SITREP COVERING PERIOD 051800 TO 061800 JAN 95.

1. GEN SIT:REMAINS UNSTABLE IN SECTOR 4C. LOCALS LIVING NEAR BUSHENGE HOSPITAL HAVE RECEIVED THREATS OF ROBBERY FROM BANDITS REPORTS WERE PASSED THROUGH RWANDISE DOCTOR TO THE NGOS(HELP-GERMANY) ASSISTING AT THE HOSPITAL. THE BUSHENGE HOSPITAL HAS A LARGE AMOUNT OF MONEY SINCE THE MONEY EXCHANGE WERE TO HAVE PAID THE LOCALS YESTURDAY, BUT DID NOT PAY THEM UNTIL TODAY. MANY PEOPLE INCLUDING NGOS HAVE EXCHANGED LARGE AMOUNTS OF MONEY AND NEITHER HAVE IT WITH THEM OR ARE TRANSPORTING IT TO VARIOUS LOCATIONS BY VEH AND FOOT. THIS INCLUDES AGENCIES WHO HAVE TO ORGANIZE PAY FOR LARGE STAFF. COMMENT. THERE IS SEVERE SHORTAGE OF NEW MONEY AND THE THREAT OF ROBBERY/ATTACK MUST BE ASSUMED TO BE HIGH. IT MUST ALSO BE ASSUMED BOAT ACTIVITY ON THE LAKE LAST 2 DAYS MAY HAVE BEEN FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSERTION FOR MONEY EXCHANGE, NOT NECESSARY FOR MIL/RAID PURPOSE.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: NTR.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES:

A. RPA:IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT ETHIOBATT AND RPA ARE PROVIDING SECURITY/OBSERVATION ON SHORE LINE IN FASCINITY OF NYAMESHEKE CLINIC. ETHIOPIAN AIM OF THE LOCATION OF THEIR DEPLOYMENT AND POSSIBLE ENGAGEMENT IS VERY UNCLEAR. IF THEIR POSITION IS INDEED ON THE SHORE DURING DARKNESS, POSSIBILITY OF DEFENCE ENGAGEMENT IS HIGH. RPA HAVE DEPLOYED INTO 3 PROBLEM AREAS IN NYAMESHEKE AREA (RFC BY ETHIOBATT) VIS-A-VIS NGOMA GD 9637,NYAMESHEKE GD 9840 AND GATARE GD 1345.

B. RGF:AT APPROXIMATELY 0200 - 0300HRS 06 JAN 95. A GRP OF ARMED PERSONS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE APPROACHED THE ZAIRE/RWANDA BORDER AT BUGARAMA. RPA BORDER GUARDS STATE THAT A UNIDENTIFIED PERSON WAS SEEN CROSSING THE BRIDGE ON RUZIZI BORDER GD 9001 AND WHEN THE INTRUDER WAS HALTED FOR QUESTIONING AT A DISTANCE, THE INTRUDER OPENED FIRE WITH AN AUTOMATIC WEAPON. THE BORDER GUARD RETURNED FIRE AND THE UNIDENTIFIED PERSON WAS OBSERVED TO FALL INTO THE RIVER. THERE WAS AN IMMEDIATE RETURN OF SPORATIC FIRE FROM THE ZAIRE SIDE TOWARD THE RPA AND AFTER THE UNIDENTIFIED PERIOD OF TIME, THE PERSON FIRING FROM ZAIRE SIDE WAS OBSERVED TO RETREAT BACK DEEPER INTO ZAIRE SIDE. AT THE SUSPECTED PLACE ON THE PATH OF THE BRIDGE THERE WAS MARKS OF BLOOD SEEN AND A BROKEN TOOTH FOUND. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE INCIDENT MAY BE LINKED TO MONEY EXCHANGE THAT ENDED YESTURDAY.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS:

A. A LETTER HAS BEEN ISSUED FROM OFFICE OF THE PREFECTURE OF CYANGUGU BY THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH TO UNAMIR(ETHIOBATT) AND OTHER AGENCIES DIRECTING THAT UNAMIR BEGIN TO VACATE THEIR CURRENT FACILITIES OF THE HOSPITAL THEY ARE OCCUPYING. NOW THAT THE HOSPITAL IS WELL UNDERWAY TO REHABILITATION AND HAS COMMENCED LIMITED SERVICE, IT IS FELT THAT THE PRESENCE OF MILITARY CAMP IN/ON HOSPITAL AREA REFLECTS BADLY ON HOSPITAL ACTIVITY.

B. MONEY EXCHANGE ENDED YESTURDAY. MANY PERS STILL HAVE MONEY TO EXCHANGE, INCLUDING NGO FIRMS. THERE WAS OBVIOUS SOCIAL SHORTAGE AVAILABLE. IN KURAMBO COMMUNE ALONE THE PEOPLE WAITING TODAY HAD APPROXIMATELY A TOTAL OF 13,500,000 FRANCS FOR EXCHANGE.

C. PATROLLED CYANGUGU TOWN ; RWESERO SUB-PREFECTURE GD 9938 INCLUDING NGOMA AND KURAMBO; NYABUYE, BUGARAMA, ZAIRE BORDER AREA. WITH EXCEPTION TO INCIDENT AT BUGARAMA/ZAIRE BORDER LASTNIGHT SITUATION WAS NORMAL.

A. CO-ORDINATED AND HOSTED VISIT OF DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR OF UN HUMAN RIGHTS RWANDA INVESTIGATION TEAM REGARDING VARIOUS ITEMS AND PREVIOUS INCIDENTS.

B. REPORT OF APPROXIMATELY 100 OUT OF APPROXIMATELY 270 PEOPLE WHO HAD BEEN TRANSPORTED BY UNHCR FROM CYANGUGU TO KIBUYE AND HAD BEEN DETAINED BY RPA WAS AT SECTOR 4B, MILOBS TO INVESTIGATE. PREFECTURE OF KIBYE REPORTED THAT SOME PEOPLE WERE QUESTIONED BUT EVIDENTLY NO PERSONS ARE ARRESTED OR DETAINED AS OF 1500 06 JAN 95.

C. AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR REHABILITATION GERWIHUNDWE HOSPITAL IN KAMEMBE COMMUNE HAVE CONFIRMED THAT UNAMIR (ETHIOBATT) WILL BE REQUIRED TO VACATE THEIR ACCOMODATIONS IN NEXT 4 - 6 WEEKS. THERE DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE ANY PLAN OF UNAMIR KNOWN TOO MILOBS OR NGOS FOR FURTHER ACCOMODATIONS IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE CURRENT BATTALLION IS DUE FOR ROTATION IN MID FEB 95, AND ALTHOUGH ACCOMADATIONS HAS BEEN SECURED UNTIL THEN, NO PLAN IS RELATIVELY APPARENT FOR THEIR REPLACEMENT. ADVISE IF ANY INFO IS KNOWN.

D. TOTAL 88 REFUGEES REMAIN IN BUGARAMA BORDER. AT RUZIZI 1 AND 2 REMAIN CLOSED.
