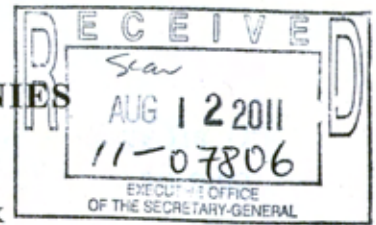

I have the honour to refer to the special meeting of the Counter-Terrorism Committee commemorating the tenth anniversary of the adoption of Security Council resolution 1373 (2001) and the establishment of the Committee, to be held at United Nations Headquarters pursuant to paragraph 11 of Security Council resolution 1963 (2010).

The special meeting (draft agenda attached herewith) will provide an opportunity for the Committee, the Counter-Terrorism Committee Executive Directorate (CTED) and international, regional and subregional organizations to conduct an in-depth discussion on the progress achieved in implementing resolution 1373 (2001); identify the related risks, impacts and challenges; share experiences and lessons learned; and identify ways and means to enhance the implementation of the resolution.

The special meeting will be held on 28 September 2011 in the ECOSOC Chamber, and will commence at 10:00 a.m.
