1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

2. OVERVIEW. NSTR.

3. RPA.

A. SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA) -RPA CONDUCTED A CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION IN RUNDA COMMUNE (GR 9882) IN AN AREA WHERE A LOT OF NGOS, MOSTLY RELIGIOUS ONES, ARE OPERATING. IT IS SUSPECTED THAT ANOTHER CATHOLIC FATHER/ BROTHER IS ON THE WANTED LIST OF THE RPA.

B. SECTOR 5C (KIBUYE)- MILOBS REPORTED THAT IN MUGANDA CELLULE, LOCALS COMPLAINED OVER THEIR INABILITY TO VISIT ARRESTED RELATIVES IN THE BIRAMBO (GR 4368) SOUS-PREFECTURE CACHOT AND THE KIBUYE PRISON. THE LOCALS CLAIMED MALES WHO WENT TO THOSE PLACES WERE ARRESTED. THESE DEVELOPMENTS HAVE PROMPTED INCREASED SUSPICION AMONG THE LOCALS THAT THEIR RELATIVES MIGHT HAVE BEEN KILLED.

C. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU), MILOBS REPORTED THAT ON 27 NOV 95, RPA FIRED AT SUSPECTED BANDITS MOVING IN A CANOE ON LAKE KIVU IN THE AREA OF MURWA PENINSULA (GR 973415). NO CAS WERE REPORTED. INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS.

D. SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE RPA WAS APPREHENSIVE ABOUT THE SITING OF A UN MARKED BEEHCRAFT WHICH CROSSED OVER THE BORDER INTO GOMA ON 28 NOV 95. THIS INCIDENT TOOK PLACE POSSIBLY BECAUSE OF A LACK OF COORDINATION BETWEEN THE AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL AT KIGALI AND THE RPA.

9. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1

(1) 23 RETURNEES ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP FROM KIBUNGO. NO RETURNEES WERE EVAC BY UNHCR. A TOTAL OF 124 ARE STILL AWAITING EVACUATION.

(2) INDBATT TRANSPORTED 15 TONNES OF RATIONS FOR 301 RPA BRIGADE FROM KIGALI TO BUTARE.

(3) INDBATT REPORTED THAT BETWEEN 09001415 HRS ON 28 NOV 95, APPROX 500 BROWN AND ROOT LOCAL EMPLOYEES STAGED A DEMONSTRATION AND ESTABLISHED BLOCKS AT THE

ENTRANCE OF IVECO AND IVECO ANNEXE DEMANDING 8 MONTHS OF SALARY WHICH APPARENTLY HAS NOT BEEN PAID TO THEM BY THE BROWN AND ROOT MANAGEMENT. AT IVECO, THE WORKERS, INCLUDING SOME EMPLOYED DRIVERS, THREW A FEW TYRES AND TUBES OUTSIDE THE COMPOUND. OWN GUARDS MANAGED TO RETRIEVE THEM AND MOVED THE CROWD OUTSIDE THE COMPOUND. THE LOCALS PELTED STONES AT BROWN AND ROOT MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL WHO ATTEMPTED TO LEAVE THE COMPOUND. INDBATT GUARD BLOCKED THE GATE AND MANAGED TO GET THE AGITATED CROWD UNDER CONTROL AND IN TURN INFORMED THE DUTY OFFICER UNAMIR HQ AND MILITARY POLICE. GENDARMES ACCOMPANIED BY MPs ARRIVED AT IVECO ANNEXE AND EXTRICATED THE BROWN AND ROOT MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL AT 1415 HRS.

(4) INDBATT MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 37 MEDICAL AND 12 DENTAL PATIENTS AT OWN CLINIC.

B. SECTOR 2.

(1) NORMAL DUTIES WERE CONDUCTED IN AOR.

(2) GHANCOY 2 PROVIDED RPA WITH 2 X TCVS TO CONVEY RATION FROM KIGALI TO BUTARE.

(3) GHANCOY 1 CONTINUED REHABILITATION OF BIRENGA GR 5958 ROAD.

(4) GHANCOY 2 CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY FOR INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA.

(4) 45 LOCALS PATIENTS WERE TREATED AND DISCHARGED BY GHANBCOY MEDICAL STAFF AT OWN CLINICS.

(5) MILOB TEAM CONSISTING OF SECTOR COMD AND OPS OFFR ESCORTED BRIG ALLAM OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION ON ARMS FLOW, TO NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP AND WAS BUKUBA BORDER POST GR 8737. THE DIGNITARY WAS BRIEFED BY THE SECTOR COMD.

C. SECTOR 3

(1) NORMAL DUTIES WERE CONDUCTED IN AOR.

(2) MALICOY MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 12 LOCAL PATIENTS.

(3) MALICOY PROVIDED TWO TRUCKS EACH TO PAM AND TO THE RPA FOR TRANSPORTING FOOD FROM GIKONGORO TO RUKUNDO AND MUSEBEYA RESPECTIVELY.

(4) MILOBS MET REPRESENTATIVES OF MARSHALL FOWLER ENGINEERS, THE COMPANY HANDLING THE REACTIVATION OF TEA FACTORY AT MATA. IT WAS LEARNT THAT THE FIRST PHASE WOULD BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF DEC 95 AND IN EARLY JAN 96 THE FACTORY WOULD GO INTO PRODUCTION.

(5) MILOBS LEARNED AT KANYARU-HAUTE THAT FEW REFUGEES FROM CAMPS IN BURUNDI VISITED GITARAMA PREFECTURE (NTINGIYO COMMUNE) TO ASSESS THE GENERAL SITUATION. THE REFUGEES RETURNED TO BURUNDI ON 28 NOV 95.

D. SECTOR 4.

(1) NORMAL DUTIES WERE CONDUCTED IN AOR.

(2) MALAWICOY PROVIDED TWO TRUCKS TO RPA FOR TRANSPORTATION OF FOOD STUFF TO GAFUNZO AND KIRAMBO.

E. SECTOR 5.

(1) NORMAL DUTIES WERE CONDUCTED IN AOR.

(2) NICOY STILL MAINTAINS A SECTION AT MT KARONGI AND PROVIDED SY TO UN PERS AND EQPT.

(3) NICOY REPORTED THAT ABOUT 12 PERS HAVE DIED IN REBAVU COMMUNE AFTER EATING CONTAMINATED BEEF.

(4) NICOY MED STAFF TREATED AND DISCHARGED 10 PERS AT OWN CLINIC.

(5) MILOB PTL TO MUGANDA CELLULE WERE INFORMED THAT THERE HAVE BEEN NO ARRESTS SO FAR IN THE PAST WEEK. HOWEVER AT KAREHE (GR 4368), LOCALS COMPLAINED OF THEIR INABILITY TO VISIT THEIR ARRESTED RELATIVES IN BIRAMBO (GR 4368) AND KIBUYE PRISON.

F. FORCE SIGNAL COY.

(1) FORCE SIGNAL COY CONTINUED ASSISTING RWANDATEL IN ACTIVATION OF LOCAL LINES IN KIGALI.

(2) PROVIDED ONE TRUCK FOR TRANSPORTATION OF WOOD FROM RUGALIKA TO NYAMAHURU ON REQUEST FROM ARDEC.

G. FORCE ENGR COY.

(1) DEPLOYED ONE DOZER FOR REHABILITATION PROJECT IN KIGALI.

(2) DEPLOYED ONE DOZER AND THREE DUMPERS FOR DESTRUCTION OF EXPIRED RATIONS.

(3) PROVIDED ONE VEH TO ARDEC FOR CONVEYANCE OF WOOD.

(4) CARRIED OUT RECCE FOR THE RECOVERY OF VEHICLE HIT BY MINE NEAR KIBUYE

1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

3. RPA.

A. SECTOR 1A (KIGALI) - LOCALS INFORMED MILOBS THAT ON 23 NOVEMBER 1995, RPA BEAT UP A LOCAL AND SUBSEQUENTLY TOOK HIM FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT TO MUHIMA HOSPITAL WHERE HE DIED THE FOLLOWING DAY AT 0100 HRS. THE DECEASED WAS BURIED BEHIND THE HOSPITAL AT 1000 HRS ON 25 NOV 1995.

B. SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA) - THE COUNSELLOR OF TENYO SECTOR (GR 7459), A HUTU, WAS ROBBED OF MONEY AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS AT NIGHT BY 10 RPA SOLDIERS. THE SAME RPA SOLDIERS ALSO BEAT UP THREE LDF MEMBERS WHO HAD RUSHED TO THE COUNSELLORS HOUSE ON HEARING 04 SHOTS FIRED BY THE RPA SOLDIERS.

C. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) - RPA IMPOSED A CURFEW FROM 1900 HRS TO 0500 HRS IN NYAMASHEKE SUB-SECTOR FOR AN UNSPECIFIED PERIOD. THIS CURFEW FOLLOWS THE IMPOSITION OF A BAN ON FISHING ON LAKE KIVU FROM 22 NOV 1995 TO DETER FRGF INFILTRATIONS FROM IJWI ISLAND.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 5C - A SOLAR PANEL SYSTEM TO POWER THE BASE STATION WAS STOLEN FROM UNHCR OFFICES BY UNKNOWN PEOPLE.

5. REFUGEES/IDPs. NSTR.

6. POLITICAL.

A. THE SRSG HELD A PRESS BRIEFING TODAY AT WHICH HE STATED THAT THE VISIT OF THE PROSECUTOR GENERAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA (ICTR), JUDGE RICHARD GOLDSTONE, PROVED HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL, AS HE HAD BEEN ABLE TO ANNOUNCE THAT THE FIRST INDICTMENTS WOULD BE ISSUED AROUND 03 DECEMBER, 1995. THE SRSG INDICATED THAT THE ICTR HAD THE FULL BACKING OF THE RWANDESE GOVERNMENT AND THAT EVEN KENYA NOW FAVOURS THE TRIALS.

B. ON THE PRISONS ISSUE, THE SRSG OBSERVED THAT TO DATE, 4,307 PRISONERS HAD BEEN TRANSFERRED TO THE NSINDA DETENTION CENTRE. HE INDICATED THAT THE REASON FOR THE DELAY IN THIS REGARD WAS NOT A QUESTION OF POLITICAL WILL. THE PRISONERS THEMSELVES OFTEN DID NOT WANT TO LEAVE THEIR HOME PREFECTURES. NEVERTHELESS, IN THE FORTHCOMING WEEK ABOUT 5,000 WOULD HAVE BEEN TRANSFERRED FROM OVER-CROWDED PRISONS TO THE NEW DETENTION CENTRES.

C. ON THE SUBJECT OF UNAMIR MANDATE, THE SRSG STATED THAT UNAMIR PHASING OUT SCHEDULE WILL START TAKING EFFECT ON THE 08 DEC 1995.



A. SECTOR 4 - MILOBS SECTOR 4 REPORTED A SHOOTING INCIDENT BETWEEN 0643-0648 HRS IN MURURU SECTOR (GR 7521). SEMIAUTOMATIC FIRE WAS HEARD FOLLOWED BY AUTOMATIC FIRE. RPA DENIES THAT THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE. FIRING WAS REPEATED THREE TIMES AFTER 0648 HRS BETWEEN RUSUZI I AND RUSUZI II. INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS.

B. SECTOR 5C- MILOBS SECTOR 5C REPORTED THE ARREST OF 04 PERSONS BY RPA ON 17 NOV 95 IN MURAMBO SECTOR OF GISEBEYO COMMUNE (GR 2150) DURING A WEDDING. THE ARRESTED PERSONS ARE BEING DETAINED IN GAKINA (GR 2952) MILITARY CACHOT. THE RPA REPORTEDLY ALSO KILLED ONE LOCAL DURING THE INCIDENT.

C. IN SECTOR 1A, MILOBS REPORTED THE OUTBREAK OF A FIRE AT YAMAHA SPARE PARTS CENTRE IN KIGALI CITY ON 24 NOV 95 AT 0400 HRS. A JOINT TEAM FROM UNAMIR AND RWANDA FIRE BRIGADE BROUGHT THE FIRE UNDER CONTROL BY 1000 HRS. GOODS WORTH MILLIONS OF RWF WERE DESTROYED IN THE FIRE.

(2) INDBATT PROVIDED ESCORTS TO BROWN AND ROOT WATER TANKERS FOR NIGHT SHIFT DUTIES.

(3) INDBATT MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 65 MEDICAL AND 15 DENTAL PATIENTS AND RMO CARRIED OUT MEDIAL CHECK UP OF 121 ORPHANS AT MISSIONARIES OF CHARITY ORPHANAGE KIGALI.

(4) FC VISITED INDBATT COY LOC AT TRAFIPRO 24 NOV 95.

HE LATER VISITED MISSIONARIES OF CHARITY ORPHANAGE (MOTHER TERESA GROUP) KIGALI AND WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE CO.

(5) INDBATT GUARD AT COMMUNICATION COMPOUND REPORTED SOUND OF ONE SINGLE SHOT SMALL ARMS FIRE HEARD FROM THE GENERAL AREA OF GR 0983 (GIKONDO AREA) AT 1905 HRS ON 23 NOV 95.

(6) INDBATT TRANSPORTED BRIDGING MATERIAL FROM KIGALI TO KAYENZI COMMUNE (MARENGA GR 8091) FOR SALVATION ARMY.

A. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) - MILOBS REPORTED THAT ON 23 NOV 95 FROM 0600-0630 HRS, AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE TOOK PLACE BETWEEN TWO RPA PATROLS AT GITONGO SECTOR (GR 0445). THE PATROLS DEPLOYED ON 22 NOV 95 TOOK EACH OTHER FOR FRGF/INTERHAMWE AFTER FAILING TO IDENTIFY THEMSELVES. DETAILS OF CASUALTIES IS NOT KNOWN.

B. SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) - MILOBS REPORTED THAT AT ABOUT 1507 ON 23 NOV 95, RPA SOLDIERS OPENED FIRE ON LOCALS FISHING IN LAKE KIVU WHERE FISHING IS REPORTED BANNED. THE FIRING TOOK PLACE AT KABEKERA CELL (GR 019415). NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED BUT LOCALS WERE ANGERED BY THE SHOOTING AND ARE SEEKING RECOURSE THROUGH LOCAL AUTHORITIES. RPA EXPLAIN THAT THIS MEASURE IS NECESSARY AS FRGF RETURN TO IJWI ISLAND BY DAY USING STOLEN BOATS AND INFILTRATE AT NIGHT MIXED WITH THE LOCAL FISHERMEN.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) - MILOBS REPORTED THAT ON 22 NOV 95 AT ABOUT 2240 HRS, AN ELECTRIC PYLON WAS BLOWN UP AT MUDUMDANO SECTOR, RWENGERO CELL (GR 006413). BLAST ONLY BENT THE PYLON AND POWER SUPPLY WAS NOT CUT. FRGF/ INTERHAMWE OR SYMPATHIZERS ARE BEING SUSPECTED. THE TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE USED REMAINS UNKNOWN AND NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED.

A. THE CHIEF PROSECUTOR OF THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA, JUDGE RICHARD GOLDSTONE, ARRIVED KIGALI TODAY. HE WAS MET AT AIRPORT BY SRSG WHO ACCOMPANIED HIM TO A MEETING WITH H.E. THE VICE-PRESIDENT AND MINISTER OF DEFENCE, MAJOR GENERAL PAUL KAGAME, AND THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, MR ANASTASE GASANA.

B. THE SRSG LATER HELD A MEETING WITH MR IAN MARTIN, CHIEF OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS FIELD OPERATION FOR RWANDA.

C. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT PARTICIPANTS IN THE THEMATIC CONSULTATIONS HAD AGREED THAT RWANDA NEEDS US\$ 120 MILLION TO REHABILITATE RETURNEES. THE CONSULTATIONS WERE OFFICIALLY CLOSED BY THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF INTERIOR, COL ALEXIS KANYARENGWE. THE RADIO ALSO REPORTED THAT SINCE LAST FRIDAY, THE ICRC AND UNAMIR HAD ASSISTED THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT IN TRANSFERRING MORE THAN 3000 DETAINEES FROM THE OVER-CROWDED PRISON AT KIBUNGO TO NSINDA DETENTION CENTRE.

9. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1

(1) INDBATT REPORTED THAT 72 RETURNEES ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP FROM KIBUNGO, NYAGATARE AND BUTARE. 65 WERE DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO KIBUNGO, GASHORA, RUHENGERI AND KIGALI TOWN. A TOTAL OF 147 ARE AWAITING EVACUATION.

(2) INDBATT PROVIDED ESCORTS TO BROWN AND ROOT WATER TANKERS FOR NIGHT SHIFT DUTIES.

HE URGED MILOBS NOT TO RELEASE INFORMATION TO THE MEDIA. THE NEW RPA PLATOON COMMANDER IS MUCH MORE COOPERATIVE AND ALLOWED THE MILOBS TO VISIT THE CACHOT.

THERE IS LAND BEING PROVIDED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF HOUSES FOR THOSE WHOSE HOMES WERE DESTROYED DURING THE WAR.

(2) MALAWICOY MEDICAL PERSONNEL ARE IN BUYEYE AND YOVWE ASSISTING IN NATIONAL ANTI-POLIO VACCINE CAMPAIGN.

3. RPA. IN SECTOR 3A (GIKONGORO), RPA CARRIED OUT CORDON AND SEARCH OP IN GIKONGORO THIS MORNING. LOCALS WERE SCREENED AND THEIR HOUSES WERE SEARCHED. THE PREFECT SAID EFFORTS WERE BEING MADE TO IDENTIFY A GROUP OF PEOPLE INVOLVED IN BANDITRY ACTIVITIES IN THE NEIGHBOURHOOD. RPA LATER REPORTED HAVING RECOVERED SOME ITEMS BUT GAVE NO FURTHER DETAILS.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. SECTOR 5B (GISENYI). MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT ON 18 NOV 95 AT BUSUMBA SECTEUR (GR 2727), INFILTRATORS ABDUCTED ONE PERSON WHOSE WHEREABOUTS ARE STILL UNKNOWN. RPA WERE LATER INFO BY LOCALS AT NYAMIRANGO SECTEUR (GR 3218), ABOUT MOV OF LARGE NUMBER OF INFILTRATORS (APPROX 50) SOME OF WHOM WERE IN UNIFORM AND WERE REPORTEDLY CARRYING WEAPONS. FIVE INFILTRATORS WERE APPREHENDED BY RPA AND RIFLES, GRENADES AND MINES WERE RECOVERED FROM THEM.

B. SECTOR 3A - GIKONGORO. MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN THE AREA. BANDITRY ACTIVITIES ARE SAID TO BE ON THE INCREASE IN RWAMIKO COMMUNE. THE BANDITS ARMED WITH CUTLASSES AND WOODEN HAMMERS ARE SUSPECTED TO HAVE COME FROM MUDASOMWA AND BUTARE. SOME TWAS FROM BUHORO SECTOR ARE ALSO SAID TO HAVE TAKEN PART IN THESE ACTIVITIES.

C. SECTOR 4 - ON 17 NOV 95 IN KIGABIRO CELL GR 8416 OF NYAKABUYE COMMUNE, SIX BANDITS ATTACKED THE HOUSE OF A LOCAL WHO WAS ON A PATROL WITH THE RPA AND SERIOUSLY INJURED HIS WIFE. MOTIVE FOR THE ATTACK IS NOT KNOWN AND INVESTIGATION BY THE RPA IS IN PROGRESS.

THE PARTICIPANTS INCLUDED SEVERAL SENIOR RWANDAN GOVERNMENT FIGURES AS WELL AS ALL AMBASSADORS TO RWANDA AND OTHER PROMINENT MEMBERS OF THE DIPLOMATIC CORPS. THE SRSG WHO WAS INVITED TO MAKE AN OPENING ADDRESS, CONVEYED TO THE MEETING THE SECRETARY- GENERAL MR BOUTROS BOUTROS-GHALI'S SUPPORT AND WISHES FOR SUCCESS IN ACHIEVING ITS OBJECTIVES. THE SRSG ALSO EMPHASIZED THE NEED FOR AN IMPROVEMENT IN REGIONAL RELATIONSHIPS IN ORDER TO ENCOURAGE THE RETURN OF THE REFUGEES. A. SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA). MILOBS RECEIVED AN UNCONFIRMED REPORT AT A VACCINATION CENTRE THAT A SECRET DETENTION FACILITY EXISTED IN NYAKABANDA COMMUNE (6597) IN NGARU SECTOR (6303). THE REPORT FURTHER STATED THAT THE CENTRE HAS 80 INMATES WHO ARE BEING MALTREATED. INVESTIGATIONS REVEALED THAT THE CENTRE IS NEAR A BRIDGE CALLED MOUFOUMBA (660084) LINKING GITARAMA PREFECTURE TO RUHENGERI PREFECTURE. THE LOCALS ARE AFRAID TO SPEAK TO MILOBS. THE COUNCILLOR OF THE AREA CONFIRMED THE PRESENCE OF THE PRISON BUT SAID IT CONTAINS ONLY FOUR INMATES. MILOB TEAM WERE DENIED INFORMATION BY RPA GUARDS AT THE PRISON. A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS PATROL WILL FURTHER INVESTIGATE THE REPORT.

B. SECTOR 3A (GIKONGORO). LAST WEEK, 20 OUT OF THE 47 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT WERE RELEASED AFTER INVESTIGATIONS PROVED THAT THEY WERE NOT GUILTY. SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA)-REFERENCE THE REPORTED CASE OF MASKED SOLDIERS WHO FORCED THEIR WAY INTO THE CATHOLIC COMPOUND IN TABA COMMUNE ON 12 NOV 95, MILOBS CONFIRMED THAT THE SOLDIERS WERE LOOKING FOR A SPANISH FATHER WHO WAS OUT ATTENDING A FUNCTION AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. HE WAS INTERVIEWED BY MILOBS AND HE SPOKE HIS MIND ON THE INCIDENT. HE SAID HE BELIEVES THE ATTACK WAS A FOLLOW-UP FROM COMMENTS MADE ON RADIO RWANDA BY THE GITARAMA REPORTER WHO CRITICIZED HIM BY NAME AS AN INTERAHAMWE WHO HAD TO BE KILLED. THE BROADCASTING ALSO INCLUDED DEROGATORY COMMENTS AGAINST ALL SPANISH PRIESTS AS PRO-HUTU RACISTS. SEVEN FRANCISCAN SISTERS WERE BEATEN. THREE OF THEM WERE INTERVIEWED AND WERE STILL SHAKEN AND HAVE MOVED OUT OF THEIR HOUSES. ONE LOCAL WAS SHOT IN THE ARM AS HE ATTEMPTED TO YELL FOR HELP. THE RPA AUTHORITIES ARE AWARE OF THE SITUATION AND HAVE INTERVIEWED THE FATHER IN THE PRESENCE OF THE A/BOURGEMESTRE.

A. SECTOR 1A (KIGALI)-TWO MEN WERE ARRESTED ON 13 NOV 95 BY THE RPA IN KIGALI CITY FOR HAVING TAKEN PART IN THE GENOCIDE. IN THE SAME SECTOR, MILOB TEAM INFORMED THAT THE RPA BN AT RILIMA HAS BEEN REPLACED BY ANOTHER BN FROM KIBUYE.

B. SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA)- MILOBS REPORTED THAT MASKED SOLDIERS IN A CAMOUFLAGED VEH WITHOUT NUMBER PLATES, FORCED THEIR WAY INTO A CATHOLIC COMPOUND IN TABA COMMUNE (GR8883) ON 12 NOV 95 AROUND 1900 HRS. THEY WERE LOOKING FOR A SPANISH FATHER WHO HAS THE REPUTATION OF SPEAKING HIS MIND ON THE SITUATION IN RWANDA. WHEN THEY COULD NOT FIND HIM, THE INTRUDERS FORCED THEIR WAY INTO A ADJACENT HOUSE WHERE SOME FRANCISCAN SISTERS LIVE. THE RPA SOLDIERS BEAT UP AND THREATENED 03 OR 04 OF THE SISTERS SO AS TO FIND OUT THE WHEREABOUTS OF THE FATHER WHO WAS ACTUALLY IN ANOTHER PARISH. MILOB TEAM WILL FURTHER INVESTIGATE WITH A HUMAN RIGHTS OFFICER. RPA WAS INFORMED AND THEY MOVED TO THE RELIGIOUS COMPOUND AROUND MIDNIGHT ON THE SAME DAY. THEIR INVESTIGATION IS ALSO IN PROGRESS.

C. SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) - AT GICYE COMMUNE (GR 5115), LOCALS REPORTED TO MILOBS THAT RPA HAS IMPOSED RESTRICTIONS ON CONTACT WITH UNAMIR. IN THE SAME SECTOR AT KABAYA COMMUNE (GR 4906), LOCALS REPORTED THAT 50 PERS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED BY RPA ON CHARGES OF HAVING ALLEGEDLY PARTICIPATED IN THE GENOCIDE. OUT OF THE 50 ARRESTED, 10 HAVE BEEN TRANSPORTED TO THE GISENYI PRISON WHILST THE OTHERS ARE STILL IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT.

THE MINE WAS PLACED IN A PLAYING GROUND BESIDE LAKE KARAGO (GR4520) VERY CLOSE TO THE MUKAMIRA RPA MILITARY CAMP. ACCORDING TO THE SOLDIER, THE MINE WAS LAID BY SOME CIVILIANS WHO WERE SEEN WALKING ALONG THE LAKE SOME HOURS EARLIER.







EXACT DATE AND STRENGTH OF ATTACKING FORCE NOT KNOWN. ISLAND SUSPECTED TO HAVE ABOUT 4 COYS OF EX-FAR UNDERGOING INTENSIVE TRAINING.

B. THE SECTOR COMD OF SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA) WAS INFORMED BY AN RPA OFFICER THAT LOCAL RPA TPS WERE NOT HAPPY WITH THE APPOINTMENT OF THE PRESENT 305 BDE COMD. PRESENT COMD WAS MEMBER OF FRGF.

C. IN SECTOR 3B (BUTARE) A DRUNKEN RPA SOLDIER CAUSED PANIC ON 5 NOV 95 AT ABOUT 1930 HRS WHEN HE FIRED SOME ROUNDS OF SMALL ARMS IN THE CENTRE OF THE TOWN. THE SOLDIER WAS LATER ARRESTED AND TAKEN INTO MILITARY CUSTODY.

REFERENCE REPORTED EXPLOSION AT MUHARI SECTEUR (GR 7729) IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) IN SITREP OF 6 NOV 95, MILOBS INVESTIGATION REVEALED INCIDENT WHICH LASTED BETWEEN 1054 HRS AND 1200 HRS OCCURRED WHEN A VILLAGER CLAIMING HE HAD SEEN FRGF/INTERHAMWE INFORMED RPA WHO CORDONED OFF THE AREA. MR PASTEUR BIZIMUNGU, ANNOUNCED THAT A PERMANENT SECRETARIAT WOULD BE ESTABLISHED TO FOLLOW-UP THE WORK OF THE CONFERENCE. IT APPEARS TO BE A CONCERTED MOVE BY THE FORMER GOVERNMENT LEADERS TO DESTABILIZE THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE PREFECTURE. THE RPA IS TAKING ACTION IN THE VARIOUS PLACES BY INCORPORATING THE LOCALS IN THE SECURITY MEASURES. THEY HAVE ALSO INSTITUTED HARSH POPULATION CONTROL MEASURES, INCLUDING HOUSE SEARCH OPERATIONS. WHILE THIS HAS PROVEN EFFECTIVE IN AREAS WHERE THERE IS ACTIVE AND FAVOURABLE COOPERATION OF THE LOCALS, IT HAS NEVERTHELESS DELINEATED THE RPA FROM THE LOCALS IN OTHER AREAS.


