

UNAMIR CAMP AT SHAGASHA TEA FACTORY.

We have been contracted by the European Union to rehabilitate tea factories of Shagasha, Kitabi, Mata and Mulindi for OCIR du Thè. At Shagasha tea factory, we were given 2 old houses with roofs to accomodate our technicians but these houses have been fenced off within the UNAMIR compound.

Work at Shagasha tea factory started on 23/8/95 and we have 8 technicians stationed there. We request you to allow us to occupy the two houses allotted to us by OCIR-THE although they now fall within your camp. We confirm to abide by your regulations for reasons of security. We also request you to let us have access to water on temporary basis while the main water supply line to the factory is repaired.

Looking at the remoteness of the area, we shall be grateful if you would allow, on emergency basis, evacuation by your helicopter of any of our technician falling seriously sick and needing urgent medical attention.

Thanking you for your cooperation and look forward to a favourable support.





THE SECURITY AND EVACUATION PLAN IS ESSENTIALLY A BRIEF AND COMPREHENSIVE DOCUMENT ENCOMPASSING ONLY THE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS TO BE FOLLOWED.HOWEVER,WE HAVE TWO POINTS TO COMMENT ON.

1. THE GENERAL INTRODUCTORY PART OF THE SECURITY AND EVACUATION PLAN STATES THAT THE TUTSIS FIRST ENTERED THIS REGION FROM ETHIOPIA.MENTIONING OF ETHIOPIA AS COUNTRY OF ORIGIN FOR TUTSIS,WOULD KEEP OUR IMPARTIALITY IN DOUBT FOR PEACEKEEPING MISSION IN RWANDA. TO AVOID SUCH INCONVENIENCE, IT WOULD BE APPRECIATED IF IT IS IMPROVED. TO DO SO, IT WOULD HAVE BEEN BETTER TO MENTION "HORN OF AFRICA" AS THE REGION OF ORIGIN.

2. IN THE REINFORCEMENT INSTRUCTIONS,IT IS STATED THAT ALL SECTORS NEED TO BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE AND RECEIVE REINFORCEMENTS TO/FROM ANY SECTOR. WE THINK THAT THIS WILL NOT BE ENOUGH,AND DETAIL PLANNING SEEMS TO BE NECESSARY TO COORDINATE THE OUTER AND INNER OR ADJACENT UNITS' WITHDRAWALS.

UNITS IN THE CENTER SHOULD SECURE CERTAIN AREAS AND FACILITATE FOR THE FALL BACK OF THE OUTER UNITS i.e AREAS TO BE COVERED BY THE INNER OR NEIGHBORING UNITS,TIME THE OUTER UNIT TAKES TO FALL BACK,COMMUNICATION FREQUENCIES AND CODE NAMES,FORMATION AND COMMAND OF THE TWO UNITS AFTER THE FALL BACK ENROUTE TO THE NEXT INNER OR ADJACENT UNITS HAVE TO BE DEVELOPED IN DETAIL. EXAMPLE ZAMBATT SHOULD COVER AND WAIT FOR OUR COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL AND SENBATT ALSO COVER AND WAIT FOR THE TOTAL WITHDRAWAL OF THE TWO BNS,ETC. IF THE ROUTE OF EVACUATION IS ALONG THE MAIN ROAD TO KIGALI.

IT MIGHT BE THOUGH THAT COORDINATION WILL BE IMPLEMENTED AS THE NEED ARISES,HOWEVER,TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE UNITS DIFFERENCE IN NATIONALITY AND THE DIFFICULTIES THAT MIGHT BE ENCOUNTERED,ITS PREFERABLE TO PLAN AHEAD IN DETAIL AND MAKE UNITS REHEARSE AND KNOW EACH OTHER DURING PEACE TIME.

THIS TYPE OF COORDINATED WITHDRAWAL WILL ENABLE UNITS LIKE OURS NOT TO MOVE ALL THE WAY TO KIGALI FIGHTING ALONE.




