

LETTER OF APPOINTMENT

15 July 2009

Dear Major-General Jilke,

I am pleased to offer you an appointment as an Assistant Secretary-General in the Secretariat of the United Nations. This will be a fixed-term appointment, in accordance with the terms and conditions specified below and subject to the provisions of the Staff Regulations and Staff Rules, together with such amendments as may from time to time be made to such Staff Regulations and such Staff Rules.

Please be advised that the salary shown above does not include any allowances to which you may be entitled as explained in the Annex to this letter.

Tenure of Appointment

This fixed-term appointment is for a period of seven months and four days from the effective date of appointment shown above. It therefore expires on the 4th day of February 2010. This appointment is subject to extension of mandate and availability of funding.

This appointment may be terminated prior to its expiration date in accordance with staff regulation 9.3, in which case you will be given 30 days' written notice. This appointment is also subject to termination in the interest of the Organization, as determined by the Secretary-General, in which case you will be given three months' written notice. Should your appointment be terminated prior to its expiration date, the United Nations will pay such indemnity as may be provided for under the Staff Regulations and Staff Rules. Please note that the normal expiration of the appointment at its term does not require the payment of any indemnity. This fixed-term appointment does not carry any expectancy of renewal.


Information

This is a fixed-term appointment on secondment from Government service. The conditions governing appointments with the United Nations are set out in this Letter of Appointment. By signing this Letter of Appointment, you specifically acknowledge that you have agreed to serve the United Nations on secondment from the service of your Government on the conditions specified in this Letter of Appointment and its attachment.

This letter of appointment cancels and supersedes the unexpired portion of your current appointment which was due to expire on 5 August 2009.
