UN: UNAMIR: PROPOSED VISIT BY AUSTRALIAN PARLIAMENTARIANS AND PRESS PARTY

1. Approval of the United Nations is sought for a party of Australian Parliamentarians and accredited press representatives to visit UNAMIR in Rwanda during the period 23-27 January 1995. The party will travel to Rwanda by RAAF Falcon aircraft which will drop the party in Kigali and return to Nairobi. The visiting party intend to call on the Force Commander and Rwandan Government officials, meet with the Australian contingent and attend Australia Day celebrations, meet Australian NGO organisations operating in Rwanda and, if possible, visit border refugee camps.
