Subject : 1962 Programme in the field of Civil Aviation

Reference is made to your memorandum of 1 February (your file number GF-390) regarding the New York Headquarters' approval of 1962 project submissions for Civil Aviation.

On the basis of previous indication of approval, we have already proceeded with implementation of project N° 10-01 Airport Operations.

Regarding project N° 10-19 Advisory Services in Civil Aviation, we are revising the programme from a total of 10 to 8 experts in order to bring a 20% reduction in personnel as indicated. However, since this part of our programme has not yet received the approval of the Congolese authorities, I cannot indicate at this time which categories of experts we shall remove from our previous submissions. I would therefore suggest that a revised project submissions should be made to indicate only a total of 8 experts without definition as to categories.

In connection with the estimation of local costs for Civilian Operations projects the following elements should be considered:

MSA

Since the entire MSA is expressed in Congolese francs and paid as such it should be treated as local costs.

MAINTENANCE OF VEHICLES

Cost incurred on this item should also be considered as local costs on a 100 percent basis. Though some spare parts for vehicles are imported at present we intend to rely more and more heavily upon local companies to import them and provide them to us.

OFFICE EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES

In principle the entire cost on this item should be considered as local.

OFFICE PREMISES

Rental of office premises provided outside the Ministries and offices of the Government for the Civilian Operations Experts is fully chargeable to local costs. In cases where premises are shared with other ONUC personnel, proportionate costs can be worked out.

INTERNAL TRAVEL

At present Civilian Operations Experts are able to travel by ONUC chartered aircrafts. The charges for charter aircraft are at present paid in outside currencies. However, technically this is an item of local cost and Congolese francs to cover estimated cost of internal travel should be earmarked as local costs.

MEDICAL AND HOSPITALIZATION

Here again proportionate costs for Civilian Operations can be worked out from the rest of the cost for other ONUC personnel and provision therefore should be made under local costs.

LOCAL EMPLOYEES

Local staff employed directly in support of projects and forming part thereof would automatically be charged to local costs. However, any local staff employed, such as messengers, cleaners, etc. in office premises which are provided for civilian personnel should also be included in local costs. Where necessary proportionate distribution can be worked out.

Les loyers des locaux fournis, abstraction faite des bureaux des ministères et du gouvernement, aux experts des Opérations civiles sont entièrement imputables aux frais locaux.
