WERE BEING PROVIDED BY THE CRETE-ZAIRE-NIL PROJECT BEFORE THE WAR , BUT SINCE THE PROJECT IS NOW NOT FUNCTIONAL THE ASSISTANCE IS NOT FORTHCOMING. THE SISTERS HAVE REQUESTED ASSISTANCE FOR WATER STORAGE FACILITIES AND BLANKETS FOR THE CHILDREN.
